11 We have established a quorum of
12 Council and we will now come to order.

13 Despite the need, there will be
14 no invocation today. We will, however,
15 observe a very brief moment of silent
16 reflection or prayer for our city, its
17 leaders, and its citizens during the
18 current public health crisis.

19 We will have a brief moment of
20 silence.

21 (Moment of silence.)

22 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

23 Thank you. Before we begin conducting
24 the business we have for today, I would
25 like to offer a brief statement regarding

2 the scope of the Council sessions and
3 public comment at our sessions during the
4 COVID-19 pandemic.

5 As we all know, Philadelphia is
6 currently operating under a Declaration
7 of Emergency related to the Coronavirus
8 issued by both Governor Wolf and Mayor
9 Kenney. Social distancing rules
10 implemented under the emergency
11 declaration prevents City Council from
12 conducting the meetings in person. As a
13 result, it is impossible to comply fully
14 with the state Sunshine Act, which
15 includes requirements for public comment.

16 Under normal circumstances, if
17 Council could not comply with the
18 Sunshine Act as it relates to the public
19 comment, Council would not act on any
20 legislation at all. These are not normal
21 times, however. So in an emergency such
22 as COVID-19, the law allows City Council
23 to meet and take necessary actions to
24 address the emergency and to support
25 essential governmental functions without

2 strict adherence to the Sunshine Act.

3 This limited power to act lasts until the
4 Governor and the Mayor declare that the
5 emergency has ended.

6 We are not eliminating public
7 comment. Instead we are implementing a
8 different approach, which I will describe
9 later in the session.

10 With that said, Council is
11 taking action today solely in order to
12 speed the process of appropriating money
13 to agencies and people fighting to keep
14 our city safe. We have made every effort
15 under these difficult circumstances to
16 ensure that this meeting is disseminated
17 widely to the public and that your
18 comments will be heard. I want to thank
19 you.

20 Our orders of business today,
21 if there are no objections, I propose to
22 dispense with the regular order of
23 business, except approval of the Journal,
24 request for leaves of absence,
25 communications, consideration of the

3 Thank you.

4 Our next order of business is
5 consideration of the Calendar.

6 There being no bills on the
7 First Reading Calendar, the Chair
8 recognizes Councilwoman Parker for the
9 purpose of calling up resolutions and
10 bills on the Second Reading and Final
11 Passage Calendars.

12 COUNCILWOMAN PARKER: Thank
13 you, Mr. President. The following bill
14 is being called up from the Second
15 Reading and Final Passage Calendars
16 today: No. 200258. All other
17 resolutions and bills are being held.

18 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

19 Thank you, Councilwoman.

20 Before considering this bill
21 today, we will consider public comment as
22 follows:

23 This is our first remote
24 session of Council and our first test of
25 a new approach to public comment. Today

2 is a streamlined version of our typical
3 Council session, and we are only going to
4 consider one item of business, Bill No.
5 200258, which will give the
6 Administration additional funding
7 authority to respond to the Coronavirus
8 epidemic.

9 Today your public comment must
10 concern that bill and that bill alone.
11 In future remote sessions and after the
12 emergency declaration has ended, your
13 public comment may concern any matters on
14 the Second Reading and Final Passage
15 Calendar for possible action at those
16 Council sessions.

17 As we are now generally in the
18 press release and social media and on our
19 website, all speakers must sign up in
20 order to testify. For the duration of
21 this health crisis, you must call
22 215-686-3406 by 5:00 p.m. the day before
23 the session to sign up for public
24 comment. We will take your name, phone
25 number, the number of the legislative

2 item you are commenting on and whether
3 you are in support or against the
4 legislation. We will telephone each
5 person on the list during the Council
6 session in order in which they were added
7 to the list and will invite them to our
8 remote meeting. They will have three
9 minutes to speak.

10 In addition, we could
11 conceivably limit the number of speakers
12 to a total of ten if it's on one
13 particular bill. So we will deal with
14 that as time comes on the particular
15 legislative item.

16 What we ask you to do is adhere
17 to our guidelines, and once the three
18 minutes have passed, you will be asked to
19 conclude your remarks.

20 Mr. Decker, can you please call
21 the first name on the list.

23 MS. ROBBINS: Good morning,
24 Councilmembers and Council President.

3 MS. ROBBINS: My name is
4 Melissa Robbins and I live in Fox Chase
5 neighborhood of Philadelphia. I thank
6 you all for using your resources to allow
7 residents to be a part of today's
8 meeting.

9 Increasingly we, as your
10 evidence and builders, feel a lack of
11 trust with government. I'd like to know
12 how can taxpayers be guaranteed, which we
13 all rightfully deserve, transparency of
14 how the \$80 million will be allocated?

15 We all know it's the front-line
16 workers who are underpaid and overworked
17 and who not only risk their lives every
18 day, but they risk the lives of their
19 loved ones when they return home. Small
20 businesses are taking hits and owners
21 don't know where to go.

22 The digital divide is ever more
23 clear and growing. I'd like to know what
24 efforts are also being made to reach out
25 to residents who do not have access to

4 I'd just like to say I thank
5 you all for your hard work and showing
6 true leadership in such a dire time, and
7 this will end my comment.
