4 Services. My name is John Schlotterbeck.
5 I am the Commissioner for Public
6 Property. I am here today to testify in
7 support of Bill No. 070873 authorizing me
8 as the Commissioner, on behalf of the
9 City, to grant to the Southeastern
10 Pennsylvania Transportation Authority,
11 SEPTA, an easement across a portion of
12 certain parcels of land in the vicinity
13 of the intersection of 13th and Market
14 Streets.

15 The granting of this easement
16 will allow the construction of a
17 passenger elevator at 13th and Juniper
18 Street Station -- as part of the 13th and
19 Juniper Street Station ADA compliance and
20 accessibility project.

24 070873. I request that the Committee
25 vote Bill No. 070873 out of Committee

19 MR. HAIGLER: Good morning.
20 Good day, Councilman DiCicco and members
21 of the Committee. I'm Otis Haigler, Jr.,
22 Director of Legislative Affairs for the
23 Department of Licenses and Inspections.
24 Today I'm here to provide testimony on
25 Bill No. 070958, which, if enacted, will

2 prohibit vending on Broad Street between
3 Jefferson and Norris Streets on both

9 enactment of this bill, as this is within
10 Council's prerogative under Section
11 9-205, Subsection (8), Subsection (p) of
12 The Philadelphia Code, and we are
13 prepared to enforce the provisions of
14 this bill should it pass in Council and
15 is enacted into law.

16 Thank you for the opportunity
17 to provide the Department's testimony.

10 comparable to the problem that we had on
11 Germantown and Erie.

12 MR. HAIGLER: Yes.

13 COUNCILMAN CLARKE: And there
14 was no structure. So what we're going to
15 do is eliminate all vending opportunities
16 at this point for the record and then we
17 will be hopefully working with your
18 office crafting an ordinance that will
19 designate certain vending locations and
20 opportunities and specific types, because
21 right now, as you know, fortunately we
22 have just opened up significant retail
23 opportunities, a new movie theatre
24 complex with stores and other things
25 along the corridor, and unfortunately a

 2 number of individuals are setting up shop
 3 illegally and selling the same product as
 4 the person who is paying a significant
 5 amount of rent in a building right in
 6 front of the store. So once we do this
 7 part, we'll be coming back to do a

 10 fine. I'll be glad to work with you.

19 William Erickson, City Planner for the
20 Development Planning Division of the
21 Philadelphia City Planning Commission. I
