19 The Chair will dispense with

23 of all members of City Council, I welcome
24 you to our Council session. We
25 appreciate your taking the time to join

5 At this time, the Chair
6 recognizes Councilwoman Miller, who will

9 Would Ms. Dana King and those
10 accompanying her please join the
11 Councilwoman at the podium.

12 I'm being told that
13 Councilwoman Miller is going to be joined
14 by Councilwoman Campbell and Councilman
15 Ramos.

16 COUNCILWOMAN MILLER: Good
17 morning. It is my pleasure to proclaim
18 this day, November 17, 2007, as the David
19 P. Richardson, Jr. Day.

20 The City Council of
21 Philadelphia designates the day of
22 November 17, 2007 as David P. Richardson,
23 Jr. Day and further recognizing, honoring
24 and celebrating David P. Richardson, Jr.
25 for his great achievement as an activist,

2 lawmaker, human rights advocate and
3 political leader.

4 Whereas, David Richardson was
5 born and raised, served and died locally
6 here in Philadelphia; and

7 Whereas, David Richardson was a
8 Germantown High School student who at a
9 very young age became an activist, a
10 lawmaker, a human rights advocate and a
11 political leader; and

12 Whereas, 40 years ago, on
13 November 17, 1967, David Richardson, as
14 an organizer of the walkout movement for
15 African and African-American history in
16 public schools, took a stand and made a
17 difference; and

18 COUNCILWOMAN CAMPBELL:

19 Whereas, in 1973, at the age of 24, Dave
20 Richardson was elected State
21 Representative for the 201st Legislative
22 District; and

23 Whereas, David Richardson, a
24 native of Philadelphia, served 12
25 consecutive terms as State Representative

2 for the 201st Legislative District; and

3 Whereas, Dave Richardson was
4 the Democratic Chairman of the Health and
5 Human Services Committee, the Chairman of
6 the Pennsylvania Legislative Black Caucus
7 and the National Black Caucus of State
8 Legislators; and

9 Whereas, Dave Richardson was
10 also the 59th Democratic Ward Leader and
11 the Chairman of the Philadelphia Black
12 Elected Officials and the House Urban
13 Affairs Committee; and

14 COUNCILMAN RAMOS: Whereas,
15 during Dave Richardson's tenure in the
16 Legislature, he was the prime sponsor of
17 more than 400 bills and co-sponsored more
18 than 2,186 measures introduced by his
19 colleagues; and

20 Whereas, Dave Richardson's
21 legislative record gained him recognition
22 as a proponent of social welfare reform
23 and prison reform; as an advocate for
24 social justice and equal rights; and as a
25 leader in the fight for the rights of the

2 elderly, children, the disabled and the
3 homeless;

4 Whereas, many of Dave
5 Richardson's bills are now law, including
6 his measure repealing Pennsylvania's
7 welfare lien statute.

8 Resolved, by the Council of the
9 City of Philadelphia, the City Council of
10 Philadelphia designates the day of
11 November 17, 2007 as David P. Richardson,
12 Jr. Day and further recognize, honor and
13 celebrate David P. Richardson, Jr. for
14 his great achievement as an activist,
15 lawmaker, human rights advocate and
16 political leader.

17 COUNCILWOMAN MILLER: Further
18 resolved, that an engrossed copy of this
19 resolution be presented to Dana Y. King,
20 Lead Academic Coach, on behalf of the
21 African and African-American Studies for
22 the School District of Philadelphia, as
23 further evidence of the sincere
24 admiration and gratitude of this
25 legislative body.

13 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA: The
14 Chair recognizes Ms. Dana King for
15 remarks.

16 MS. KING: Thank you so much.
17 We actually accept this on behalf of the
18 11,000 young people who are now in an
19 African-American history course in the
20 City of Philadelphia. We are the only
21 School District as a result of this
22 protest in '67 40 years later to have a
23 mandated course in cultural studies and,
24 in this case, African-American studies.
25 So we'd like to thank those young people

2 who protest for this to happen in 1967.

3 But I must say as we continue
4 to move on and look at the education of
5 our children in Philadelphia, a part of
6 that resolution requires that our City,
7 our District educate all of our children
8 to pursue excellence. The
9 African-American history course is only a
10 small part of that resolution. And so
11 we're looking for the continued support
12 of City Council, those of you who
13 represent our children in Philadelphia,
14 to continue to push for better education.

15 So we'd like to thank you and
16 we accept this on behalf of our children.

17 (Applause.)

18 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA:

19 Council will be at ease.

20 (Council at ease.)

21 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA: The
22 Chair now recognizes Councilman Savage,
23 who will present a resolution recognizing
24 the work of Phil Tuckett and Rick Horrow
25 and the Fox Sports Net.

5 The Chair recognizes Councilman
6 Savage.

7 COUNCILMAN SAVAGE: Thank you,
8 Madam President.

9 Today I'm going to be honoring
10 Phil Tuckett, Rick Horrow and Fox Sports
11 Net for impacting not only a local
12 recreation center, but the whole
13 community of Frankford. They have really
14 made a difference in Frankford. They
15 uplifted the residents of Frankford with
16 a brand new field, AstroTurf, NexTurf,
17 the same as the New York Giants have.
18 It's an incredible field. Not only have
19 we made the players and coaches happy,
20 but the people that surround there that
21 don't play sports are happy because the
22 neighborhood has improved, and that's why
23 I'm here to honor Phil Tuckett, Rich
24 Horrow and Fox Sports Net.

25 Unfortunately, Phil Tuckett

2 could not make it today, but Rick Horrow
3 is here, and I also have standing next to
4 me Billy Gambrel, in which he is the
5 playground's namesake. Billy Gambrel has
6 been involved with the Frankford Chargers
7 since 1967, for over 40 years, and what
8 better recipient would be Gambrel
9 Playground for a project as Operation
10 Field Rescue.

11 Also, I have John Butler here,
12 who is the Executive Director of Pop
13 Warner, and he has been a very
14 instrumental person in this project, as
15 Rick Horrow will tell you about that.

16 Recognizing, honoring and
17 celebrating the incredible work of Phil
18 Tuckett, Rick Horrow and the Fox Sports
19 Net in bringing Operation Field Rescue to
20 Gambrel Field and the Frankford Chargers
21 in Philadelphia.

22 Whereas, Gambrel Field is home
23 to the Frankford Chargers, the Pop Warner
24 football team; and

25 Whereas, until recently,

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2 Gambrel Field stood in disrepair, with no
3 grass and littered with rocks and glass;
4 and

5 Whereas, Phil Tuckett of
6 Bristlecone Films and Rick Horrow of
7 Horrow Sports Ventures conceived the idea
8 of Operation Field Rescue. Their goal
9 was to impact and improve the community
10 by renovating a local field; and

11 Whereas, Gambrel Field was
12 selected to be a part of the Tuckett and
13 Horrow Operation Field Rescue; and

14 Whereas, with the hard work and
15 dedication of Phil Tuckett, Rick Horrow
16 and the Fox Sports Net, Gambrel Field
17 received a complete makeover and is now a
18 state-of-the-art football field; and

19 Whereas, the process and
20 culmination of these efforts will be
21 shown on Fox Sports Net starting on
22 Thanksgiving Day of this year 2007; and

23 Whereas, Phil Tuckett, Rick
24 Horrow and the Fox Sports Net are to be
25 commended for their outstanding

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2 commitment, investments and dedication to
3 improving not only the field, but the
4 community as well.

5 Be it resolved by the Council
6 of the City of Philadelphia that it
7 hereby recognizes, honors and celebrates
8 the incredible work of Phil Tuckett, Rick
9 Horrow and the Fox Sports Net in bringing
10 Operation Field Rescue to Gambrel Field
11 and the Frankford Chargers in
12 Philadelphia.

13 Further resolved, that an
14 engrossed copy of this resolution be
15 presented to Phil Tuckett and Rick Horrow
16 as evidence of the sincere appreciation
17 of this legislative body.

18 (Applause.)

19 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA: The
20 Chair recognizes Mr. Horrow for remarks.

21 MR. HORROW: Thank you, ladies
22 and gentlemen.

23 Thank you, Councilman Savage.

24 And I really, really, really
25 appreciate, on behalf of Phil Tuckett and

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2 Fox Sports Net and their affiliates
3 nationally, the opportunity to say a few
4 words to you today and announce a few
5 things.

6 The first announcement is that
7 Operation Field Rescue, which is a
8 national show that is starting a process
9 that will lead to rescuing other fields
10 and gymnasiums and stadiums all over the
11 country, basically started here in
12 Philadelphia. It was a dream of ours,
13 Phil Tuckett and Fox Sports Net and mine,
14 but it took flight for a number of
15 reasons.

16 The first reason was the
17 Councilman, who stepped up on behalf of
18 his district and his political
19 leadership, that caused this process to
20 work at Gambrel Field.

21 Second, Bill Gambrel, who has
22 been the instrumental leader of that
23 facility and at 46 years as a constant
24 source of pride and civic accomplishment
25 for the Frankford community and Northeast

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2 Philadelphia, and John Butler, who is the
3 Executive Director of Pop Warner, which
4 is an organization that is headquartered
5 in the Philadelphia area and also is part
6 of a larger relationship with the
7 National Council of Youth Sports, which
8 services, by the way, 52 million kids.
9 So this is a big process, and we're very
10 happy about it.

11 The specific announcement is
12 that the show called "Operation Field
13 Rescue" will be a national show on Fox
14 Sports Net and Comcast, and it's so
15 important to the network that it debuts
16 Thanksgiving day, Thanksgiving evening
17 and will run substantially through the
18 holiday season. It will be shown a
19 number of times as a testament to the
20 positive aspect of this for the City of
21 Philadelphia and the political leadership
22 by Councilman Savage.

23 Three things I wanted to end
24 with, which I think are very important.
25 First, the reason why this is significant

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2 is, it's a celebration of history,
3 tradition and team work. You all may
4 know the Frankford Yellow Jackets were
5 the NFL champions 80 years ago in 1927,
6 and the Philadelphia Eagles celebrated
7 their 75th anniversary this year. Well,
8 they were an outgrowth, as you know, of
9 the Frankford Chargers. And I personally
10 have been involved in 100 projects, major
11 league, minor league and all in between,
12 but I've never seen the tenacity and
13 persistence and team work that's been
14 demonstrated by all of the people that
15 have put this project together. Clearly,
16 the City of Philadelphia and the
17 leadership of the man standing to my
18 right, the Philadelphia Eagles, Comcast
19 Spectacor, Bock Construction, Pop Warner
20 and AstroTurf clearly, who made a major
21 commitment to put this field in.

22 Second, this is a celebration
23 of Billy Gambrel and the region and the
24 community. When you look at the press
25 release that has gone out announcing the

2 program, it talks about the downtrodden
3 nature of that field, and believe me,
4 when we started the project, it was more,
5 more, more than downtrodden, and because
6 of the Councilman's leadership, the
7 leverage and the ability to not only have
8 over a million dollars in donated goods
9 and services from AstroTurf, from Bock
10 Construction and otherwise, but there
11 also has been a secondary commitment of
12 1.6 million for the ball fields and the
13 play areas and the basketball courts and
14 the water area and the rec center
15 improvements and the walkway. So now
16 this center will be a catalyst for \$2.6
17 million, and this television show and
18 process has been the leverage for that.

19 Finally, which I think is
20 important as well, this process will be a
21 model for future facilities nationally.
22 We are announcing on Thursday night,
23 Thanksgiving night, something called For
24 the Kids. It's the Operation Field
25 Rescue hotline. We'll have a number and

2 a website, and it's co-underwritten by
3 the producers, by Fox and by Pop Warner
4 and the National Council for Youth Sports
5 and their 52 million kids.

6 The bottom line is, we expect
7 to have thousands of interests, inquiries
8 from communities about how to get ball
9 fields and stadiums and arenas done. I
10 would tell you that all of the experience
11 I've had again in the professional arena,
12 there have been over \$20 billion spent on
13 public/private partnerships to build
14 facilities. Eighty percent of them are
15 for the professional athletes. Now,
16 that's been my role in life, and I
17 understand that value, and, of course, we
18 all understand the value of the Eagles
19 and the Phillies to this community.
20 However, this process will start the next
21 step for hopefully that 20 percent that
22 has been spent before and flip it on its
23 head, and we do believe that this is a
24 process that will allow fields around the
25 country and around North America to be

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2 done, and we thank for that Fox Sports
3 Net clearly, Billy Gambrel, Pop Warner,
4 the Councilman's leadership, the City of
5 Philadelphia, the Eagles and this entire
6 process, which will make a major, major
7 national statement. And for my part, I'm
8 humbled and moved, and hopefully shared a
9 small part in this vision as this process
10 moves forward.

11 Thank you very much.

12 (Applause.)

24 as a result of their job. And as we
