6 Bill Nos. 200285, 200286, 200287,
7 200288, 200289, 200290, 200291, 200292
8 and Resolution Nos. 200307 and 200331.

9 Mr. Stitt, can you please
10 read the titles of the bills and
11 resolutions?

12 THE CLERK: Bill No. 200285,
13 an ordinance to adopt a Capital Program
14 for the six Fiscal Years 2021 through
15 2026 inclusive.

16 Bill No. 200286, an ordinance
17 to adopt a Fiscal 2021 Capital Budget.

18 Bill No. 200287, an ordinance
19 adopting the Operating Budget for
20 Fiscal Year 2021.

21 Bill No. 200288, an ordinance
22 amending Chapter 19-1200 of the
23 Philadelphia Code, entitled "Parking
24 Tax," by revising certain tax rates,
25 under certain terms and conditions.

1 Bill No. 200289, an ordinance
2 amending Chapter 19-1800 of the
3 Philadelphia Code, entitled "School Tax
4 Authorization," by revising certain tax
5 rates, all under certain terms and
6 conditions.

7 Bill No. 200290, an ordinance
8 amending Chapter 19-2600 of the
9 Philadelphia Code, entitled "Business
10 Income and Receipts Tax," by revising
11 certain tax rates, under certain terms
12 and conditions.

13 Bill No. 200291, an ordinance
14 amending Chapter 19-1500 of the
15 Philadelphia Code, entitled "Wage and
16 Net Profits Tax," by revising certain
17 tax rates, under certain terms and
18 conditions.

19 Bill No. 200292, an ordinance
20 amending Chapter 19-1300 of the
21 Philadelphia Code, entitled "Real
22 Estate Taxes," to eliminate the
23 discount for early payment of real
24 estate taxes, all under certain terms
25 and conditions.

1 Resolution No. 200307,
2 resolution providing for the approval
3 by the Council of the City of
4 Philadelphia of a Revised Five Year
5 Financial Plan for the City of
6 Philadelphia covering Fiscal Years 2021
7 through 2025, and incorporating
8 proposed changes with respect to Fiscal
9 Year 2020, which is to be submitted by
10 the Mayor to the Pennsylvania
11 Intergovernmental Cooperation Authority
12 pursuant to the Intergovernmental
13 Cooperation Agreement, authorized by an
14 ordinance of this Council, approved by
15 the Mayor on January 3, 1992 (Bill No.
16 1563-A), by and between the City and
17 the Authority.

18 Resolution No. 200331,
19 resolution approving the Director of
20 Finance's Budget Stabilization Reserve
21 Fund Withdrawal Certification for
22 purposes of allowing utilization of
23 \$34,276,000 in a Reserve Fund for
24 General Fund purposes in connection
25 with the FY2021 Operating Budget.

1 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

2 Thank you, Mr. Stitt.

3 Today we will continue the
4 public hearing of the Committee of the
5 Whole to consider the bills read by the
6 Clerk that constitute proposed
7 operating and capital spending measures
8 for Fiscal 2021, a Capital Program and
9 a forward-looking Capital Plan for
10 Fiscal 2021 through Fiscal 2026.

11 According to the budget
12 schedule, this time was to be used to
13 hear additional testimony from
14 departments that the Council had asked
15 to return. We have no departments
16 returning today. However, we will
17 recess the public hearing and meeting
18 on the bills before the Committee today
19 until a date and time certain. This
20 concludes the public hearing of the
21 Committee for today.
