2                   COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
3 you. The Committee on Finance is called  
4 to order.

5                   We will ask the Clerk to read  
6 the title of the bill.

7                   THE CLERK: 190353, an  
8 ordinance authorizing the City of  
9 Philadelphia Department of Public Health,  
10 on behalf of the City, to enter into an  
11 intergovernmental agreement with the  
12 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department  
13 of Human Services, whereby additional  
14 funds could be made available to City  
15 Federally Qualified Health Centers, under  
16 certain terms and conditions.

17                   COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
18 you very much.

19                   We note that there is a quorum.  
20 To my right, Councilman Henon, Vice  
21 Chair. To his right, Councilman David  
22 Oh. And to my left, Councilman Bill  
23 Greenlee. To his left, the President of  
24 City Council, Darrell Clarke.

25                   Does anybody have any

3                   (No response.)

4                   COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: This  
5           is an Administration bill and we're happy  
6           to have it. We see the Commissioner  
7           here, and we would like to call on you  
8           for your statement and thank you for  
9           being here.

10                   COMMISSIONER FARLEY: Thank  
11           you. Good morning, Chair Blackwell and  
12           Councilmembers. My name is Dr. Tom  
13           Farley and I serve as Health  
14           Commissioner. Joining me today is Sami  
15           Jarrah, the Chief Operating Officer for  
16           the Health Department.

17                   I'm pleased to say a few words  
18           about my support for Bill No. 190353.  
19           The purpose of this ordinance is to  
20           authorize Philadelphia's Department of  
21           Public Health to enter into a multi-year  
22           alternative payment agreement with the  
23           Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from 2019  
24           through 2024.

25                   Currently, the City of

2       Philadelphia spends funds to provide  
3       medical care for uninsured patients at  
4       its eight health centers. This payment  
5       agreement will enable the Commonwealth to  
6       draw down federal Medicaid funds to match  
7       these expenditures. These matching funds  
8       will then be provided to Philadelphia in  
9       higher payment rates for services  
10      provided at the City's eight health  
11      centers to cover existing costs. As you  
12      know, Medicaid is the program that  
13      provides health insurance to people with  
14      low or no income. Revenue from the  
15      federal Medicaid matching funds is built  
16      into Mayor Kenney's Fiscal Year 2020 to  
17      2024 Five Year Budget Plan, which Council  
18      has before it for consideration and which  
19      the Department of Public Health testified  
20      about on April 23rd.

21               This new payment agreement  
22      requires federal authorization from the  
23      Centers for Medicare and Medicaid  
24      Services, or CMS, which the state will  
25      submit for federal approval in the coming

2           months. It has already gained the  
3           approval of the Commonwealth.

4                     If approved by CMS, this new  
5           payment agreement would operate similarly  
6           to how the Department of Public Health  
7           draws down additional Medicaid dollars  
8           for the Philadelphia Nursing Home and  
9           through the Philadelphia Hospital  
10          Assessment. Because the Commonwealth and  
11          CMS typically approve changes to Medicaid  
12          payment methodologies in multiple years,  
13          the agreement needs to have a term of  
14          three years, renewable up to a five-year  
15          maximum, and is, therefore, subject to  
16          approval of City Council.

17                    Thank you for considering this  
18          ordinance. I'm happy to answer any  
19          questions.

20                    COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
21          you very much.

22                    Are there any questions, any  
23          statements from members of the Committee?

24                    (No response.)

25                    COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Is

17          permit first reading of this bill at our  
18          next session of City Council.

19                      (Duly seconded.)

20                      COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: It has  
21          been moved and properly seconded that  
22          Bill No. 190353 be reported from this  
23          Committee with a favorable recommendation  
24          and further moved that the rules of  
25          Council be suspended to permit first

4           All those in favor of the  
5       motion will signify by saying aye.

7           COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Those

10          COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: The  
11       ayes have it and the motion carries, and  
12       Bill No. 190353 will be reported from  
13       this Committee with a favorable  
14       recommendation and a request that the  
15       rules of Council be suspended so as to  
16       permit first reading at our next session  
17       of Council.

18          Let me thank everyone for being  
19       here. Our business is completed and this  
20       hearing is adjourned.
