

Historic Values Committee met November, 1965

Present: R. F. Nichols, chairman, Mr. Williams, and Dr. Tinkcom.

1. Research budget - 1966

Propose allotting funds to permit Mrs. Kirkbride and Dr. Tinkcom to work 30 hours a week. This at their present rates of pay would require for Mrs. Kirkbride \$5,070. for 1560 hours work and for Mrs. Tinkcom 7,800.

\$12,870.

This will leave approximately \$4,000 for research. Of this sum \$800. should be encumbered for Ed Iwanicki; and the honoraria formerly offered to Miss Rudolph and Mrs. Graham should be made available to each (\$500. each). Approximately \$2200. will, therefore, be available for a student assistant, or assistants. Travel fund \$350.
