The Historical Values Committee met in Mr. Williams' office at the Historical Society of Pennsylvania, 3:15, June 21, 1965.

Present were: Dr. Nichols, Chairman, Mr. Williams, and Mrs. Tinkcom.

The Committee reviewed the preliminary draft of Bower and Fradley's plans for the CENTRAL GERMANTOWN URBAN RENEWAL AREA. It was agreed that the proposals, as presented on this draft, are acceptable to the Committee. Care seems to have been taken to preserve the historical values on Germantown Avenue and the interesting Victorian character of Greene Street as well.
