2 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Thank
3 you, everyone. Today is Monday,
4 October 17th for the Committee on
5 Finance. Good morning. Before we
6 begin the public hearing, I will make
7 the following announcements:

8 Due to the continued threat
9 of public health from COVID-19, City
10 Council Committees are currently
11 meeting remotely. We are using
12 Microsoft Teams to make these remote
13 hearings possible. Instructions for
14 how the public may view or offer
15 public testimony at public hearings
16 of Council Committees are included in
17 the public hearing notices that are
18 published in the Philadelphia Daily
19 News, Inquirer and Legal
20 Intelligencer prior to the hearing
21 and can also be found at
22 PHLCouncil.com. I now note that the
23 hour has come.

24 Mr. McMonagle, will you
25 please call the roll to take

1 attendance from Members that are in
2 attendance. Please indicate that you
3 are present when your name is being
4 called.

5 THE CLERK: Councilwoman
6 Bass.

7 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Good
8 morning, Mr. Chairman, colleagues and
9 the City of Philadelphia.

10 THE CLERK: Councilwoman
11 Gym.

12 COUNCILWOMAN GYM: Good
13 morning, Mr. Chair and colleagues. I
14 am present.

15 THE CLERK: Councilman
16 Jones.

17 COUNCILMAN JONES: Good
18 morning, Mr. Chair, colleagues,
19 Eagles fans, Philly fans around the
20 City.

21 THE CLERK: Councilman Oh.
22 (No response.)

23 THE CLERK: And,
24 Councilmember Squilla.

25 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Good

1 morning, colleagues. Present. Thank
2 you. A quorum of the Committee is
3 present and the hearing is now called
4 to order.

5 This is a public hearing of
6 the Committee on Finance regarding
7 Bill Nos. 220659, 220660, and 220742.
8 Mr. McMonagle, will you please read
9 the title of the bills.

10 THE CLERK: I'll read all
11 three bills before testimony.

12 Bill No. 220659, amending
13 Bill No. 220401 entitled "An
14 Ordinance Amending Chapter 19-1500 of
15 The Philadelphia Code, entitled 'Wage
16 and Net Profits Tax,' by revising
17 certain tax rates, under certain
18 terms and conditions," to correct a
19 typographical error in stating the
20 period in which a reduction in the
21 resident Net Profits Tax rate is
22 applicable.

23 And Bill No. 220660,
24 amending Bill No. 210284, entitled
25 "An Ordinance Amending Chapter

1 19-2600 of The Philadelphia Code,
2 entitled 'Business Income and
3 Receipts Taxes,' by revising certain
4 tax rates, under certain terms and
5 conditions" to fix a mistake in
6 identifying the tax year to which a
7 tax reduction applies, so that the
8 tax reduction applies in FY2023, all
9 under certain terms and conditions."

10 And Bill No. 220742,
11 authorizing an increase in the
12 nonelectoral indebtedness of the City
13 within the Pennsylvania
14 constitutional limit; authorizing the
15 Bond Committee to sell bonds at
16 public or private negotiated sale, to
17 provide funds toward various capital
18 municipal purposes, providing for
19 appropriations to the Sinking Fund
20 Commission for the payment of such
21 bonds; and authorizing agreements to
22 provide credit or payment or
23 liquidity sources for the bonds in
24 connection with issuance of the
25 bonds, and certain other actions.

1 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Thank
2 you, Mr. McMonagle.

3 Before we begin to hear the
4 testimony from the witnesses we have
5 for today, everyone who has been
6 invited to the meeting to testify
7 should be aware that this public
8 hearing is being recorded. Because
9 the hearing is public, participants
10 and viewers have no reasonable
11 expectation of privacy. By
12 continuing to be in the meeting, you
13 are consenting to being recorded.

14 Additionally, prior to
15 recognizing Members for questions or
16 comments they have for the witnesses,
17 I will note for the record at this
18 time that we will use the chat
19 feature available in Microsoft Teams
20 to allow Members to signify that they
21 wish to be recognized. In order to
22 comply with the Sunshine Act, the
23 chat feature must only be used for
24 this purpose.

25 Mr. McMonagle, can you

1 please call the panel to be
2 testifying this morning for the first
3 bill.

4 THE CLERK: Yes. Can we
5 have Mr. Rob Dubow.

6 MR. DUBOW: Morning. Chair,
7 is it okay if I do all three bills at
8 once in my testimony?

9 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Yes,
10 absolutely. Thank you.

11 MR. DUBOW: Great. Thanks.
12 Good morning, Chair Squilla and the
13 members of the Finance Committee.
14 I'm Rob Dubow, Finance Director. I'm
15 joined by colleagues from the Budget
16 Office, Department of Revenue and the
17 Treasurer's Office. I want to thank
18 you for the opportunity to testify in
19 support of Bills 220659, 220660 and
20 220742.

21 Bills 220659 and 220660
22 provide technical corrections to the
23 Net Profits Tax and Business Income
24 and Receipts Tax legislation that was
25 enacted earlier this year. The

1 changes will conform the code to the
2 rates intended by Council and they
3 were subsequently included in the
4 Five Year Plan that was submitted to
5 and approved by PICA.

6 Bill No. 220742 authorizes
7 the loan for the FY23 Capital Budget,
8 which was approved by City Council in
9 June. This new legislation is
10 slightly larger to account for the
11 amendments to the final Capital
12 Budget passed by Council and is also
13 needed due to some technical issues
14 with the advertising of the original
15 loan authorization in the spring.
16 That concludes my testimony and we're
17 available to answer any questions the
18 Committee may have.

19 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Wow.
20 That was great testimony there, Rob.
21 We appreciate it.

22 Just for clarity, and I know
23 that these bills mainly are for
24 technical purposes for changes of the
25 intent of Council's legislation, is

1 there anything else besides the
2 changes? I know I guess it was in
3 the final bill that there was an
4 additional addage to that language.

5 MR. DUBOW: Yeah, for the
6 loan authorization bill, the initial
7 loan authorization bill was based on
8 the proposed budget from the
9 Administration. This version of the
10 loan authorization also includes the
11 amendments that were made during the
12 budget processing discussions with
13 Council.

14 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Right,
15 and they were agreed on both by
16 Council and the Administration so
17 this change is necessary, so I
18 appreciate that.

19 I will see if there are any
20 questions for Mr. Dubow on these
21 bills?

22 (No response.)

23 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Seeing
24 none, is there anyone else to
25 testify?

1 (No response.)

2 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Also,
3 I'd like to recognize Councilman Oh
4 is present at the hearing.

5 Mr. McMonagle, is there
6 anybody else to testify or any public
7 comment for these bills?

8 THE CLERK: No,
9 Mr. Chairman. We have no further
10 testimony.

11 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Okay.
12 Great. Hearing no further questions
13 from Members and there being no other
14 panelists to testify, we will take a
15 brief break to connect members of the
16 public that wish to testify and since
17 there aren't any, we will move on to
18 ending the hearing.

19 This will conclude the
20 hearing and we'll now go into a
21 public meeting. Being no further
22 questions from members of the
23 Committee and no other witnesses to
24 testify, I'll ask if there's anyone
25 else present in the hearing whose

1 name we failed to call at this time
2 to wish to offer testimony on the
3 bill being considered today?

4 (No response.)

5 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Since
6 there is none, I want to thank all
7 the panels and witnesses for their
8 participation today. We value your
9 opinions. We now invite all panels
10 and witnesses to please disconnect
11 from the meeting before we go into
12 our public meeting. We will now
13 pause the proceedings briefly as
14 multiple participants leave the
15 hearing.

16 Thank you. This concludes
17 the public hearing of the Committee.
18 We will now go into a public meeting
19 to consider the actions to be taken
20 on these bills before this Committee
21 today.

22 Mr. McMonagle, will you
23 please call the roll of Members.

24 THE CLERK: Councilwoman
25 Bass.

1 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Aye.

2 THE CLERK: Councilwoman

3 Gym.

4 (No response.)

5 THE CLERK: Councilman

6 Jones.

7 COUNCILMAN JONES: Present.

8 THE CLERK: Councilman Oh.

9 COUNCILMAN OH: Present.

10 THE CLERK: Councilman

11 Squilla.

12 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA:

13 Present. We now have a quorum.

14 And the Chair will recognize

15 Councilmember Bass for a motion on

16 Bill No. 220659.

17 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank

18 you, Mr. Chairman.

19 I move that Bill No. 220659

20 be reported from this Committee with

21 a favorable recommendation.

22 COUNCILMAN JONES: Second.

23 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: I note

24 that Councilmember Jones seconds the

25 motion. It has been moved and

1 properly seconded that Bill No.
2 220659 be approved.

3 All those in favor of the
4 motion will signify by saying aye.

5 (Aye.)

6 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Any
7 opposed?

8 (No response.)

9 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: The
10 ayes have it. The motion carries.
11 Bill No. 220659 will be reported from
12 this Committee with a favorable
13 recommendation and further move that
14 the rules of Council be suspended to
15 permit the first reading of this bill
16 at the next session of Council.

17 The Chair recognizes
18 Councilmember Bass for a motion on
19 Bill No. 220660.

20 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank
21 you, Mr. Chairman.

22 I move that Bill No. 220660
23 be moved from this Committee with a
24 favorable recommendation.

25 COUNCILMAN JONES: Second.

1 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: The
2 motion has been moved and properly
3 seconded, and the favorable
4 recommendation to suspend the rules
5 for first reading of this bill at the
6 next session of Council.

7 All in favor?

8 (Aye.)

9 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Any
10 opposed?

11 (No response.)

12 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: The
13 ayes have it. It's been moved and
14 properly seconded. The ayes have it
15 and the motion carries. Bill No.
16 220660 will be reported from this
17 Committee with a favorable
18 recommendation and further move that
19 the rules of Council be suspended to
20 permit the first reading of this bill
21 at the next session of Council.

22 The Chair now recognizes
23 Councilmember Bass for a motion on
24 Bill No. 220742.

25 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank

1 you, Mr. Chairman.

2 I move that Bill No. 220742
3 be moved from this Committee with a
4 favorable recommendation and also for
5 a suspension of the rules.

6 COUNCILMAN JONES: Second.

7 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: For the
8 record seconded by Councilmember
9 Jones. It has been moved and
10 properly seconded that Bill No.
11 220742 be approved.

12 All in favor say aye.

13 (Aye.)

14 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Any
15 opposed?

16 (No response.)

17 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: The
18 ayes have it and the motion carries.
19 Bill No. 220742 be reported from this
20 Committee with a favorable
21 recommendation and further move that
22 the rules of Council be suspended to
23 permit the first reading of this bill
24 at the next session of Council.

2 (No response.)

5 before the Committee of Finance
