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2 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Good
3 afternoon, everyone. This hearing is
4 called to order. I recognize the
5 presence of a quorum of the Committee
6 members of the Appropriations Committee:
7 Councilman Allan Domb, Councilwoman
8 Jannie Blackwell, Council President
9 Darrell Clarke.

10 This is the public hearing of
11 the Committee on Appropriations. The
12 purpose of this public hearing is to hear
13 testimony on Bill No. 180006.

14 Will the Clerk please read the
15 title of the bill.

16 THE CLERK: Bill No. 180006, an
17 ordinance authorizing transfers in
18 appropriations for Fiscal Year 2018 from
19 the Grants Revenue Fund, the Director of
20 Finance - Provision for Other Grants to
21 the General Fund, the Managing Director.

22 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Thank you.
23 Are there any witnesses present
24 to testify on this bill?

25 (No response.)

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2 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: The
3 Administration mentioned they will not be
4 testifying today.

5 Seeing none, that completes the
6 witness list. I would like to ask if
7 there is anyone else here in the Chambers
8 to testify on this bill?

9 (No response.)

10 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: No, there
11 isn't. Seeing none, this concludes the
12 public hearing of the Committee on
13 Appropriations. We will now go into our
14 public meeting.

15 The Chair recognizes Councilman
16 Domb for a motion on Bill No. 180006.

17 COUNCILMAN DOMB: Mr. Chairman,
18 can I ask a question before we get to the
19 motion?

20 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Yes.

21 COUNCILMAN DOMB: I just want
22 to understand what we're doing today,
23 which is the personal services of 75,000,
24 what is that; purchase of services for
25 100; and the materials at 25. I just

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2 want to make sure we're all on the same
3 page.

4 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Yes. This
5 is a transfer ordinance to the Office of
6 Violence Prevention. They're working on
7 violence prevention initiatives, one to
8 focus on bringing in a consultant to work
9 with analyzing the more than \$61 million
10 that's allotted through the City of
11 Philadelphia on violence prevention
12 initiatives, and also the additional
13 funding is going toward a violence
14 prevention initiative that will provide
15 boots on the ground for people to do
16 outreach. And the last portion, from my
17 understanding, is just miscellaneous
18 funding regarding materials.

19 COUNCILMAN DOMB: Okay. Thank
20 you.

21 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: You're
22 welcome.

23 COUNCILMAN DOMB: You want me
24 to move the --

25 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: So moved.

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2 It has now been -- let's do this the
3 right way.

4 The Chair recognizes Councilman
5 Domb for a motion on Bill No. 180006.

6 COUNCILMAN DOMB: Thank you,
7 Mr. Chairman. I move that Bill No.
8 180006 be reported from this Committee
9 with a favorable recommendation. I
10 further move that the rules of Council be
11 suspended to permit first reading of this
12 bill at the next session of Council.

13 (Duly seconded.)

14 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: It has
15 been moved and properly seconded that
16 Bill No. 180006 be reported from this
17 Committee with a favorable recommendation
18 and further moved that the rules of
19 Council be suspended to permit first
20 reading of this bill at the next session
21 of Council.

22 All those in favor of the
23 motion will signify by saying aye.

24 (Aye.)

25 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Opposed?

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2 (No response.)

3 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: There are
4 none. The ayes have it and the motion
5 carries. Bill No. 180006 will be
6 reported from this Committee with a
7 favorable recommendation with a request
8 that the rules of Council be suspended to
9 permit first reading at the next session
10 of Council.

11 This concludes the business of
12 this Committee for today. Thank you all
13 very much.
