FATHER HIGGINS: Thank you, President Clarke.

As you move into your new quarters here, friends, we have a saying in church circles. If you want to make God laugh, tell him your plans, and I know you didn't plan on meeting in this particular room today, so everybody is

3 I do want to take this
4 opportunity before my prayer just to
5 thank our Councilwoman, Councilwoman
6 Maria Quinones-Sanchez, for giving me
7 this opportunity to be with you and to
8 offer this prayer, and a special thanks
9 to all of our Council men and women for
10 all the good work that you do for our
11 city. Much, much appreciated. And a
12 special congratulations for landing the
13 Democratic Convention next summer. Way
14 to go, and to you and to the Mayor for
15 that. It will be a great moment for our
16 city. However, it will be preceded by
17 another great moment when my boss arrives
18 in town. Pope Francis is coming to town,
19 as you know, in September, and we are all
20 very excited for that as well. And I
21 thought as part of my prayer, I just
22 would like to read a passage from our
23 Holy Father, Pope Francis. I just think
24 it fits well for you and for me.

25 So if we put ourselves, as we

3 Pope Francis: What does
4 serving mean? It means giving an
5 attentive welcome to a person who
6 arrives. It means bending over those in
7 need and stretching out a hand to them,
8 without calculation, without fear, but
9 with tenderness and understanding, just
10 as Jesus now to wash the apostles' feet.

11 Serving means working beside
12 the neediest of people, establishing with
13 them first and foremost human relations
14 of closeness and bonds of solidarity.

15 Solidarity, this word that
16 frightens the developed world. People
17 try to avoid saying it. Solidarity to
18 them is almost a bad word. But it is our
19 word. Serving means recognizing and
20 accepting requests for justice and hope
21 and seeking roles together, real path
22 that lead to liberation.

23 So brothers and sisters, I pray
24 that you and I, two very important arms
25 of our city, the civic arm, the religious

2 arm, can continue to work serving the
3 needs of those in need - the poor, the
4 homeless, the disabled, the
5 disenfranchised, the addicted. We can do
6 our best individually, but perhaps, more
7 importantly, we can do our best together,
8 in solidarity with one another.

9 So I pray for you this day.

10 May God be with you during your Council
11 meeting. May he continue to encourage
12 you, strengthen you, challenge you to do
13 all that you can in his name, and may God
14 be praised. His holy name is with us.
15 God be with you, God be with us, and God
16 bless each and every one of you.

4 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

5 Thank you.

6 The Chair again recognizes
7 Councilwoman Quinones-Sanchez.

8 COUNCILWOMAN SANCHEZ: Thank
9 you, Mr. President. I move that the
10 rules of Council be suspended as to
11 permit first reading this day of Bills
12 No. 140944 and 150008.

13 (Duly seconded.)

14 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
15 Thank you. It has been moved and
16 properly seconded that the rules of
17 Council be suspended so as to permit
18 first reading this day of Bill No. 140944
19 and 150008.

20 All those in favor say aye.

21 (Aye.)

22 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

23 Those opposed?

24 (No response.)

25 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The

1 2/19/15 - STATED - BILLS ON 2ND READING
2 ayes have it, and these bills will be
3 placed on our First Reading Calendar for
4 today.

5 That concludes our reports from
6 committee, and the next order of business
7 is our Calendar.

8 I note that the bills just
9 reported from committee with suspension
10 of the rules have been deemed to have had
11 a first reading, and these bills will be
12 placed on our Second Reading and Final
13 Passage Calendar at our next session of
14 Council.

15 As there are no additional
16 bills on our First Reading Calendar, the
17 Chair recognizes Councilman Jones for
18 calling up the resolutions and bills on
19 the Second Reading and Final Passage
20 Calendar.

21 COUNCILMAN JONES: Thank you,
22 Mr. President. The following resolutions
23 and bills are being called up from Second
24 Reading and Final Passage Calendars
25 today: No. 150099, 150100, 150104,

1 2/19/15 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT
2 150110, 141027, 140902, 140903, 140971,
3 150003, 150053, 150054, 140517, 140635,
4 140649, and 140886. All other
5 resolutions and bills are being held.

6 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
7 Thank you, sir.

8 Before considering these bills
9 and resolutions on the Final Passage
10 Calendar today, we will have our public
11 comment session. The public comment will
12 go as follows:

13 If you have not signed up to
14 testify on a bill or resolution today
15 that is on the Final Passage Calendar,
16 I'd ask that you do so and the table is
17 on -- where's the signup? Oh, in the
18 rear. Okay. Thank you. There's a table
19 in the rear you can sign up to testify
20 today.

21 Your name will be called. When
22 your name is called, I ask you to go to
23 the podium in the middle of the Council
24 Chambers/courtroom. You will be given
25 three minutes to speak.

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2 There's a device on that
3 podium. When the light turns green, it
4 is your time to speak. When the light
5 turns yellow, you have 30 seconds to
6 conclude your remarks. And when the
7 light turns red, we'd ask that you please
8 adhere to the guidelines and conclude
9 your remarks. Thank you so much for your
10 participation and your compliance with
11 those particular guidelines.

12 Mr. Decker, would you please
13 call the name of the first individual who
14 is testifying today.

15 CHIEF CLERK: Dr. Stephen
16 Gambescia, commenting on Bill Nos.
17 140517, 140635, 140649, and 140886.

18 (Witness approached podium.)

19 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good
20 morning, sir.

21 DR. GAMBESCIA: Good morning,
22 President Clarke and members of Council.
23 I'm Dr. Stephen Gambescia. I'm
24 representing the American Heart
25 Association. I'm also on faculty at

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Drexel University as a Professor of
Health Services Administration.

The American Heart Association
has joined with many health advocacy
partners, including the American Cancer
Society Action Network, American Lung
Association, urging Council to defeat and
reject the legislation before you today
for this body to propose for these four
exemptions related to the Philadelphia
Clean Indoor Air and Worker Protection
Law.

The members of City Council, we
understand that you understand that
secondhand smoke is dangerous to human
health. I'd like to point out and
recognize and thank Councilwoman Tasco.
At the last hearing we understood that
Council is going to -- you'll have before
you a bill that would really end these
exemptions that we have. And in December
what the Committee did is, they actually
did not pass these resolutions, and we
thought that was very helpful.

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2 Unfortunately, the Committee reconsidered
3 these four exemptions and they're going
4 to be passed.

5 We think that this legislation,
6 it creates an impossible choice for
7 Philadelphia workers to decide whether
8 they can earn a living wage or smoke in a
9 smoke-filled environment that may kill
10 them. Philadelphia workers shouldn't be
11 forced to expose themselves to the toxic
12 and harmful environment in order to have
13 a job and collect a paycheck. Nothing
14 about the science of deadly secondhand
15 smoke has really changed.

16 Less than a quarter of
17 Philadelphians smoke, and the majority of
18 Philadelphians, they don't want to smoke
19 and they don't want to be exposed to
20 secondhand smoke.

21 What is of note and I think
22 that's new is that -- and I think very
23 compelling for the body to consider -- is
24 that the Greater Philadelphia Life
25 Science Congress of the Philadelphia

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Visitors and Convention Bureau that testified at the subcommittees on these bills noted that they're also joining us, and what's happening is, these large conventions, especially the health conventions when they come to the City, if you don't have a comprehensive Clean Indoor Air Act, especially for workers, the conventions won't come here. The American Heart Association is in that camp as well, and we think that that's going to be problematic for the economy of the City.

So what we're urging, respectfully, is that the Council, on behalf of the health of Philadelphians and the economy, not pass these four exemptions.

Thank you.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

Thank you for your testimony.

CHIEF CLERK: Irma Lopez

Salter, commenting on 150110.

(Witnesses approached podium.)

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2 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good
3 morning.

4 MS. SALTER: Hello. Good
5 morning. I'm here to let you know that
6 PREIT closed down the Gallery or closed
7 down the small businesses. They allowed
8 some of the businesses to stay. They
9 allowed -- they misled us by saying that
10 they was closing the whole Gallery for
11 two years, for two years, and they did
12 not -- and they did not keep their word.

13 We had Mayor Squilla -- I mean
14 Mark Squilla represent our district,
15 which the Gallery is his district. He
16 did a very good job. The reason why we
17 didn't get the time we should have got,
18 because they misled him. They told him
19 mistruths. They gave him the same
20 impression that they gave us.

21 Yesterday was supposed to be
22 our last day, and other vendors are there
23 still. So they chose who to put out, who
24 to mislead that there was going to be no
25 more Gallery. It wasn't going to be --

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all this construction was supposed to be happening. I've been there since October 1st, 1992, 23 years, and now I have to go to unpack, to have no income, to -- don't know where to go from here, because the Gallery is still open because they allowed -- all these people here, they're vendors. All these people here, they got stories to tell, but, of course, you don't have the time to hear the whole stories. I'm trying to tell it for them.

So I appreciate if you could go back to PREIT, although they said yesterday was the last day, and to say it was the last day because we thought you was closing the whole Gallery. You're not closing the whole Gallery. So you misled the Councilman, your district person, our district person.

And so when they come before you for money, for tax incentives, are they going to mislead you to tell you how they're going to do so much to bring in businesses, Philadelphia businesses could

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2 stay, or they going to bring all these
3 people from out of town, you know, and
4 mislead you, like they're going to do
5 something for us.

6 So now that they misled us,
7 would you please go back today, call
8 PREIT and tell them what's up? Why did
9 you tell us you was closing down? You're
10 not closing down.

11 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I
12 think the Councilman wants -- Councilman
13 Squilla.

14 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Thank you,
15 Mr. President, and thank you, Irma.

16 I want to say that Irma has
17 been leading the fight for the kiosks and
18 vendors there in the Gallery, and we were
19 able to get two extensions from the
20 December 31st. They extended it to
21 January 31st and then, as Irma so well
22 explained to me how important Valentine's
23 Day was to the merchants and what it
24 meant to them, they extended it again
25 until the 18th, which was yesterday. So

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they did do that rent free, and they did tell me that the Gallery II will be closing and Gallery II, there are still some contracts they need to buy out and some people who have leases that they need to fulfill, but they are in the process of actually trying to close down everything.

What we wanted them to do is offer them some other locations. Some of the locations aren't good for the vendors. They have offered them some locations in the other malls, and some of the vendors have actually found some place on Chestnut Street, South Street, Frankford Avenue and other spots for the vendors to work out during this time where the Gallery will be going under some major changes.

I still want to work with them. I've spoken to PREIT, understanding that we need -- we're going to need an EOP in place for the repair of the Gallery. We want to work closely with the vendors and

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the merchants involved to make sure that we will have not only minority-owned businesses back in the Gallery once it reopens, but also local businesses, people who are from Philadelphia and how important that is. And that will be a part of the legislation for protection of the vendors and the retail stores that will come back.

So, I mean, I know this is a tough time right now for them. We did work along with the Gallery. The Gallery said they will not extend the time any longer for anybody without a contract and that we need now to work with where to go, how can we help these vendors go to other locations, and how could we help them to maybe get a good relationship with PREIT to come back once the Gallery is open.

So I thank you for all your work and standing up for your constituents and for the vendors there, and hopefully we continue to work

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2 together to make this a good story at the
3 end. So thank you.

4 MS. SALTER: I appreciate
5 everything you've done, but it would be a
6 really good story if at least we could
7 stay for everybody leaves, because it's
8 not fair that while they're
9 negotiating -- they got this big sign, a
10 new store is going to open next month,
11 2015, not 2016. So how are the stores
12 going to come and open up? And then
13 there's -- all the stores in Gallery II
14 are open. There's two kiosks that are
15 allowed to stay. They're major names,
16 Radio Shack. I know they filed for
17 bankruptcy, but somebody bought them out,
18 and they're going to keep their name.
19 Auntie Anne's, you know, they a big
20 company, but they have kiosks in there.
21 But why could they stay and we can't
22 stay?

23 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

24 Okay.

25 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Just for

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2 clarification for the record, it's not
3 really a new store. It's a relocation
4 from Gallery I to Gallery II for the
5 bakery, and that's until their contract
6 is expired.

7 MS. SALTER: They be having the
8 whole place for them. You know, just
9 until they buy their contract out? So
10 let us stay there until everybody is
11 bought out and everybody is out, you
12 know. We want to feed our family. You
13 know, like I always say to them, I fed
14 your family. You allow me to feed mine.
15 Could I still feed my family until you
16 really close down?

17 Will you please help me or call
18 them now and say, you know, let them stay
19 until you buy Tiffany out and then let
20 Tiffany out, because that's the one that
21 they be having so-called buying them out.

22 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
23 Okay. Thank you, Ms. Salter.

24 MS. SALTER: Could you help
25 too, President? Could you work with us

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2 too, please?

3 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

4 Yeah. I've had the pleasure of knowing
5 you for a lot of years and we've done
6 some good things together back in the
7 good-old days and the advocacy.

8 MS. SALTER: And I thank you.

9 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I
10 really appreciate your commitment. We do
11 have this process internally.

12 MS. SALTER: I know.

13 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
14 Because I don't believe anybody, any of
15 the electeds in here, knows more about
16 that location and this issue than
17 Councilman Squilla. So if there is any
18 assistance that's needed from Councilman
19 Squilla, it's obviously going to be given
20 from members of this Chamber, myself or
21 any staff. So we'll work through the
22 Councilman to see, particularly on any
23 relocation plans, to see if there's some
24 assistance for the City, because I know
25 the City does step in when there needs to

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2 be relocation of the traditional stores.

3 So there should be some process that's

4 established to support vendors, because

5 you are in fact businesses, although

6 you're a small business, a more mobile

7 business, but you should be given some

8 assistance from the City of Philadelphia.

9 So I will work with the

10 Councilman from my behalf and any

11 assistance he needs in moving forward on

12 trying to make sure that you're kept

13 whole as much as possible if and until

14 there's actually a development of the

15 Gallery to make sure. Okay?

16 MS. SALTER: Thank you. Thank

17 you very much.

18 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

19 You're welcome. Thank you.

20 CHIEF CLERK: Ed Boyle.

21 (Witness approached podium.)

22 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good

23 morning.

24 CHIEF CLERK: Commenting on

25 140649.

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2 MR. BOYLE: Hello. I'm the
3 owner of Boost Mobile in the Gallery. We
4 were told construction was supposed to
5 begin in March, and many merchants are
6 staying well through April.

7 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Can
8 I do this, because this is not really on
9 the Calendar.

10 Is there legislation on the
11 Calendar yet, Final Passage, Mr. Decker?

12 CHIEF CLERK: Ms. Lopez was
13 commenting on Bill No. 150110,
14 Mr. President.

15 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: And
16 that is?

17 (Ms. Salter talking without
18 microphone.)

19 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Hold
20 on a second.

21 CHIEF CLERK: It was not
22 related, Mr. President.

25 And I understand your plight,

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2 but we do have guidelines. Your ability

6 You're on the smoking waiver?
7 You're on the smoking waiver. I just
8 wanted to make sure that we're on this --
9 okay. My fault.

10 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Council
11 President, it might be helpful if I talk
12 to them too after the meeting today.

13 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

15 Sir, are you speaking on the
16 smoking waiver bill?

21 wonderful staff and Commissioners, the
22 City will for the first time celebrate
23 the Veteran's Day Parade.

24 So thank you very much.

3 much for being the point person for the
4 City Council of Philadelphia. You're
5 doing a great job on that.

9 Parkside Business and Technology Center
10 there was the first 2015 mayoral

23 The other thing is at that
24 forum, there were over 200 people in
25 attendance, over 200 early in the

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morning, and the diversity there, there were small businesses, community leaders, regular just voters, the media, all in attendance waiting on the responses from these potential mayoral aspirants.

And what I wanted to say was that there are 88 days, about 19 hours left until Election Day, and the issues of education, taxation, economic development, reentry, and public safety are going to be in those forums. We need to ask the hard question, no matter who you're for. It doesn't matter. What matters is that they at least speak to those things with an idea as to where they're going, and I think they're well on their way today. I'm glad to have been able to have it in the 4th Councilman District, but I intend to pay close attention wherever they have them throughout the City and I'm looking forward to the next 88 days.
