16 Joseph Fox, the founder,
17 started selling books in 1951, 71 years
18 ago. In 1990, Michael, his son, took
19 over the running of the bookshop, but Fox
20 Bookshop really prided itself on an 00:15:56
21 excellent children's section,

22 architectural section, and many others.
23 It was a small mom-and-pop bookshop, like
24 some of you remember that small little
25 bookshop in the movie with Tom Hanks 00:16:08

2 You've Got Mail.

3 In January of this year,
4 Michael and his wife, Judy, announced the
5 closing of the store. We'll miss this 00:16:15
6 one-of-a-kind small bookshop. The sad
7 news is they're closing somewhat due to
8 the market conditions. When the office
9 buildings closed, they've lost a lot of
10 potential customers, and they're also 00:16:26
11 going to retire.

12 But the positive news is they
13 had an amazing run. In 2020, when you
14 look at the average lifespan of a
15 business, a large business, according to 00:16:35
16 Standard and Poor's, it's 21 years. In
17 fact, down from 32 years in 1965. But
18 for a small business, the numbers are
19 very different. The average lifespan of
20 a small business is eight years. Fox was 00:16:46
21 in business for 71 years. It was the
22 oldest bookstore in the City of
23 Philadelphia.

24 So I think we all want to offer
25 our congratulations to Judy and Mike Fox 00:16:56

9 Dougherty. The evidence presented was
10 that, in part, the origin of this tax was 00:46:43
11 vindictive and self-serving.

12 It harms the lowest income
13 residents of our city. According to
14 studies, it has not curtailed in any

16 sweetened beverages, but this tax and how
17 it came about, we cannot ignore the

19 the challenge to our government. I

11 our Commonwealth -- civics, Commonwealth
12 and nation.

13 I also just want to thank my
14 pastor and my fraternity brother,
15 Reverend Dr. Derick Brennan, for this 00:48:51
16 morning's prayer. His church and my
17 church, Canaan Baptist Church,
18 Germantown, the gem of Germantown, is
19 located in Councilmember Cindy Bass's
20 district. And his prayer this morning 00:49:01
21 really talked about servant leadership,
22 and servant leadership from my
23 perspective will be really tested
24 tomorrow.

25 Many people know I'm a very 00:49:13

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2 strong supporter of people with learning

6 million Jews, two-thirds of Europe's
7 Jewish population, and millions of others
8 by the Nazi regime and its collaborators.

9 Today is the 77th anniversary
10 of the liberation of the Nazi 00:50:35
11 concentration camps and the end of the
12 Holocaust.

13 On a personal note, I found out
14 recently from one of my cousins, I always
15 thought my grandfather was one of nine 00:50:43
16 siblings, but he actually was one of 13
17 siblings. He was the only one who came
18 to the United States before World War I
19 and actually had the honor of serving in
20 World War I, and he was the only one who 00:50:53
21 survived. The 12 siblings, his 12
22 siblings, their spouses, his parents, my
23 great-grandparents, their children were
24 all killed in concentration camps during
25 World War II. 00:51:04

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2 My grandfather gave me a
3 postcard from one of his siblings from
4 1939. It was his last contact with his
5 family, and I actually have it with me 00:51:11
6 today as I remember International
7 Holocaust Day.

8 Thank you, Council President.

10 Thank you, Councilman. Thank you, 00:51:19
11 Councilman. Very, very tragic.

12 The Chair recognizes Councilman
13 Johnson.

14 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Thank you,

17 remarks, I want to thank Councilman Domb
18 for his remarks regarding International
19 Holocaust Day, and I had the opportunity

10 Governor Wolf for funds for Pennsylvania 00:52:13
11 Commission on Crime and Delinquency for
12 the Gun Violence Intervention initiative
13 that we're operating here in the City of
14 Philadelphia.

15 Governor Wolf yesterday 00:52:25
16 approved \$2 million for this program.
17 You know my position has always been
18 there's no more important issue here to
19 address in the City of Philadelphia
20 besides the issue of gun violence. 00:52:35

21 Today, my team will be out in
22 the community in Southwest where we lost
23 a young man to senseless gun violence,
24 working with the principal at John
25 Bartram High School, working with the 00:52:45

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2 parents of the students at John Bartram
3 High School and, most importantly,
4 working and encouraging those students
5 who feel a sense of trauma after seeing 00:52:54
6 someone being murdered while they're
7 getting out of school, after seeing a
8 fellow classmate who they've known for
9 the time period of this young man
10 attending John Bartram High School's life 00:53:06
11 being taken away from him senselessly in
12 front of other students.

13 So I always believe that it has
14 to be on all-hands-on-deck approach. I
15 salute Councilman Curtis Jones, who I 00:53:17
16 will be with today, for dedicating his
17 time.

18 A lot of times people say,
19 well, what is City Council doing, and we
