2 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
3 morning, everyone. We're going to get  
4 started. We've established a quorum.  
5 I'm going to ask that all guests and  
6 visitors please retire behind the rails  
7 and the members will take their seat.  
8 We'll get started. Thank you.

9 To give our invocation this  
10 morning, the Chair recognizes Reverend  
11 Darrell Bradsberry of the Second Baptist  
12 Church. He is here today as the guest of  
13 Councilwoman Quinones-Sanchez.

14 I would ask all guests and

16 (Councilmembers and guests  
17 rise.)

18 FATHER BRADSBERRY: God, we

13   Thank you so much for those inspiring  
14   words, Reverend.

15          Council will be at ease.

16          (Council at ease.)

17          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

18   Thank you very much.

19          The next order of business is  
20   the approval of the Journal of the  
21   meeting of Thursday, September 10th,  
22   2015, and the Chair recognizes Councilman  
23   Greenlee.

24          COUNCILMAN GREENLEE: Thank  
25   you, Mr. President. I move that the

5 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

6 Thank you. It has been moved and

9 stand approved.

10 All those in favor say aye.

11 (Aye.)

12 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

13 Those opposed?

14 (No response.)

15 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The

16 ayes have it, and the Journal is

17 approved.

18 The next order of business is

19 requests for leaves of absence, and the

20 Chair recognizes Councilman Jones.

21 COUNCILMAN JONES: Thank you,

22 Mr. President. On behalf of the

23 majority, there are no requests for

24 leaves of absence today.

25 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The

2   Chair thanks the gentleman.

3           The Chair recognizes Councilman  
4   O'Neill.

5           COUNCILMAN O'NEILL: Thank you,  
6   Mr. President. On behalf of the  
7   republicans, there are no requests for  
8   leave of absence.

9           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
10   Chair thanks the gentleman. Thank you  
11   very much.

12           At this time, I would like to  
13   dispense with the regular order of  
14   business and I would like to welcome and  
15   thank everyone who has come down today to  
16   witness their government in action. We  
17   really appreciate the fact that you've  
18   taken time out of your busy day to see us  
19   do our thing. We really appreciate  
20   having an opportunity to allow our  
21   citizens to participate in a very special  
22   way. So, again, thank you so much, and  
23   we hope that you enjoy it so much that  
24   you come back again. Thank you.

25           At this time, I would like to

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2 recognize Councilman Oh, who will present  
3 a resolution recognizing the historic  
4 significance of the 225th Anniversary of  
5 the establishment of the United States  
6 Coast Guard. Would Captain Benjamin  
7 Cooper and those accompanying him please  
8 join the Councilman at the podium.

9 (Councilmembers and guests  
10 approached podium.)

11 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: And,  
12 gentlemen, before we start, I would like  
13 to thank you on behalf of City Council  
14 for your service.

15 And joining Councilman Oh, we  
16 have Councilwoman Bass and Councilman  
17 Mark Squilla.

18 COUNCILMAN OH: Thank you very  
19 much, Council President. This is a very  
20 auspicious occasion. First of all, we  
21 are all blessed to have our freedoms, and  
22 we thank our military. In particular,  
23 the U.S. Coast Guard does its job so well  
24 we often don't notice them, but that's a  
25 shame, because they do a wonderful and

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2 fantastic job.

3 A little bit about the Coast  
4 Guard before we present this resolution  
5 is that the U.S. Coast Guard is a  
6 maritime military multi-mission service  
7 military armed forces organization that  
8 is unique among the military branches  
9 because it has a maritime law enforcement  
10 mission with both jurisdiction that is  
11 domestic and international and a federal  
12 regulatory agency mission as part of its  
13 work.

14 It operates under the U.S.  
15 Department of Homeland Security during  
16 peacetime, and at any time the President  
17 designates or the U.S. Congress  
18 instructs, the U.S. Coast Guard will then  
19 be transferred to the U.S. Department of  
20 the Navy. The Coast Guard has been  
21 involved in every U.S. war from 1790 to  
22 the Iraq wars and the war in Afghanistan.

23 By itself, the Coast Guard is  
24 the world's 12th largest naval force, and  
25 its motto in Latin is "semper paratus,"

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2        always ready.

3                Here in Philadelphia, Sector  
4        Delaware Bay covers a portion of  
5        Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Delaware,  
6        including the busy commercial ports of  
7        Philadelphia and Wilmington. And so this  
8        resolution is being presented in  
9        recognition of its 225th Anniversary.

10               And so this resolution,  
11        recognizing the historic significance of  
12        the 225th Anniversary of the  
13        establishment of the United States Coast  
14        Guard and expressing the appreciation of  
15        the people of Philadelphia to the Coast  
16        Guard for its dedicated service to  
17        protecting and advancing the nation's  
18        vital maritime security and interests.

19               Whereas, 225 years ago, on  
20        August 4th, 1790, the United States Coast  
21        Guard was founded by the Revenue Cutter  
22        Service by the signing into law of the  
23        Tariff Act by George Washington at the  
24        request of the Secretary of the Treasury,  
25        Alexander Hamilton; and



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2 Whereas, the 10 original  
3 vessels were responsible for enforcement  
4 of the federal tariff and trade laws and  
5 the prevention of smuggling. After the  
6 War of 1812, the revenue cutters were  
7 further tasked with preventing the  
8 importation of slaves, combating piracy,  
9 removing dangerous wrecks, and preventing  
10 plunder; and

11 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Whereas,  
12 in 1915, Congress merged the Revenue  
13 Cutter Service and the Life-Saving  
14 Service to create the United States Coast  
15 Guard as "a part of the military forces  
16 of the United States" and entrusted them  
17 with ensuring that maritime safety,  
18 security, and stewardship are maintained;  
19 and

20 Whereas, the men and women in  
21 the Coast Guard have selflessly served in  
22 the majority of our Nation's conflicts,  
23 from the Quasi-War with France to  
24 Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

25 Whereas, the Coast Guardsmen

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2 continue the legacy of the brave  
3 Americans who first rowed their small  
4 boats into the rough seas of the  
5 Massachusetts coast, embodying the  
6 virtues of heroism, valor, and altruism;  
7 and

8 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Whereas,  
9 the Guardians of the Coast Guard are  
10 dedicated to saving life at sea,  
11 protecting the marine environment, the  
12 nation's coastline and ports, and  
13 enforcing the nation's maritime laws; and

14 Whereas, the City of  
15 Philadelphia is grateful for the  
16 sacrifices and accomplishments of the  
17 Coast Guard and for its historic  
18 contributions to our Nation, and the  
19 knowledge that it will continue to serve  
20 valiantly in our future; now, therefore  
21 be it

22 Resolved, by the Council of the  
23 City of Philadelphia, that it hereby  
24 recognizes the historic significance of  
25 the 225th Anniversary of the

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2 establishment of the United States Coast  
3 Guard and expresses the appreciation of  
4 the people of the City of Philadelphia to  
5 the Coast Guard for its dedicated service  
6 to protecting and advancing the nation's  
7 vital maritime security and interests.

8 COUNCILMAN OH: Further  
9 resolved, that an engrossed copy of this  
10 resolution be presented to the United  
11 States Coast Guard, further evidencing  
12 the sincere admiration and gratitude of  
13 this legislative body.

14 (Applause.)

15 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
16 Thank you.

17 The Chair recognizes Captain  
18 Cooper for remarks.

19 CAPTAIN COOPER: Thank you.

20 Good morning, everyone.

21 (Good morning.)

22 CAPTAIN COOPER: My name is  
23 Captain Benjamin Cooper and I am the  
24 Sector Commander for the Coast Guard.  
25 The Sector has about 750 active-duty,

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2 reserve, and civilian Coast Guard  
3 members. We are home based out of One  
4 Washington Avenue, right on the Delaware  
5 River.

6 The Coast Guard has 225 years  
7 of service to the nation, and we're very  
8 proud of that. As the smallest branch of  
9 the armed forces, we have less than  
10 42,000 people. Those members of the  
11 Coast Guard do a lot of service for the  
12 nation for the maritime safety, maritime  
13 security, and maritime stewardship of the  
14 environment.

15 We would like to thank Council  
16 President Clarke, Councilman Oh,  
17 Councilman Squilla, and Councilwoman  
18 Quinones-Sanchez for this nice  
19 recognition and thank all the folks here.  
20 If you are veterans and have served this  
21 nation, thank you. We appreciate the  
22 support that -- the community's support  
23 to our folks. And Councilwoman Bass.  
24 I'm sorry.

25 This is a nice day for us. The

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2 U.S. Coast Guard actually formed the  
3 first Coast Guard cutter, which was  
4 called the Revenue Cutter, back in 1791.  
5 It was built in Philadelphia, and it is  
6 wonderful to be honored here.

7 Thank you very much.

8 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

9 Thank you.

10 (Applause.)

11 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

12 Council will be at ease.

13 (Council at ease.)

14 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

15 Thank you very much.

16 At this time, the Chair  
17 recognizes Councilman Johnson, who will  
18 present a resolution congratulating  
19 Joseph Casey for his contributions to the  
20 City of Philadelphia as general manager  
21 of SEPTA. Would Mr. Casey and those  
22 accompanying him please join the  
23 Councilman at the podium.

24 (Councilmembers and guests  
25 approached podium.)

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2 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: And  
3 joining Councilman Johnson, we have  
4 Councilwoman Bass, Councilman Squilla,  
5 Councilman Greenlee, and Councilman  
6 Jones, Councilman Henon, Councilwoman  
7 Reynolds Brown, Councilwoman Blackwell.  
8 I guess we pretty much --

9 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON:  
10 Transportation Committee, sir.

11 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
12 Councilman O'Neill.

13 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Good  
14 morning, everyone.

15 (Good morning.)

16 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Today is  
17 truly an honor and a privilege to have  
18 the opportunity to acknowledge the hard  
19 work and dedication of a fine public  
20 servant, and I want to thank the members  
21 of the Transportation Committee, the  
22 former Chair, Councilman Curtis Jones,  
23 but also Councilwoman Jannie Blackwell  
24 for joining me up here for this  
25 presentation as we honor and acknowledge

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2 Mr. Joseph M. Casey, general manager of  
3 SEPTA.

4 And I've had the opportunity to  
5 develop a friendship with Joe over the  
6 last four years that extended beyond just  
7 the basic professional relationship of me  
8 being a Councilperson and him serving as  
9 the general manager of SEPTA, and I can  
10 attest to you of his great character but,  
11 more importantly, his personal outgoing  
12 personality. See, he always returns my  
13 phone calls, always being supportive as  
14 it relates to me moving the 2nd  
15 Councilmanic District forward.

16 And so at this time, I would  
17 like to give the microphone to  
18 Councilwoman Jannie Blackwell to say a  
19 few words.

20 COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
21 you very much.

22 Good morning.

23 (Good morning.)

24 COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: As  
25 always, we thank God for the privilege of

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2        being with all of you and for the  
3        privilege of recognizing someone who has  
4        done such a great job for our city and  
5        beyond.

6                The Council decided that after  
7        the resolution -- but we'll make our  
8        presentation now -- that we wanted to go  
9        the next mile -- and we thank his whole  
10       team. Frances Jones, we don't want her  
11       to go and we can't make her stay, but  
12       certainly for the entire team, we say  
13       thank you, and we want to make an extra  
14       presentation this morning and it reads as  
15       follows:

16               Retirement Award presented to  
17       Joseph M. Casey, September 17th, 2015 in  
18       appreciation for 34 years of leadership  
19       and service, City Council of  
20       Philadelphia.

21               (Applause.)

22               COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
23       you. Thank you, Kenyatta.

24               COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: You're  
25       welcome, Councilwoman.



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2 And the resolution reads -- and  
3 I just asked Frances, I said, Frances,  
4 what can we do to keep you working so you  
5 don't retire, the hard work and  
6 dedication?

7 Honoring and congratulating  
8 Joseph M. Casey for his contributions to  
9 the City of Philadelphia as general  
10 manager of SEPTA.

11 Whereas, Joe Casey has been a  
12 dedicated SEPTA employee for 34 years in  
13 a number of roles, culminating his career  
14 as general manager; and

15 COUNCILMAN GREENLEE: Whereas,  
16 he has improved SEPTA in a number of  
17 ways, starting with establishing a  
18 customer-first culture and committing the  
19 Transit Authority to improving the  
20 overall customer experience; and

21 COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Whereas,  
22 before serving as general manager of  
23 SEPTA, Mr. Casey served in a number of  
24 budgetary roles, including Chief  
25 Financial Officer and Treasurer, and

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2 various senior management positions in  
3 Internal Audit and Finance; and

4 COUNCILMAN O'NEILL: Whereas,  
5 since he began serving as the Authority's  
6 CFO before becoming general manager,  
7 SEPTA has achieved 16 consecutive  
8 balanced budgets and received the  
9 Government Finance Officers Association  
10 Distinguished Budget Award for 10  
11 consecutive years; and

12 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Whereas,  
13 Mr. Casey also made economic,  
14 environmental, and social sustainability  
15 core business priorities and created a  
16 culture that encourages initiatives to  
17 grow ridership, better meet the needs of  
18 the communities SEPTA serves and identify  
19 new revenue streams and cost saving  
20 opportunities; and

21 COUNCILMAN HENON: Whereas, he  
22 also helped pass Pennsylvania Act 89 in  
23 January 2014 and procure funding so that  
24 SEPTA can embark on a number of  
25 initiatives to address its 5 billion

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2   State of Good Repair backlog, with  
3   projects such as bridge and track  
4   replacement, reconstruction of stations  
5   and other facilities and the purchases of  
6   new vehicles; and

7           COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Whereas,  
8   Mr. Casey also expanded SEPTA's  
9   commitment to operating an efficient and  
10  modern bus fleet that now has 700 hybrids  
11  in service, meaning SEPTA now operates  
12  one of the largest "green" mass transit  
13  fleets in the country, reducing diesel  
14  fuel consumption by 2.2 million gallons  
15  annually; and

16          COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL:  
17  Whereas, Mr. Casey has also founded a  
18  number of community engagement  
19  initiatives at SEPTA, including the,  
20  quote/unquote, "Stop Hunger at Your  
21  Station" food drive, which has donated  
22  more than 100 tons of food to  
23  Philabundance since its inception 6 years  
24  ago; and

25          COUNCILMAN JONES: Whereas,

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2 Mr. Casey will continue his dedication to  
3 the City of Philadelphia after his  
4 retirement from SEPTA as chair of the  
5 transportation committee for the 2016  
6 Democratic National Convention; now,  
7 therefore be it

8 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Resolved,  
9 that the Council of the City of  
10 Philadelphia, hereby honors and  
11 congratulates Joseph M. Casey for his  
12 contribution to the City of Philadelphia  
13 as general manager of SEPTA.

14 And I would be remiss if I  
15 didn't also acknowledge that under his  
16 leadership, SEPTA was awarded the number  
17 one transportation company, not in the  
18 City of Philadelphia, not in the State of  
19 Pennsylvania, but in the United States of  
20 America.

21 And so on behalf of the members  
22 of City Council, we want to officially  
23 present you, Joe, this resolution, this  
24 citation for your hard work and  
25 dedication.

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2 (Applause.)

3 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
4 Chair recognizes Mr. Casey for remarks.

5 MR. CASEY: Thank you. I'm  
6 really humbled to be recognized by City  
7 Council. I spent, during the course of  
8 my career, I spent a lot of time with  
9 Councilmembers on various different  
10 issues, and I can really testify to their  
11 commitment and hard work for their  
12 constituents, and those constituents are  
13 also my customers.

14 In a big city such as  
15 Philadelphia and the highly condensed  
16 area, public transportation is extremely  
17 important, and although we have made  
18 strides in the past to improve some of  
19 our facilities, with Act 89, there's a  
20 lot of things in the works. So in the  
21 next couple years, you'll see a renovated  
22 City Hall station. The courses will be  
23 improved. You'll see trolleys,  
24 articulated trolleys, that are ADA  
25 accessible on our streets and much, much

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2 more. The progress and the future of the  
3 City of Philadelphia are intertwined with  
4 SEPTA, and we want to be a partner, and  
5 we believe the future of the City of  
6 Philadelphia and the future of SEPTA are  
7 extremely bright.

8 Thank you very much.

9 (Applause.)

10 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

11 Thank you.

12 Council will be at ease.

13 (Council at ease.)

14 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

15 Thank you. Thank you so much.

16 At this time, the Chair  
17 recognizes Councilwoman Reynolds Brown.

18 COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Thank you,  
19 Mr. President. I wanted to seize the  
20 moment to introduce to Council the next  
21 bench of lawyers, super lawyers, who will  
22 be running our city in all parts of  
23 government and industry. So we want to  
24 invite from Temple University their law  
25 students, Alison Neville, if she would

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2 stand, Sela Cowger, Scott Dion, and Paul  
3 Lewis. It's always a pleasure to salute  
4 the next generation of leadership in our  
5 city.

6 (Applause.)

7 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

8 Welcome.

9 COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Thank you,  
10 Mr. President.

11 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: And  
12 good luck.

13 Thank you.

14 The Chair now -- no. That was  
15 the same. Okay. Thank you,  
16 Councilwoman.

17 The next order of business is  
18 communications, and the Chair requests  
19 that the Sergeant-of-Arms delivers the

10 address as 3509 Haverford Avenue  
11 including 3502 Mount Vernon Street, all  
12 under certain terms and conditions.

13 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Is  
14 that it? Do you have any additional  
15 communications, Mr. Decker?

16 CHIEF CLERK: I have none,  
17 Mr. President.

18 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
19 Thank you very much, sir.

20 The next order of business is  
21 the introduction of bills and  
22 resolutions, and the Chair recognizes  
23 Councilwoman Blackwell.

24 COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
25 you, Mr. President. Today I introduce



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2 one bill and one non-privileged  
3 resolution.

4 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

5 Thank you, Councilwoman.

6 COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
7 you.

8 CHIEF CLERK: An ordinance to  
9 amend the Philadelphia Zoning Maps by  
10 changing the zoning designations of  
11 certain areas of land located within an  
12 area bounded by Ludlow Street, Farragut  
13 Street, 46th Street, Haverford Avenue,  
14 and 40th Street.

15 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: That  
16 bill will be referred to the appropriate  
17 committee.

18 CHIEF CLERK: And a  
19 non-privileged resolution approving the  
20 redevelopment contract of the  
21 Philadelphia Redevelopment Authority for  
22 the redevelopment and urban renewal of a  
23 portion of the Mantua Urban Renewal Area,  
24 identified by house number and street  
25 address as 3509 Haverford Avenue

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2 including 3502 Mount Vernon Street.

3 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: That  
4 resolution will be on next week's Final  
5 Passage Calendar.

6 And the Chair now recognizes  
7 Councilman Greenlee.

8 COUNCILMAN GREENLEE: Thank  
9 you, Mr. President. On your behalf, I  
10 offer one bill.

11 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
12 Thank you, Councilman.

13 CHIEF CLERK: An ordinance  
14 authorizing the paving of Bucknell Street  
15 from Oxford Street to Jefferson Street,  
16 Twenty-Third Street from Oxford Street to  
17 Jefferson Street, and Bolton Street from  
18 Croskey Street to Twenty-Third Street.

19 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: And  
20 that bill will be referred to the  
21 appropriate committee.

22 The Chair recognizes Councilman  
23 Henon.

24 COUNCILMAN HENON: Thank you,  
25 Council President. I have no bills or

12 The Chair recognizes Councilman

14 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Council  
15 President, I have no bills today, sir.

16 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

17 Thank you, Councilman.

18 COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: You're  
19 welcome.

20 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
21 Chair recognizes Councilwoman  
22 Quinones-Sanchez.

23 COUNCILWOMAN SANCHEZ: Thank  
24 you, Council President. I have one bill.

18   was going to be a sheriff in a cowboy  
19   movie, this, that, and the other. It  
20   changed over time. But I think the  
21   following individual probably knew what  
22   she wanted to be shortly after birth.  
23   She wanted to be a lawyer and then  
24   eventually a Supreme Court justice. She  
25   has even picked out the person she wants

2   to take out on the Supreme Court to be  
3   there.

4           On that road to that dream is  
5   my staff person, Nycole Watson, Esquire,  
6   whose last day is tomorrow as she pursues  
7   that bigger dream. She is an individual  
8   who has worked for us for about two  
9   years, has been in government for more  
10   than that, in the Public Defender's  
11   Office serving as a youth advocate. She  
12   has worked on some of the alternative  
13   courts. She has been our representative  
14   on CJAB. She has helped me most recently  
15   with the Governor's appointment on the  
16   Pennsylvania Crime and Delinquency  
17   Commission. She has worked to establish  
18   youth courts in several of our schools.  
19   And tomorrow is her last day, and I  
20   cannot tell you the job she's going in,  
21   because then she'd have to kill me and  
22   all of us in this Chamber. It is that  
23   high up and secret. But we wish her  
24   well, and she will be sorely missed. You  
25   want to keep them all, but people, once

2   they recognize good talent, come after  
3   it. And we want to ask that you all join  
4   us in wishing her well.

7   Thank you. Councilman, I know she's not  
8   that shy in the office.

9           COUNCILMAN JONES: Not at all.

10   You know what she --

11           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I

12   know the real deal. Thank you,  
13   Councilman.

14           The Chair recognizes Councilman  
15   Johnson.

16           COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Thank you,  
17   Council President. First and foremost, I  
18   want to thank all my colleagues and  
19   members of the community and people  
20   throughout the City of Philadelphia who  
21   came down to Point Breeze and  
22   participated in my 8th annual Community  
23   Appreciation Day. We had a great time,  
24   and I want to, through honorable mention,  
25   acknowledge Councilwoman Cindy Bass who

3   Me Nae Nae. Did a real good job. I want  
4   to also acknowledge my good friends  
5   Councilman David Oh and Councilman Denny

8   to Point Breeze and so I thank them for  
9   coming out and making it a great day.

10           I also want to acknowledge  
11   Mayor Michael Nutter and his  
12   Administration and his team for having  
13   the vision and putting the City of  
14   Philadelphia on the map by bringing Pope  
15   Francis to the City of Philadelphia. I  
16   remember when they first came up with the  
17   idea and they went over to Rome to the  
18   Vatican, was standing outside with the  
19   rest of the crowd waiting for the Pope to  
20   come out and start speaking to the  
21   masses. Nevertheless, they put together  
22   a plan to get the Pope to come to the  
23   City of Philadelphia.

24           I have a very large Italian and  
25   Irish constituency throughout my



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2 district, and I think it's great that  
3 they'll have an opportunity to have the  
4 Pope come to the City of Philadelphia.  
5 And I think it's great, and the eyes of  
6 the world will be on the City of  
7 Philadelphia this weekend. So I just  
8 want to say hats off to the  
9 Administration for doing such a wonderful  
10 job.

11 Thank you.

13 Thank you, Councilman.

14 (Applause.)

15 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
16 Chair recognizes Councilman Squilla.

17 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Thank you,  
18 Mr. President. I just wanted to speak a  
19 little bit on the resolution we  
20 introduced about "It Can Wait," and the  
21 reason why I think it's important is, we  
22 recently saw some reports on some of the  
23 media about hit-and-runs and how much  
24 frequency it seems to be increasing with  
25 people maybe not paying attention,

3   biking, and I'd like to give credit to  
4   AT&T. And understanding that with the  
5   big, large percentage of people that are  
6   using smartphones now, it's not only

9   do with your phone while driving, and  
10  it's really important to realize it can  
11  wait, because it's a safety issue and we  
12  need to make sure that we get that  
13  message out there, and I really believe  
14  that this resolution will help do that.

15           And to follow my colleague  
16  Councilman Johnson, I do want to welcome  
17  the Pope into Philadelphia. Next week we  
18  won't be here, so I guess we'll have to  
19  welcome him today. And also we see the  
20  papal flags on everybody's desk, which I  
21  think is a nice gesture from Council to  
22  welcome him.

23           So thank you very much, and  
24  looking forward to the Pope's visit next  
25  week.
