6                   COUNCILMAN JONES: Thank you,  
7 Mr. President. On behalf of the  
8 majority, there is one request for leave  
9 of absence, Councilwoman Marian Tasco.

10                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
11 Thank you. Leave shall be granted.

12                  The Chair recognizes Councilman  
13 O'Neill.

14                  COUNCILMAN O'NEILL: Thank you,  
15 Mr. President. On behalf of the  
16 republicans, there are no requests for  
17 leave of absence.

18                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
19 Chair thanks the gentleman.

20                  At this time, I would like to  
21 dispense with the regular order of  
22 business to welcome all our guests and  
23 visitors here today. We hope that your  
24 stay here is a pleasurable one, so much  
25 so that you please come back again. So,

5           At this time, the Chair  
6   recognizes Councilwoman Brown, who will  
7   present a resolution recognizing the 2013  
8   Next Generation of Leaders: Rising  
9   Stars. Would Stephanie Kosta, Esquire,  
10   and those accompanying her please join  
11   the Councilwoman at the podium.

12           And joining Councilwoman Brown  
13   we have Councilwoman Bass and Councilman  
14   Jones and Councilwoman Sanchez also and  
15   Councilwoman Blackwell.

16           COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Thank you,  
17   Mr. President. Thank you very much. In  
18   our continuing mission to create what I  
19   call a bench, next generation of women  
20   leaders, I'm thrilled this morning to  
21   present a group of women whom I believe  
22   will be ultimately sitting where we are  
23   running governments, running corporations  
24   across this town.

25           I need to ask those ladies to

3                   These are young women that have  
4    been identified by my office whom we  
5    believe are going to be tomorrow's  
6    leaders. And building a bench doesn't  
7    start the day before, but years in  
8    advance so that we can groom them to  
9    indeed accept the baton for leadership.

10                   Additionally, A Few Good Men is  
11   a 1992 American drama film which was  
12   directed by Rob Reiner, starring Tom  
13   Cruise, Jack Nicholson, and Demi Moore.  
14   It was adapted for the screen by Aaron  
15   Sorkin for his play of the same name.  
16   Many of you may remember it was a  
17   courtroom drama revolving around the  
18   court martial of two U.S. Marines charged  
19   with the murder of a fellow Marine and  
20   the trials that came after that case.

21                   Councilman Jones is here  
22   representing all of the men in City  
23   Council, because it's our view that he is  
24   one of the few good men, along with these  
25   in Council, who believe that women have

3                       So with that, we are delighted  
4       to recognize and congratulate the 2013  
5       next generation of women leaders as  
6       recognized by City Council, identified by  
7       City Council.

8                       COUNCILWOMAN SANCHEZ: Whereas,  
9       since 2005, Councilwoman Blondell  
10      Reynolds Brown has honored the Next  
11      Generation of Leaders: Rising Stars; and

12                      Whereas, the celebration honors  
13      women between the ages of twenty one and  
14      thirty nine, like me, who are on the  
15      incline of their careers and making a  
16      difference in their respective  
17      communities; and

18                      COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Whereas, in  
19      2013, Councilwoman Blondell Reynolds  
20      Brown will recognize eleven young women  
21      who embody leadership and exemplify being  
22      a Rising Star in their field of  
23      employment and community service; and

24                      Whereas, Councilwoman Blondell  
25      Reynolds Brown is pleased and proud to

5           Whereas, Lorena E. Ahumada is  
6   an associate at Kleinbard Bell and  
7   Breckler LLP. She concentrates her law  
8   practice in the areas of complex  
9   commercial litigation, employment  
10   litigation and counseling, and insurance  
11   coverage law. Lorena is on the board of  
12   directors of Raices Culturales  
13   Latinoamericanas, Inc., and is the  
14   past-president of the Hispanic Bar  
15   Association of Pennsylvania. She also is  
16   a Deputy Regional President of the  
17   Hispanic National Bar Association; and

19   Whereas, Shana Booker, a 31-year-old  
20   native of Philadelphia and a 2003  
21   graduate of Philadelphia University, is  
22   in her tenth season with the Philadelphia  
23   76ers and currently serves as the  
24   Marketing Manager. Ms. Booker assists  
25   with the day-to-day operations of the

10   cooking into a career. Later that year  
11   she was accepted into OIC's Opportunities  
12   Inn Program under the chief Charlie  
13   Schmidt -- under the Chef Charlie Schmidt.  
14   In spring 2012, Kristol was named the  
15   Chef de Cuisine of the restaurant that  
16   she helped open in 2006. XIX Restaurant  
17   is an American restaurant featuring Chef  
18   Kristol's cuisine and sweeping views of  
19   the city skyline on the 19th floor of the  
20   Hyatt at The Bellevue. Kristol has four  
21   children, Shawn, Faith, Emani and Amere,  
22   which she absolutely adores and loves  
23   fashion; and

25   for me because you all know Anjali

10 Health Policy. Anjali's family is  
11 originally from New Delhi and Mumbai,

15           Whereas, Brigitte Daniel is the  
16 Executive Vice President of Wilco  
17 Electronic Systems, Inc., one of the  
18 highest regarded African-American owned  
19 cable operators in the nation. Founded  
20 by Will F. Daniel, Wilco has provided  
21 affordable cable and technology services  
22 to low-income communities, governmental  
23 and educational institutions in  
24 Philadelphia for over 30 years, along  
25 with remote surveillance and security

3   Philadelphia area; and

4           COUNCILMAN JONES: Whereas,  
5   Oshunbumi Fernandez is the CEO of ODUNDE,  
6   Incorporated.

7           COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: 2nd  
8   Council District.

9           COUNCILMAN JONES: We know it.

10          ODUNDE produces the largest  
11   African-American street festival in the  
12   country, featuring up to 500,000 people;  
13   and

14          Whereas, Lindsey Glasgow is a  
15   project engineer at Skanska USA where she  
16   has been working on a variety of complex  
17   construction projects for pharmaceutical  
18   and higher education industries.

19   Currently she is working as project  
20   engineer on a major expansion of the  
21   University of Delaware's Eastern Campus  
22   Residential Hall Complex. Lindsey  
23   graduated from Philadelphia University,  
24   in the 4th Councilmanic District, with a  
25   Bachelor's degree in architectural

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2   studies and a Master's in construction  
3   management;

4           Whereas, Stephanie Kosta is an  
5   active trial attorney, representing a  
6   diverse clientele in complex business  
7   litigation, class action suits, and  
8   governmental relation matters. After  
9   graduating summa cum laude from Temple  
10   University, Stephanie received her law  
11   degree from Georgetown University. And  
12   Ms. Kosta is active in many civic  
13   charities and non-profit causes, having  
14   served on boards of directors such as the  
15   Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment  
16   Authority Board and St. John's Church in  
17   Philadelphia, been appointed to  
18   Pennsylvania's Auditor General's Eugene  
19   DePasquale's transition team, providing  
20   pro bono counsel to children in crisis  
21   through the Support Center for Children  
22   Advocates, and is an active volunteer in  
23   the Law Counsel for Legal Diversity  
24   Mentoring Program and with City Year,  
25   particularly focusing on inspiring inner

6           Whereas, Rasheedah Phillips,

8   University's Law School and is currently  
9   employed at Community Legal Services as a  
10   staff attorney in the Housing Unit. In  
11   addition to her work at CLS, Ms. Phillips  
12   has served on boards of many community  
13   organizations and communities -- such as  
14   Communities in Schools, Friends of the  
15   Free Library, and has been featured as a  
16   guest speaker at graduation ceremonies  
17   and workshops to speak to her experiences  
18   of being a former teen parent.

19   Ms. Phillips is also an author, with  
20   several published motivational essays and  
21   short fictional stories; and

22           COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Whereas,  
23   YingYing Shang is a 17-year-old High  
24   School senior and a Teen Advisor to the  
25   United Nations Foundation campaign Girl

8       of Philadelphia, that we hereby recognize  
9       and congratulate the 2013 Next Generation  
10      of Women Leaders: Rising Stars, the

8   and all past honorees for your support  
9   and guidance.

10               Thank you so very much.

11               (Applause.)

12               COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

13   Council will be at ease. Thank you.

14               (Council at ease.)

15               COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

16   Thank you so much.

17               At this time, the Chair  
18   recognizes Councilwoman Blackwell, who  
19   will present a citation welcoming His  
20   Excellency Joseph Nyuma Boakai, Sr., Vice  
21   President of the Republic of Liberia.  
22   Would His Excellency Joseph Nyuma Boakai  
23   please join the Councilwoman and those  
24   accompanying him please join the  
25   Councilwoman.

2                   And joining Councilwoman  
3   Blackwell we have Councilman Oh and  
4   Councilman Kenney.

5                   COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
6   you, Mr. President.

7                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
8   You're welcome, Councilwoman.

9                   COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: We  
10   want to recognize, and they're certainly  
11   invited to stand with us, Voffee Jabateh  
12   from Southwest Philadelphia, Dr. Vera  
13   Tolbert, and some other members of the  
14   Mayor's Commission on African and  
15   Caribbean Immigrant Affairs who may be  
16   here.

17                   We also want to invite a member  
18   of our own member. She's like a member  
19   of City Council for all the work she's  
20   done for us. That's Sade Olanipekun. We  
21   want her to stand with us. She certainly  
22   is Nigerian by birth, but has a brother  
23   in Liberia. And she will be visiting  
24   there next year, so we want her to meet  
25   Her Excellency and the Ambassador, and

2       maybe they can exchange words when this  
3       is done. So come forward, everyone.

4                   And we have our guest Barbara  
5       Simmons, my goodness. So she came back  
6       from -- she's been teaching in Liberia  
7       for the last year. She went from the  
8       Mayor's Commission on African and  
9       Caribbean Immigrant Affairs and she's  
10      been teaching there, and she came back  
11      today. God bless you. Such a pleasure  
12      to have you.

13                  This is a wonderful honor for  
14      us and it is with great pride that we  
15      make this presentation.

16                  As you know, Stan Straughter is  
17      Chairman of the Mayor's Commission on  
18      African and Caribbean Immigrant Affairs,  
19      and the work we've been able to do since  
20      founding it in around '05 or '06 is just  
21      phenomenal across the globe. So we say  
22      thank you to Stan and we love you.

23                  Citation welcoming His  
24      Excellency Joseph Nyuma Boakai, Sr., Vice  
25      President of the Republic of Liberia to

2     the City of Philadelphia and recognizing  
3     him for his dedication in serving his  
4     country and people with exceptional  
5     diligence.

6           Whereas, Vice President Joseph  
7     Nyuma Boakai, Sr. is a public-spirited  
8     patriot and dedicated public servant who  
9     has served his country and people well.  
10    His service to the nation, which spanned  
11    more than 35 years, included various  
12    positions in government, the private  
13    sector, agro-related, church and civil  
14    society; and

15           Whereas, Vice President Boakai  
16    was born in a remote village of Worsonga  
17    in Foya District, Lofa County, on  
18    November 30th, 1944. Vice President  
19    Boakai has withstood the test of time and  
20    epitomized the Liberian adage which  
21    states, quote, "It does not matter where  
22    you are coming from, but where you are  
23    headed," end of quote. He is a radiant  
24    beam of hope for his hometown and a model  
25    citizen; and

2                       Whereas, Vice President Boakai  
3   is a holder of a Bachelor of Arts degree  
4   in Business Administration from the  
5   University of Liberia and Advanced  
6   Management Certificate GIMPA, Ghana. He  
7   speaks English, reads and writes Mendi  
8   and Kissi; and

9                       COUNCILMAN OH: Whereas, Vice  
10   President Boakai has been happily married  
11   since 1972 to Kartumu Y. Boakai. This  
12   union is blessed with four children,  
13   three sons and one daughter; and

14                      Whereas, Vice President Boakai  
15   was selected as running-mate to Madam  
16   Ellen Johnson Sirleaf in the 2005 General  
17   and Presidential Elections of the Unity  
18   Party ticket. Honorable Boakai was  
19   elected, along with President Ellen  
20   Johnson Sirleaf, to chart a new course  
21   for Africa's oldest Republic which is  
22   just emerging from a long and bitter  
23   civil war; and

24                      Whereas, during the 2011  
25   Presidential Elections, Vice President

2   Boakai was again selected by Her  
3   Excellency Ellen Johnson Sirleaf, now a  
4   Nobel Peace Prize Winner, to serve as her  
5   running-mate in order to continue the  
6   development agenda that they have already  
7   started implementing in the first term;  
8   and

9                   Whereas, Vice President Boakai  
10   has continued to work along with  
11   Mrs. Ellen Johnson Sirleaf to restore law  
12   and order in Liberia, to ensure the  
13   reconstruction of the country, ensure  
14   that peace and tranquility exist in the  
15   country, encourage investors to take  
16   advantage of the investment climate in  
17   Liberia and ensure that basic social  
18   services are provided for the people of  
19   the country; and

20                   COUNCILMAN KENNEY: Whereas,  
21   Vice President Boakai also serves as  
22   President of the Liberian Senate and he  
23   presides two days a week over plenary  
24   sessions of that body. He performs  
25   supervisory functions over a number of

2   institutions and agencies including the  
3   Liberia National Lotteries, the Liberia  
4   Marketing Association, the Liberia Agency  
5   for Community Empowerment, and the  
6   National Commission on Disarmament  
7   Demobilization Resettlement and  
8   Reintegration;

9           Whereas, as part of the  
10   philanthropic support to humanity, Vice  
11   President Boakai supervised and  
12   personally financed up to 75 percent of a  
13   7-mile rural village road construction to  
14   Worsonga, Liberia. He worked with the  
15   Federation of Liberian Youth and the  
16   Danish Youth to construct a school for  
17   150 students and clinic for a community  
18   of 10 villages. He also influenced the  
19   erection of an OIC project in Foya Kama,  
20   Liberia, by heading the fundraising for  
21   rural electrification of Foya Kama in  
22   Lofa County, Northern Liberia;

23           Whereas, Vice President Boakai  
24   has served as member of chairman of many  
25   boards including Chairman of the Liberia

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2   Finance and Trust Corporation, Chairman  
3   of the Board of Star Radio, founding  
4   member of the Bethesda Christian Mission,  
5   founding organizer-African Methodist  
6   Episcopal University, and President of  
7   the Monrovia YMCA; therefore, be it

8                 Resolved, that the Council of  
9   the City of Philadelphia hereby welcomes  
10   His Excellency Joseph Nyuma Boakai, Sr.,  
11   Vice President of the Republic of  
12   Liberia, to the City of Philadelphia and  
13   recognizes him for his dedication in  
14   serving his country and the people with  
15   exceptional diligence.

16                Welcome and thank you for being  
17   here today.

18                (Applause.)

19                COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: We  
20   will now call forward our own Stan  
21   Straughter, who is Honorary Consul to  
22   Guinea as well as Chairman of the Mayor's  
23   Commission on African and Caribbean  
24   Affairs. He will make other  
25   introductions and present His Excellency.

2                   MR. STRAUGHTER: Let me thank  
3 the President of City Council, Honorable  
4 Jannie L. Blackwell, and all the members  
5 of City Council for always working with  
6 us. We call you. You respond. So I  
7 want to thank you and make sure the  
8 public is aware of all the work all of  
9 you do to help us. We appreciate you.

10                   Also, I want to just recognize  
11 the Honorable Gurly Gibson, who is the  
12 U.S. trade representative for Libera.  
13 The only African country with a trade  
14 office in the United States is in  
15 Philadelphia. Ms. Gurly Gibson, thank  
16 you very much.

17                   (Applause.)

18                   MR. STRAUGHTER: Mr. Sam  
19 Slewion, who is also the Secretary of the  
20 Commission, and the members of the  
21 Commission here are also here with us. I  
22 also want to get a chance to introduce  
23 you to another gentleman who I constantly  
24 call, I'm sending him e-mails, His  
25 Excellency the Honorable Jeremiah

2       Sulunteh, the Ambassador to the United  
3       States from the Republic of Liberia.

4                       (Applause.)

5                       MR. STRAUGHTER:   Mr. Don  
6       Dennis, who is the President of the  
7       Liberian Association of Pennsylvania.

8                       I want to make you aware that  
9       we are all Liberians in that we have the

17      here with people like Voffee Jabateh and  
18      all of the others here.

19                      So without any further adieu, I  
20      want to say thank you for His Excellency  
21      for visiting Philadelphia.  He will be  
22      visiting Drexel University this  
23      afternoon.  He'll be visiting Lincoln  
24      University tomorrow and visit their

10          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The

11       ayes have it and the motion carries. We  
12       will consider the Resolution Consent  
13       Agenda shortly.

14                  The Chair now recognizes  
15       Councilman Jones for a motion concerning  
16       the bills on the Second Reading and Final  
17       Passage Calendar.

18                  COUNCILMAN JONES: Thank you  
19       again, Mr. President. I move that the  
20       rules of Council be suspended to permit  
21       the use of a Consent Agenda to consider

15                  (Aye.)

16                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

17      Those opposed?

18                  (No response.)

19                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
20      ayes have it and the motion carries. We  
21      will consider those bills on the Consent  
22      Agenda shortly.

23                  The Chair now recognizes  
24      Councilman Jones for the purpose of  
25      calling up bills and resolutions on the

1       6/20/13 - STATED - BILLS ON 2ND READING  
2       regular Second Reading and Final Passage  
3       Calendar.

4                   COUNCILMAN JONES: Thank you  
5       again, Mr. President. In addition to the  
6       bills being considered on the Consent  
7       Agenda, the following resolutions and  
8       bills are being called up for the Second  
9       Reading and Final Passage Calendars  
10      today: Nos. 120340-A, 130182-A,  
11      130458-A, 130417-A, 130455-A, 130178,  
12      130179, 120651, which is being amended,  
13      130180, 130456. All other bills and  
14      resolutions are being held.

15                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

16      Thank you so much, Councilman.

17                   Before considering these  
18      resolutions and bills, we will consider  
19      public comment as follows:

20                   We're going to alter our public  
21      comment today. We have a very lengthy  
22      list. What I'd like to do -- I'm going  
23      to take the prerogative of the Chair --  
24      first I would like to thank  
25      representatives from Unite Here and there

2           apparently is another organization here

3           that doesn't have a name attached but

4           they are together, and I want to thank

5           representatives from Action United.

6           Because we have such a lengthy list and

7           under the rules of the public comment,

8           Council is authorized to essentially cut

9           off comment after several speakers on the

10          same subject matter. So what I've asked

11          those individuals from those

12          organizations is to give a spokesperson

13          from those particular organizations that

14          we have identified. I would like to

15          extend to those individuals five minutes

16          for public comment since you have agreed

17          to condense your list of witnesses today.

18                 On the other page, there is a

19          long list of individuals who indicated

20          that they are here on their own. I must

21          tell you under the rules, if it's the

22          same subject matter, we have the

23          authorization and the right per Council

24          rules to limit that comment in a

25          continued basis. In layman's terms, that

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           means at some point we have the right to  
3           cut that off. I will try to accommodate  
4           as many people as possible, but we do  
5           have quite a lengthy schedule today. And  
6           I don't want to have to cut people off,  
7           but I would like to accommodate.

8                        So, again, I want to thank  
9           those individuals from Unite Here and  
10          Action United and the other group that is  
11          identified here today.

12                       The public comment will go as  
13          follows: For those individuals who are  
14          here today, you will be given three  
15          minutes to speak. There's a podium in  
16          the middle of the Council Chambers.  
17          There is a device on that podium. There  
18          is a light. That light will turn green  
19          when it is your time to speak. It will  
20          turn yellow when you have 30 seconds, and  
21          when it turns red, we ask that you please  
22          conclude your remarks. That means your  
23          three minutes are up.

24                       We want to thank you in advance  
25          for your cooperation, and, again, we

2           really do appreciate you coming down and  
3           provide significant input into your  
4           governmental process.

5                       So with that, Mr. Decker, will  
6           you please read the name of the first  
7           individual. And, again, the individual  
8           speaking for Unite Here will be given  
9           five minutes as opposed to three and also  
10          from Action United will be given five  
11          minutes as opposed to three.

12                       Mr. Decker.

13                       CHIEF CLERK: Earlene Bly,  
14          Michael Mullins, Marcia Teagle, Pat  
15          Norris, and Kate Goodman, speaking on  
16          behalf of Unite Here, commenting on --

17                       (Applause.)

18                       CHIEF CLERK: -- commenting on  
19          Bill No. 130161.

20                       (Applause.)

21                       (Witnesses approached podium.)

22                       COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

23          Thank you. Who is going to speak?

24                       MS. NORRIS: Good morning,  
25          Mr. President, City Council. My name is

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           Patricia Norris and I work at Cayuga.

3           I'm a food service assistant at Cayuga.

4                   MR. MULLINS: I'm Mike Mullins.

5           I'm a parent of two sons who will be in

6           second grade and kindergarten at Penn

7           Alexander School in the fall, and I'm

8           part of a fast for safe schools. We all

9           haven't eaten since Sunday.

10                   MS. TEAGLE: Good morning. My

11           name is Marcia Teagle. I'm a food

12           service manager at deBurgos School and I

13           also haven't eaten since Monday.

14                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

15           Thank you.

16                   MS. BLY: Good morning. My

17           name is Earlene Bly and I am a parent and

18           I also have not eaten since Monday --

19           Sunday night actually, and we are here

20           today to speak on -- we're fasting for

21           safe schools. And I have a teenage

22           daughter who is in Roxborough High

23           School. I also have a grandson that's

24           about to start elementary school in the

25           fall, and our main concern here today is

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           the safety of our children.

3                       We are deeply concerned that  
4           when school starts up in September, our  
5           children will be left to fend for their  
6           selves basically. We have -- you have it  
7           where right now it's just going to be the  
8           teachers and maybe the principal in the  
9           school. Well, what about the support  
10          staff that's going to -- that's there to  
11          help the teachers? When the children are  
12          not in the classroom, that is when they  
13          are at their most vulnerable. When they  
14          are at lunch, when they're going from  
15          class to class in the hallways, when  
16          they're at recess, you know, we need  
17          someone there to monitor our children.  
18          If there's no one there, who is going to  
19          monitor them?

20                     The violence in the schools  
21          today is mainly being kept at a  
22          minimum -- I mean, there is violence in  
23          schools today, but I believe that it's  
24          being kept at a minimum because we have  
25          the student safety staff there. There is

2           so many things that they prevent on a  
3           daily basis. I mean, personally I have  
4           gotten phone calls when my children were  
5           in elementary school about the stuff that  
6           was going to happen that was prevented  
7           because of the student safety staff, and  
8           I'm sure there's parents here today that  
9           feel the same way that I feel.

10                    You know, we need some --

11                    (Applause.)

12                    MS. BLY: We need the student  
13           safety staff and all of the support that  
14           the teachers have normally in the  
15           schools. You know, you're taking away  
16           the student safety staff, the counselors  
17           and others that is there to support the  
18           teachers to take care of our children.

19                    My main concern is that when my  
20           child enters that school building during  
21           the day, that she's being cared for and  
22           looked after through the course of the  
23           day and that she makes it home to me  
24           safely at the end of the day. I don't  
25           feel as though my child is going to be

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           safe walking through the school hallways  
3           during the course of the day, because  
4           right now there's not going to be anyone  
5           there to keep an eye on her. The  
6           teachers are only going to be in the  
7           classroom. Who else is going to be there  
8           to look after my child and everyone  
9           else's child? That's what I would like  
10          to know.

11                       And right now -- we have facts  
12          that tell you that in elementary schools  
13          and in the high schools, those two are  
14          the most at risk. The violence in those  
15          schools like with assaults, with children  
16          trying to bring weapons in and all -- you  
17          know what I'm talking about. Everything  
18          that I am saying is that the children in  
19          elementary schools and the high schools  
20          are the most at risk, and this is where  
21          we need these people at today.

22                       When school starts in  
23          September, I would like to know that  
24          there is going to be some type of student  
25          safety staff, somebody there to keep an

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2           eye on my child and everyone else's  
3           child.

4                   Thank you.

5                   (Applause.)

6                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

7           Thank you so much.

8                   MS. BLY: One other thing. I  
9           would like to invite all the members of  
10          the City Council to come out to Broad and  
11          Walnut and support us. You know, we're  
12          going to be there.

13                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

14          Where? Say that again. I didn't hear  
15          you.

16                  MS. BLY: Broad and Walnut  
17          today. I would like for everybody to  
18          come out and show us some support.

19                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

20          Thank you so much.

21                  MS. BLY: Thank you. The  
22          Governor also.

23                  (Applause.)

24                  CHIEF CLERK: Julie Becker,  
25          Sarah Calderon, Colleen McCauley, and

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2           Debra Kimmelman.

3                   (Witnesses approached podium.)

4                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: And  
5           for the record, I understand they're  
6           representing PCCY; am I correct?

7                   MS. CALDERON: Good morning.

8                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
9           morning.

10                  MS. CALDERON: My name is Sarah  
11           Calderon. I am here -- thank you so much  
12           for the opportunity. This is my second  
13           opportunity to speak on behalf of proper  
14           school funding for our School District.

15                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

16           Thank you.

17                  MS. CALDERON: I am the mother  
18           of four, two currently in high schools  
19           here in the City. I have raised all my  
20           four children here in the City and  
21           educated them here. At my last testimony  
22           two weeks ago I promised to continue to  
23           collaborate with all efforts to restore  
24           the necessary funds for public education,  
25           and I closed my testimony with the hope

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2           that my City Council would pledge to do  
3           the same. Today I can report to you that  
4           I have paid a visit to our elected  
5           leaders in Harrisburg, along with an  
6           outstanding number of parents and  
7           children, visiting Representatives and  
8           Senators' offices, talking to staff, and  
9           speaking up on behalf of our children and  
10          our schools.

11                 After that visit, I received  
12          follow-up phone calls and I also made a  
13          number of phone calls to legislators and  
14          to you as well. I have been engaging in  
15          this task daily during lunch breaks at  
16          work.

17                 Regarding your efforts as City  
18          Council as a whole, I have continued to  
19          receive mixed reviews. Statements like  
20          the liquor by the drink tax didn't make  
21          it out of committee, Councilwoman doesn't  
22          think we have enough votes, the U&O has  
23          been pulled out, Councilman doesn't think  
24          that --

25                         (Audience members booing.)

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2           MS. CALDERON: -- we can make  
3           it through and so on, the type of thing  
4           we can afford to do when there is so much  
5           time. But we don't have that time.

6           The cigarette tax bill that you  
7           all approved will then go 46 million  
8           around the mouth of our starving School  
9           District, but we know that it would hang  
10          by a thread in Harrisburg. In the  
11          meantime, our School District, facing the  
12          most draconian budget cuts in its  
13          history, has already distributed 3,800  
14          pink slips and cut back essential  
15          personnel and programs. If further  
16          enacted, these cuts will compromise not  
17          just the learning environment of our  
18          children and their education, but will  
19          also jeopardize their safety and their  
20          well-being.

21          Budgets passed have set our  
22          School District to this current fate.  
23          Many of our leaders in Harrisburg have  
24          simply failed us. If an injustice  
25          somewhere is an injustice anywhere, this

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2           injustice to our School District is one  
3           against the children of our Commonwealth.

4           I think that given that picture, we  
5           should be able to expect our local  
6           leaders, our City Council leaders, to  
7           have our backs and that of the thousands  
8           of its children and families presenting a  
9           very visible strong front against the  
10          wavering and hostile forces in Harrisburg  
11          and outside of it in favor and on behalf  
12          of our children and their school  
13          communities.

14                           (Applause.)

15                   MS. CALDERON: If at the end of  
16           the day the liquor by the drink tax, the  
17           U&O tax, the cigarette tax, the whatever  
18           tax, any source of funding, any  
19           additional source that can supply funds  
20           needed for truly viable and operational  
21           schools, then I would expect our leaders  
22           to show a strong front on behalf of all  
23           those bills. We know you do -- we know  
24           if you do, and then we will remember that  
25           you did, even if Harrisburg shows

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2           contrary. But if you choose to set  
3           politics as a priority against the  
4           well-being of the most vulnerable  
5           residents of your city, we will remember  
6           that also, and this is a fact, because we  
7           will remember it.

8                        (Applause.)

9                        MS. CALDERON: We continue to  
10          work very hard to make our voices heard.  
11          We expect that you will continue to work  
12          with us very hard and to present a very  
13          united front in favor of our children and  
14          of our schools.

15                      Thank you.

16                      (Applause.)

17                      COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

18          Thank you.

19                      CHIEF CLERK: Ted Stones.

20                      COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Ted,  
21          I understand you're speaking for Action  
22          United?

23                      MR. STONES: Right.

24                      COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I  
25          want to thank you for allowing us to

2           condense our public comment and thank you  
3           for your continued support for schools.

4                   (Witness approached podium.)

5                   MR. STONES: Thank you,  
6           Mr. President.

7                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
8           You're welcome, sir.

9                   MR. STONES: Good morning,  
10          President Clarke and other members of  
11          City Council. My name is Theodore  
12          Stones. I live in the Germantown section  
13          of the City and am a leader and member of  
14          Southeast Regional Council of Action  
15          United, a statewide organization of low-  
16          and moderate-income families whose local  
17          membership totals 25,000 families.  
18          Action United is also a member of the  
19          PCAPS Coalition, which has come together  
20          to make our public school system one of  
21          Philly's crown jewels instead of one that  
22          under-serves and disenfranchises its  
23          children.

24                   (Applause.)

25                   MR. STONES: One month ago I

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           gave testimony before the Finance  
3           Committee to voice Action United's  
4           support for Councilwoman Sanchez's  
5           proposed Ordinance 130161 that will  
6           reform the use and occupancy tax and  
7           raise desperately needed money for our  
8           schools.

9                       In the weeks since then, of  
10          course, the school has made drastic cuts  
11          to programs and personnel and gave out  
12          3,800 pink slips. So I'm here today to  
13          restate the need for Council to pass this  
14          ordinance and --

15                       (Applause.)

16                       MR. STONES: -- and we are very  
17          disappointed that this ordinance has not  
18          even been brought up for a vote today.

19                       I would like to propose on  
20          behalf of the people of the Commonwealth  
21          of Philadelphia and the citizens of the  
22          City of Philadelphia that City Council  
23          would reinstate this ordinance and vote  
24          on it today.

25                       (Applause.)

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2                   (Audience members yelling  
3       "vote.")

4                   MR. STONES: We feel that this  
5       is a very important ordinance and we  
6       would like to know where Council stands  
7       on behalf of this ordinance. So please  
8       reinstate this ordinance and vote.

9                   I am aware that you already  
10      passed the cigarette tax. Even if this  
11      tax is approved by the representatives in  
12      Harrisburg, it will not come close to  
13      filling the gap of \$304 million we need  
14      for the deficit in the school system.

15                  It is time to change the  
16      dialogue about school funding. The  
17      dialogue of how can we raise the bare  
18      minimum to patch a budget hole is the  
19      wrong dialogue. The dialogue we need to  
20      have is how the City of Philadelphia is  
21      going to provide a high-quality education  
22      for all of its children, and we need you  
23      to commit to finding the money it takes  
24      to do that.

25                  Now is not the time to stand

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2           back and congratulate yourselves because  
3           you might have raised a fraction of the  
4           304 million.

5                       (Applause.)

6                       MR. STONES: The people of  
7           Philadelphia, children and adults alike,  
8           are counting on you to keep going, to  
9           find more ways to support our schools and  
10          ensure a bright future for our city. The  
11          use and occupancy tax is one way to do  
12          that.

13                      The current plan attempts to  
14          balance the School District's budget with  
15          high taxes on homeowners and regressive  
16          tax on cigarettes and massive cuts to the  
17          pay and benefits of the people that work  
18          tirelessly to provide the best education  
19          they can for our children under very hard  
20          circumstances. At the same time, the  
21          businesses in Philadelphia are going --  
22          are getting a huge tax break at the same  
23          time big businesses in Philadelphia are  
24          getting a huge tax break, 2.4 million for  
25          Penn Center, 2.8 million for Liberty

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2           Place, 3.4 million for Franklin Mills,  
3           and that's without even mentioning the  
4           property tax abatement that's benefiting  
5           Comcast and other corporations.

6                     In short, you have agreed to a  
7           plan that at best will barely balance the  
8           school's budget by taking money from  
9           teachers and enacting a tax that  
10          regressively burdens low- and  
11          moderate-income people. Meanwhile, the  
12          most profitable businesses in the City  
13          are walking away with a huge tax break to  
14          pad their already loaded bank accounts.  
15          We're not asking the corporations to not  
16          pay their healthcare benefits, not send  
17          their children to school. We're asking  
18          them to take a fair share in keeping our  
19          schools operative and to better our  
20          schools.

21                     (Applause.)

22                     MR. STONES: At a time when  
23           everyone is being asked to make  
24           sacrifices, it is only right that large  
25           businesses in Philadelphia step up to the

2           plate and start to pay their fair share.

3                   The use and occupancy  
4           legislation gave City Council the chance  
5           to step up to the plate and deliver real  
6           resources for our schools. We call on  
7           this body, which has stood in support of  
8           schools over the last two years and which  
9           voted with our coalition for a moratorium  
10          on school closings, to continue taking  
11          its share of responsibility and  
12          delivering for Philadelphia's children.

13                   A few seconds, please.

14                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Yes,  
15          sir.

16                   MR. STONES: Do your part,  
17          stand with us for high-quality education  
18          for all children. Stand with us for  
19          justice. On Tuesday we will go to  
20          Harrisburg and call on the state to do  
21          their part as well. Together, we can  
22          make public education the priority that  
23          it needs to be if Philadelphia is to have  
24          a future that we can be proud of.

25                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

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2           Thank you.

3                   (Applause.)

4           MR. STONES: Thank you very  
5           much. And please vote on the resolution.

6                   (Audience members yelling  
7           "vote.")

8           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

9           Thank you, Mr. Stones. Thank you for  
10          your testimony, sir.

11          CHIEF CLERK: Rebecca Reedman  
12          Moore and Susan Gobreski speaking on  
13          behalf of Education Voters, commenting on  
14          Bill No. 130161.

15                   (Witnesses approached podium.)

16          MS. MOORE: My name is Rebecca  
17          Reedman Moore and I'm a graduate of the  
18          Philadelphia High School for Girls. I'm  
19          a mother of a public school graduate and  
20          a current 11th grader. I love  
21          Philadelphia, but I come to you today  
22          with a heavy heart to talk about  
23          education funding. There are so many  
24          things to be concerned about. Here are a  
25          few:

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2           We are driving teachers away.

3           I know an excellent teacher who used to  
4           teach in the suburbs and chose to come to  
5           the City. He told me that this spring  
6           was the first time he thought, Maybe I  
7           should think about leaving and looking  
8           for a job elsewhere.

9           My daughter will be in 12th  
10          grade next year. Without counselors,  
11          there will be no one to write the  
12          required counselor recommendations, to  
13          share information about scholarships or  
14          answer questions. But my daughter at  
15          least has two parents who went to  
16          college. I'm more concerned about other  
17          children. As you know, many Philadelphia  
18          high school seniors will be the first in  
19          their families to apply to college.  
20          Having no counselors could be devastating  
21          for their ability to get into college and  
22          for their life chances.

23          Two years ago, a family friend  
24          died. Her daughter's friends, including  
25          my child, couldn't concentrate at school,

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2           but they could go to the counselor's  
3           office and cry and talk and sit with the  
4           counselor.

5                       Students and their families  
6           have crises all the time, mental health  
7           crises, sudden illnesses. They need to  
8           get connected to support. They need to  
9           get 504 plans to help them through. They  
10          need IEPs. The counselor and nurse help  
11          families and students stay standing  
12          during these times and to pick up the  
13          academic pieces.

14                      And this you need to listen to.  
15          My daughter tells me her friends at  
16          school all feel, they all feel that the  
17          City has given up on them. I don't  
18          believe that, but I worry about the  
19          messages that we are sending our  
20          children.

21                      Our students are smart. They  
22          know students across the City border  
23          still have all things that are being  
24          taken away from them, music and art,  
25          librarians, counselors, non-teaching

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2           assistants and school safety workers,  
3           after-school activities, enough teachers.  
4           What do they think when they see this  
5           picture? I think they will think that  
6           the adults believe those kids are worth  
7           spending money on, that those other kids  
8           outside the City deserve a decent  
9           education but that the children of  
10          Philadelphia do not. We need to let them  
11          know that they count and that we will  
12          fight for them.

13                   Dr. Martin Luther King said,  
14           "The arc of the moral universe is long,  
15           but it bends towards justice." More  
16           recently President Obama said, "But here  
17           is the thing, it does not bend on its  
18           own. It bends because each of us in our  
19           own way puts our hand on that arc and we  
20           bend it in the direction of justice."

21                   I am here to implore you, help  
22           it bend a little more towards equity and  
23           justice today. Pass the use and  
24           occupancy tax.

25                   (Applause.)

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2           MS. MOORE: Let's send our  
3 children in Philadelphia a different  
4 message, the message that they all, every  
5 one of them, are worthy of respect and  
6 love. They have potential, and they  
7 deserve schools with adequate funding.

8           Thank you.

9           (Applause.)

10          MS. GOBRESKI: My name is Susan  
11 Gobreski and I just want to say one  
12 thing. There are several dozen parents  
13 out in the hallway testifying. And,  
14 again I repeat, at the end of the school  
15 year, instead of just coming through nice  
16 and early when we can count on you, we're  
17 waiting. We've been waiting and working.

18          I'm a little emotional today  
19 because families are at graduation and  
20 they couldn't be here, but they've been  
21 reaching out to you to ask you to do more  
22 than the minimum, more than just a little  
23 bit more than the minimum, but to figure  
24 it out. So we're going to be judging you  
25 not just by what you do but by what you

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2           don't do, and we will be voting.

3           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

4           Thank you.

5           (Applause.)

6           CHIEF CLERK: Sherrie Cohen.

7           (No response.)

8           CHIEF CLERK: Sherrie Cohen.

9           (No response.)

10          CHIEF CLERK: Harry Levant,  
11          commenting on 130182-A.

12          (Witness approached podium.)

13          MR. LEVANT: Good morning,  
14          Mr. President --

15          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
16          morning, sir.

17          MR. LEVANT: -- members of  
18          Council. It was Albert Einstein who said  
19          the definition of insanity is doing the  
20          same thing over and over again and  
21          expecting different results. By applying  
22          that definition, the School Reform  
23          Commission can be certified as insane.

24          (Applause.)

25          MR. LEVANT: For each year, we

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2           come back here facing deeper and deeper  
3           cuts, deeper and deeper budget deficits.

4                     My name is Harry Levant. I'm  
5           the current President of the Home and  
6           School Association at Philadelphia High  
7           School for the Creative and Performing  
8           Arts, better known as CAPA.

9                     (Applause.)

10                    MR. LEVANT: CAPA has a  
11           world-renowned artistic program in six  
12           different majors and state-of-the-art  
13           academics where 99 percent of our  
14           children go on to four-year colleges.

15                    Yesterday I testified before  
16           the School Reform Commission. At the  
17           start of the testimony yesterday, two  
18           groups of students presented themselves  
19           and played two musical interludes for the  
20           members of the Commission. At the end of  
21           these musical interludes, all five  
22           Commission members and Dr. Hite rose to  
23           their feet and gave the students a  
24           well-deserved standing ovation.

25                    Two hours later I came to the

2       podium and posed the following question  
3       to the School Reform Commission: What  
4       were going through your minds as you were  
5       giving a standing ovation to students,  
6       knowing that you had just a week earlier  
7       enacted cuts ending their musical  
8       careers?

9                   This madness must end. I come  
10      here to praise this body for,  
11      Mr. President, you and your members have  
12      been -- had dumped on you time and time  
13      again these ridiculous budget deficits,  
14      and there are many of us out here who  
15      believe that this has become a political  
16      pawn in Harrisburg looking at 2014 and  
17      beyond. If that is so, I urge this body  
18      to recognize that you are our voices.

19                   Right in front of me is a rail  
20      that separates you from us. I understand  
21      why that rail is here for practical  
22      reasons. However, when it comes to  
23      education funding, the arts, safety, I  
24      have brothers and sisters who are fasting  
25      at Broad and Walnut. We are --

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2           (Applause.)

3           MR. LEVANT: We are energized  
4 like never before, and I am here to ask  
5 you to do everything in your power and  
6 wisdom to find money for the District.  
7 But then take down this bar.

8           There are five people at 440  
9 North Broad where there are no checks and  
10 balances. They are cutting on our backs.  
11 You, this body, need to get more actively  
12 engaged so that our music programs are  
13 restored, our school safety, our  
14 counselors, our nurses. If you think  
15 just giving us the money you can rely  
16 upon 440, it won't happen. Please, over  
17 the summer, let your voices be heard so  
18 that the proper restorations, the School  
19 Reform Commission restores what we so  
20 desperately need.

21           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

22 Thank you.

23           MR. LEVANT: Thank you.

24           (Applause.)

25           CHIEF CLERK: Brian Armstead.

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2           (No response.)

3           CHIEF CLERK: Wayne MacManiman.

4           (No response.)

5           CHIEF CLERK: Wayne MacManiman.

6           (Witness approached podium.)

7           MR. MacMANIMAN: Good

8           afternoon.

9           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
10          afternoon, sir.

11          MR. MacMANIMAN: Thank you,  
12          Council President Clarke. Thank you,  
13          other members of City Council. I'm going  
14          to speak on behalf of the airport  
15          extension. I could say that over the  
16          last year and a half, two years, we have  
17          dumped a lot of time, energy getting  
18          involved with our communities, talking to  
19          the residents of the City of  
20          Philadelphia, the folks that matter, in  
21          my opinion, the most, the folks that live  
22          in poverty, the folks that don't have  
23          good jobs. And part of the big fight  
24          that we had was, we had big business,  
25          U.S. Air, coming in and wanting to do

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2           significant business in our city, but  
3           wanted to do nothing with providing good  
4           jobs.

5                       We have talked to many members  
6           of Council, and at the end of the day, I  
7           will concede this battle, that big  
8           business will succeed and win and the  
9           workers will get nothing out of it. But  
10          I can tell you that we are not going to  
11          give up on the battle. We're going to  
12          win the battle, because ultimately it's  
13          the City, the residents of this city that  
14          are going to matter.

15                      We have to -- in order for  
16          people to have an opportunity to start  
17          over, they got to be given a chance, and  
18          when we have big business like U.S. Air  
19          coming in here and creating jobs, they  
20          have to be jobs of meaning, not poverty  
21          jobs. Paying a minimum wage is not  
22          acceptable.

23                      I want to thank every member of  
24          City Council that I've worked with. I  
25          continue -- I want to continue that

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2           relationship moving forward, but we must  
3           do something, and it starts with you, the  
4           members of City Council. It starts with  
5           our leadership of the City. And I'm  
6           asking for your help in moving forward  
7           with this battle that we continue to  
8           remember the number one goal. That's the  
9           people of our city and how do we raise  
10          their standards.

11                   Thank you very much.

12                   (Applause.)

13                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

14           Thank you, sir.

15                   CHIEF CLERK: Markita

16           Morris-Louis, commenting on 130311.

17                   (Witness approached podium.)

18                   MS. MORRIS-LOUIS: Good

19           afternoon, Mr. President --

20                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good

21           afternoon.

22                   MS. MORRIS-LOUIS: --

23           Councilwoman Tasco, other members of the

24           Council. My name is Markita

25           Morris-Louis. I am Vice President of

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2       Community Affairs at Clarifi, formerly  
3       Consumer Credit Counseling Service of  
4       Delaware Valley, and I urge you all to  
5       support Councilwoman Tasco's resolution  
6       urging the Pennsylvania Assembly to  
7       prevent payday lenders from coming into  
8       Pennsylvania.

9                       (Applause.)

10           MS. MORRIS-LOUIS: Clarifi's  
11       mission is to lead our communities on a  
12       path for lifelong financial literacy and  
13       also financial stability. So we urge you  
14       to keep payday lenders out of  
15       Pennsylvania. Payday lenders will  
16       undermine our mission by draining  
17       billions of dollars from our economy,  
18       forcing people away from mainstream  
19       banking services and financial services  
20       into loan debts -- rolled up debt into a  
21       trap that will lead them into a cycle of  
22       poverty.

23                       Please, we urge you to support  
24       Councilwoman Tasco's resolution, to go to  
25       Harrisburg, tell the General Assembly

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2           that Pennsylvania, particularly  
3           Philadelphia, does not need payday  
4           lenders.

5                     They are proposing a so-called  
6           micro finance loan, which is really a  
7           payday loan in disguise. It is a wolf in  
8           sheep's clothing. We ask you to  
9           recognize it for what it truly is, and it  
10          is definitely not good for our  
11          communities.

12                    Thank you very much.

13                    COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

14           Thank you so much.

15                    (Applause.)

16                    CHIEF CLERK: Tyrone McCall.

17           Tyrone McCall, commenting on 130311.

18                    (Witness approached podium.)

19                    MR. McCALL: Good morning,  
20           members of City Council.

21                    COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
22           morning.

23                    MR. McCALL: My name is Tyrone  
24           McCall. I am Vice Chair of the  
25           Philadelphia Unemployment Project's Board

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2       of Directors and a resident of South  
3       Philadelphia.

4                   I'd like to thank Councilwoman  
5       Tasco and other members of City Council  
6       for her resolution opposing efforts in  
7       Harrisburg to flood the state with  
8       predatory payday loan storefronts. Many  
9       studies, including ones done by the  
10      Department of Defense and the Pew  
11      Charitable Trusts, has shown that payday  
12      loans cause extreme financial hardships  
13      in communities around the country. As a  
14      resident of Philadelphia, I find it  
15      extremely worrying that members of our  
16      State Legislature would even consider  
17      allowing these loan sharks to set up shop  
18      in Pennsylvania.

19                   While I'm disappointed that the  
20      bill has begun to move forward in the  
21      legislative process, I would like to  
22      thank Banking and Insurance Minority  
23      Chair Mike Stack as well as Senators  
24      Anthony Williams and Larry Farnese for  
25      opposing the measure.

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2           As an organization comprised of  
3           unemployment workers, PUP stands firmly  
4           against any efforts to de-regulate payday  
5           loans in Pennsylvania.

6           Again, thank you, Councilwoman  
7           Tasco and other members of City Council,  
8           for speaking out against predatory payday  
9           loans.

10           (Applause.)

11           CHIEF CLERK: The next three  
12           speakers in this order, Clarc King,  
13           Chanel Alexander, Joanna Darcus. The  
14           next three speakers, Clarc King, Chanel  
15           Alexander, and Joanna Darcus.

16           (Witnesses approached podium.)

17           MR. KING: Thank you,  
18           Mr. President of the Council,  
19           Councilmembers. I am addressing proposal  
20           120118, the feasibility of transferring  
21           PGW to a private entity. I believe it's  
22           unnecessary right now, and I want to ask  
23           the Councilmembers a rhetorical question.  
24           Can the public, can the general citizenry  
25           own anything? Can they own their public

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2       school system? Can they own public  
3       utilities? This seems to be a movement  
4       to strip all public assets away from the  
5       citizenry as dictated by Wall Street and  
6       the power of private-sector finance over  
7       government.

8                   I ask the City Council to  
9       consider a transaction tax at the  
10      Philadelphia Stock Exchange that will  
11      help facilitate the operation of  
12      government and support the standard of  
13      living of Philadelphians. I wanted to  
14      say that the reason of our national  
15      economy destabilization is that  
16      Glass-Steagall has not been reinstated  
17      and the fed's unlimited bailout system  
18      continues. We have a rational sequester,  
19      the attack on Social Security, Medicare,  
20      Medicaid, unrelenting unemployment,  
21      evidenced national destabilization.  
22      However, we have perpetual war being  
23      funded, and plans are expanded for the  
24      inevitable thermonuclear confrontation  
25      with Russia and China. This is insanity.

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2           We need political power at the  
3 highest levels of leadership to implement  
4 precise daycraft that executes the  
5 stabilization of the United States.  
6 Glass-Steagall, U.S. national banking,  
7 funding the redevelopment of North  
8 America will stop the collapse of the  
9 national economy. We here in  
10 Philadelphia can create the public bank  
11 and begin to fund the redevelopment of  
12 Philadelphia. Be the change.

13           Thank you.

14           (Applause.)

15           MS. ALEXANDER: Good afternoon,  
16 Council President, City Council members.  
17 My name is Chanel Alexander. I am a  
18 Program Manager of Anti-Predatory Lending  
19 in the Community and Economic Development  
20 Department of the Urban Affairs  
21 Coalition. We stand as one of many  
22 organizations, some which you have  
23 already heard from today, as part of the  
24 Stop Predatory Payday Loans in  
25 Pennsylvania Coalition. We want to first

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2           thank you, Councilwoman Tasco. We want  
3           to thank other Councilmembers for your  
4           steady, your continuing stand and  
5           fighting payday lenders from preying off  
6           of the citizens that live in the City of  
7           Philadelphia.

8                       We are encouraged that you are  
9           still continuing to stand and reminding  
10          the General Assembly of the Commonwealth  
11          of Pennsylvania that the current  
12          legislation will not hinder individuals  
13          undergoing financial challenges in our  
14          state, that it will hinder the  
15          individuals because it will keep them in  
16          a trap of debt. The current bill under  
17          the name of SB 975 is masqueraded as a  
18          bill of reform offering micro credit, but  
19          the loans are nothing more than a  
20          long-term debt trap. Profits are made  
21          from consecutive loans taken out, and so  
22          that individuals never have a chance to  
23          get out of the burden of debt. Payday  
24          lenders make their profit this way  
25          through consecutive loans. This puts the

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2       borrowers at risk of overdrafting  
3       accounts. It draws them away from  
4       mainstream banking institutions, which  
5       will leave them at the mercy of payday  
6       lenders in the future.

7           The cycle will continue unless  
8       the State Legislature recognizes the  
9       current PA legislation needs to be  
10      upheld. Payday lending is illegal.

11           We are asking that City Council  
12      stands with the community organizations  
13      in Philadelphia that are working  
14      diligently to build wealth in our  
15      communities, educate our communities  
16      through financial education and  
17      anti-predatory loan options. In other  
18      words, don't give up. Please keep  
19      standing through this resolution along  
20      with Councilwoman Tasco.

21           If this bill passes here, this  
22      is what might meet you in your districts:  
23      More individuals trying to make ends  
24      meet, but unable to because they will  
25      have less viable credit options. More

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2       people will struggle to stay in their  
3       homes. More people will struggle to pay  
4       taxes, and more people will struggle to  
5       support Philly businesses.

6           We ask that you please stand  
7       firm in your commitment in opposing  
8       legislation that will allow 1,000 or more  
9       payday loan storefronts to come into  
10      Pennsylvania.

11           We thank you ahead of time for  
12      your support, and we thank you for your  
13      service.

14           (Applause.)

15           MS. DARCUS: Good morning. My  
16      name is Joanna Darcus. I'm an attorney  
17      at Community Legal Services, and I am  
18      here today to speak briefly in support of  
19      Councilwoman Tasco's resolution against  
20      the legalization of high-cost payday  
21      loans.

22           Pennsylvania has one of the  
23      strongest laws in the country against  
24      predatory payday lending, but the  
25      out-of-state payday lenders are working

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2           hard in Harrisburg to roll back those  
3           consumer protections. In states where  
4           payday loans are legal, lenders target  
5           low- and moderate-income individuals. A  
6           recent study showed that over 80 percent  
7           of borrowers earn less than \$40,000 a  
8           year and more than 40 percent earn less  
9           than 20,000. The last thing struggling  
10          Philadelphians need is high-cost debt.

11                       We thank the Pennsylvania  
12          senators on the Banking and Insurance  
13          Committee, Senators Stack, Williams, and  
14          Farnese, who voted against the payday  
15          lenders bill, and we thank Councilwoman  
16          Tasco for her ongoing leadership to  
17          combat predatory lending practices. We  
18          urge everyone to get more involved with  
19          the effort to keep our existing  
20          protections in place. More information

22                       Thank you.

23                       (Applause.)

24                       COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

25          Thank you.

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2           MR. HAVER: If I could just  
3       have a brief part of your time. I'm  
4       Lance Haver, Director of Consumer  
5       Affairs. I want to thank Council for  
6       considering adding their voice to the  
7       thousands of voices from clergy, labor,  
8       community groups across the state.  
9       Keeping payday lending out of our city is  
10      an important fight, one that we're very  
11      thankful that you're joining with, and we  
12      hope that you'll pass the resolution.

13                 Thank you.

14           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

15      Thank you, Lance.

16                 (Applause.)

17           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

18      Okay. Another alteration on public  
19      comment. We're trying to do our best to  
20      accommodate everyone. We have far  
21      surpassed the number of individuals that  
22      we traditionally allow on the same  
23      subject matter, but I would like to  
24      accommodate you all. I know you came  
25      down here today, and this is a very

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2           important matter. So I would like to  
3           make this -- and I don't want to call it  
4           proposal, but this is what we'd like to  
5           do.

6                       We have ten people left on the  
7           list, and what I'd like to do is to cut  
8           the time in half, a minute and a half, as  
9           opposed to not allowing any more comment  
10          on the same subject matter, so it gives  
11          everybody an opportunity to speak, but  
12          we're going to ask that you limit that  
13          comment to a minute and a half so we can  
14          try and accommodate everybody. Okay? So  
15          we're going to have the list. We're  
16          going to read the list, those ten  
17          individuals, and we'll proceed from  
18          there. And I thank you in advance very  
19          much for your cooperation on the minute  
20          and a half.

21                      We're going to call the names  
22           and you'll just come up.

23                      I was hoping you all would  
24           applaud that, say, yeah, he's trying to  
25           be quick.

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2           (Applause.)

3           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: All  
4 right. I'm trying to be fair, folks.

5           CHIEF CLERK: Commenting on  
6 130161, Anne Bigler.

7           (No response.)

8           CHIEF CLERK: Ron Whitehorne.

9           (Applause.)

10          CHIEF CLERK: Annette Erling,  
11 Susan Clampet-Lindquist, Arden Cass, Tina  
12 Kluetmeier, Anne Gemmell, Denise  
13 Larrabee, Carol Blum, Aviva Kaminsky.

14          (Witnesses approached podium.)

15          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

16 Please state your name for the record  
17 before you begin.

18          MR. WHITEHORNE: My name is Ron  
19 Whitehorne. I'm a member of the  
20 Philadelphia Coalition Advocating for  
21 Public Schools, and what we face here  
22 today is unprecedented. Our schools have  
23 already had their budgets slashed to the  
24 bone, and now we face the prospect of  
25 opening in the fall without adequate

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2           staff to ensure student safety, let alone  
3           conditions conducive to learning. That  
4           we can even entertain such an outcome is  
5           an indictment of our society's priorities  
6           and values.

7                     In our view, we need to do a  
8           whole lot more from both the state and  
9           the City than what is being asked for by  
10          the School District. We need funding to  
11          improve our schools, not simply maintain  
12          the status quo that does not meet the  
13          needs of our children.

14                    The bare-bones five-year budget  
15          plan of the SRC may make investors in  
16          school bonds happy, but it writes off the  
17          future of thousands of young people who  
18          will fall through the cracks in this  
19          plan.

20                    We need funding --

21                    (Applause.)

22                    MR. WHITEHORNE: We need money  
23          to fund contracts with school workers and  
24          teachers that are good for students and  
25          fair to school employees. We can't

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2       forget that teacher working conditions  
3       are students' learning conditions and  
4       that attracting and retaining good  
5       teachers means competitive wages and  
6       benefits.

7                       Finally, I stand in solidarity  
8       with our brothers and sisters from Unite  
9       Here. Their sacrifice is what this City  
10      Council should be all about, and you can  
11      start by passing the U&O bill.

12                      (Applause.)

13                      COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

14      Thank you.

15                      Good afternoon.

16                      MS. LARRABEE: Good afternoon.

17      My name is Denise Larrabee and I have two  
18      children in Philadelphia's public  
19      schools, schools at which my children are  
20      happy and thriving. Like all of us, they  
21      are distressed by what they are hearing  
22      about the cuts to the funding of our  
23      schools and what awaits them in the fall.

24                      I am able to speak to you  
25      today, but dozens of citizens are not

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2           being allowed in this meeting right now.

3           They are out in the hall, and there are  
4           seats available.

5                       Today the Philadelphia Inquirer  
6           ran an article stating that Governor  
7           Corbett is determined to help solve the  
8           Philadelphia School District's financial  
9           crisis. I and many others believe it is  
10          foolhardy to rely on the state to come  
11          through for us.

12                      Last week I went with a group  
13          of parents and children to Harrisburg to  
14          deliver 4,000 letters to Governor Corbett  
15          and state legislators. When the children  
16          attempted to deliver their letters to  
17          Governor Corbett personally, he refused  
18          to meet them for even a few minutes.  
19          Here's a photo of the children delivering  
20          their letters to the secretary. It was  
21          the perfect metaphor for his and the  
22          State Legislature's treatment of  
23          Philadelphia students over the past  
24          several years.

25                      Relying on the state to enable

2           Philadelphia to tax cigarettes is far too  
3           big a risk given the state's previous  
4           response to the needs of our schools and  
5           their aversion to taxes in general. I  
6           strongly urge you to bring Bill 130161,  
7           Councilwoman Sanchez's use and occupancy  
8           tax bill, to a vote today and pass this  
9           means of raising funds for our schools,  
10          for we do not need the state's approval  
11          for this measure.

12                        (Applause.)

13                   MS. LARRABEE: The cigarette  
14           tax is a solution that is likely to fail,  
15           and if it does, you will have failed  
16           Philadelphia's children. An undefined  
17           Plan B, Councilman Clarke, is not  
18           acceptable. We know these are difficult  
19           decisions for you all to make with  
20           political ramifications, but parents will  
21           stand by Councilmembers who stand up for  
22           Philadelphia's students.

23                        Thank you.

24                        (Applause.)

25                   COUNCILMAN GREENLEE: Thank

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2           you.

3                       MS. BLUM: Good afternoon, all.  
4           My name is Carol Blum and I am the parent  
5           of two daughters who attend Meredith  
6           Elementary School. I'm here today to ask  
7           Council to increase funding for public  
8           schools.

9                       This week I've been thinking of  
10          Malcolm X, that controversial visionary,  
11          since he coined the phrase "by any means  
12          necessary." I think we need to fund  
13          public schools by any means necessary.

14                      (Applause.)

15                      MS. BLUM: Now, I'm a pacifist  
16          and I am a conscientious objector. I do  
17          not condone violence in any way. I agree  
18          with Quakers when they say there is no  
19          way to peace. Peace is the way. But how  
20          can peace be the way with our young  
21          people in Philadelphia when we show them  
22          so little in positive regard? We show  
23          them little respect when teachers and  
24          school administrators do not have the  
25          most basic tools for creating positive

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2       environments in schools. How can we  
3       sleep at night knowing we are sending  
4       students the message no more music  
5       education, even though research shows it  
6       helps us to develop our brains in complex  
7       ways and it soothes us into calmer states  
8       for improved concentration. No more  
9       counselors to help you through the rough  
10      patches in life, which we all have,  
11      adults and young people included. No  
12      more nurses to attend to you when you are  
13      unwell. No more secretaries when your  
14      parents need to talk to someone at  
15      school.

16                I'm wondering if City Council  
17      members have to bring in their own  
18      pencils, copy paper, and tissues to work.  
19      I wonder how City Council would feel if  
20      they didn't have high-tech security  
21      systems in City Hall to make you feel  
22      protected. I wonder how well you as  
23      Councilmembers will serve your  
24      constituents if you do not have a  
25      secretary to field your phone calls.

2           Anyway, my point is this:

3       Quakers say that peace is the way. I say  
4       that education is the way to create an  
5       informed citizenship where young people  
6       have choices for viable economic futures.

7           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

8       Thank you.

9           (Applause.)

10          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Is  
11       that it?

12          I understand that there were a  
13       couple of people whose names were called  
14       that were in the hall.

15          CHIEF CLERK: Annette Erling,  
16       Susan Clampet-Lindquist, Arden Cass, Tina  
17       Kluetmeier, Anne Gemmell, Aviva Kaminsky.

18          MS. KAMINSKY: I'm right here.  
19       I'm right here. I'm sorry.

20          (Witnesses approached podium.)

21          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: It's  
22       okay. I just want to give you -- I'm  
23       sorry you were in the hall. We have  
24       altered -- just to briefly tell you, we  
25       have offered the public comment timeline

2           because we wanted to let everybody speak  
3           who was on the list. So we ask that you  
4           keep your comments to a minute and a  
5           half, because we want to make sure  
6           everybody who has signed up get an  
7           opportunity.

8                       MS. KAMINSKY: My name is Aviva  
9           Kaminsky. I'm here with my son Archer  
10          who is starting kindergarten in  
11          September, and his father and I both work  
12          for the City, so we have to go -- we have  
13          to live in Philadelphia, and we bought a  
14          house in the C.W. Henry catchment,  
15          because it was the best school and we  
16          wanted our son to go there, but at a PTA  
17          meeting the other day, our principal told  
18          us that if they only have a principal and  
19          teachers to run the school, she won't be  
20          able to open the school. And the idea  
21          that my son may not have a school to go  
22          to at all because of these cuts is  
23          outrageous to me. And I know that there  
24          are taxes that can be collected. I know  
25          that there are funds that are available

2           so that this doesn't have to happen. And  
3           the idea that we have to go to  
4           Philadelphia schools but those schools  
5           are so completely underfunded is really  
6           shocking to me. And I wanted to bring my  
7           son today so that you can see the face of  
8           what it looks like that you are not  
9           funding properly and what it looks like  
10          for a child who might not be able to go  
11          to their school.

12                       Thank you.

13                       COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

14          Thank you so much.

15                       (Applause.)

16                       MS. ERLING: My name is Annette  
17          Erling. Before I start, I just wanted to  
18          say it was difficult to come in here and  
19          see all the empty seats after all of us  
20          have been waiting outside for hours. So  
21          that was really --

22                       (Applause.)

23                       MS. ERLING: My husband and I  
24          have been in the City for about 20 years  
25          and we conservatively estimate that in

2       those 20 years between all our taxes,  
3       we've probably conservatively invested  
4       \$200,000 or more into the City of  
5       Philadelphia and the State of  
6       Pennsylvania just in our taxes. We have  
7       not only invested money; we invested tons  
8       of time and love and commitment to the  
9       City, and to have this feeling that  
10      suddenly it's all being dishonored, that  
11      while -- my son goes to Independence  
12      Charter School. He's 10 years old. To  
13      suddenly see, Sorry, you already don't  
14      have a gym, you don't have a crossing  
15      guard, you don't have a full-time  
16      librarian, you won't have anything.  
17      There will be a teacher in a classroom.  
18      That is it. That is not honoring the  
19      commitment that we made to the City.

20               Our property taxes are about to  
21      rise about 140 percent next year, and  
22      I've been telling everybody that's great.  
23      I'm so happy about this, because we can  
24      invest more in the City. Pay your taxes,  
25      do the right thing, invest in the

2       children. Then I look at the property  
3       tax map and I see that all of the  
4       businesses around me are going down. The  
5       nuisance parking lot, \$23,000, down in  
6       taxes next year. The apartment building  
7       that never cleans up its trash or chips  
8       the ice off of its sidewalk, down next  
9       year. All of the money that we're  
10      putting in is being wiped out by that  
11      drop in property taxes. I couldn't  
12      believe my eyes.

13                   (Applause.)

14               MS. ERLING: I want to say,  
15      please, please take the use and occupancy  
16      tax and make it right. Make it right so  
17      that the businesses are paying their fair  
18      share and so that the citizens can be  
19      honored for our commitment and our  
20      investment.

21               COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

22      Thank you, ma'am.

23               MS. ERLING: Thank you.

24                   (Applause.)

25               MS. KLUETMEIER: My name is

2           Tina Kluetmeier and I'm honored to have  
3           the opportunity to speak before City  
4           Council today. My voice is a little  
5           horse because I was in the hallway with  
6           my --

7                       COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Just  
8           move a little closer to the mic.

9                       MS. KLUETMEIER: Sorry. I had  
10          hoped to participate earlier in the  
11          process, but most of my volunteer hours  
12          have been dedicated to our kids' Odyssey  
13          of the Mind teams at Masterman and  
14          Independence Charter Schools. OM, as we  
15          call it, is a creative problem-solving  
16          competition that synthesizes science,  
17          technology, and the arts. For the past  
18          few years, it's been entirely funded and  
19          facilitated by parents at both of these  
20          schools. We were proud parents when our  
21          sons' team at ICS took first place at the  
22          regional tournament and competed in the  
23          state tournament in Mt. Pocono this  
24          spring. One of the things that we  
25          noticed at the state tournament is that

2       school districts that invested in these  
3       kinds of opportunities swept the award  
4       ceremony, devastating our kids.

5           Despite the time, talent, and  
6       effort that they put in and their parents  
7       into this endeavor, they just couldn't  
8       compete at the same level. Another  
9       parent told me that the School District  
10      used to support Odyssey of the Mind  
11      throughout Philadelphia, but schools  
12      stopped participating when funding for  
13      programs like this was eliminated in a  
14      previous round of budget cuts four or  
15      five years ago. We've already lost so  
16      much.

17           Not surprising, according to a  
18      recent New York Times article, income is  
19      a better predictor of success in school  
20      than race, confirming both our  
21      observation and our experience in Mt.  
22      Pocono. It's our responsibility to work  
23      together as a community to close this  
24      gap.

25           My husband and I moved to

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           Philadelphia from the Boston area in the  
3           late 1980's at a time when the City was a  
4           ghost town after 5 o'clock.

5           Nevertheless, we bought a house in the  
6           19146 area code 20 years ago this August  
7           because we're committed to urban  
8           communities. Since then, we've been  
9           thrilled by the investments made by City  
10          Council and the Mayor to create a  
11          thriving urban center that's helped  
12          reverse the City's population decline for  
13          the first time in over 50 years. While  
14          we appreciate and enjoy the many cultural  
15          opportunities that Philadelphia offers,  
16          it's the neighborhoods --

17                       (Microphone turned off.)

18                       COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

19          Ma'am, ma'am, we need you to conclude  
20          your remarks, please.

21                       MS. KLUETMEIER: So let me end  
22          by saying that the finger-pointing has  
23          got to stop. Yes, the state should  
24          increase its funding for the Philadelphia  
25          public schools, but the City, including

2           its corporate citizens as well as  
3           homeowners and small businesses, must dig  
4           deep to support our children. Our  
5           property taxes have doubled while our  
6           salaries have declined more than 30  
7           percent since 2008. It's time for  
8           leadership today.

9                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

10          Thank you.

11                   MS. KLUETMEIER: Please support  
12          the use and occupancy tax.

13                   (Applause.)

14                   MR. COHEN: Hi. My name is  
15          David Cohen. I live in Bella Vista.

16                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Hold  
17          on, sir.

18                   MR. COHEN: Sorry?

19                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Hold  
20          on.

21                   Mr. Decker?

22                   Your name -- this is the deal.  
23          And you may have unfortunately been in  
24          the hall.

25                   MR. COHEN: I've been in the

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           hall since 10 o'clock.

3                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
4           rules of Council as it relates to public  
5           comment authorizes Council; i.e., me, to  
6           cut off conversation on the same subject  
7           matter, which we have done -- could have  
8           done about half an hour ago. Because we  
9           understand the importance of that, we  
10          said we're going to take the final names  
11          on the list, cut the public comment time  
12          in half to accommodate everyone who had  
13          signed up.

14                   MR. COHEN: They told me  
15          outside I could get on the list at 10  
16          o'clock, who's ever in charge outside.

17                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I  
18          don't know who told you or where they  
19          told you. I'm telling you what the story  
20          is now. So we have tried to accommodate  
21          everyone who was on the list, those  
22          people that were in here, people that  
23          were in the hall, and we're going to  
24          conclude our public comment now on the  
25          same subject matter.

1           6/20/13 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2           MR. COHEN: So I can't speak?

3           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: That  
4 is correct.

5           MR. COHEN: Thank you very  
6 much. I really appreciate your help.

7           (Audience members booing.)

8           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
9 Folks, folks, look, this is the deal.  
10 Now, I understand how passionate you all  
11 are, because there's nobody more  
12 passionate than the people in this  
13 Council, because we have voted to raise  
14 people's taxes -- let me -- I'm going to  
15 ask you to be respectful, because I've  
16 been extremely respectful today.

17           These people in this Chamber  
18 have voted consistently on an annual  
19 basis to raise taxes, the taxes that  
20 people were complaining about two  
21 speakers ago, because we understand the  
22 importance of public education, and we're  
23 going to vote it again this year to put  
24 \$74 million on the table for schools,  
25 more than we were asked to do. And this

2           notion that somehow Harrisburg won't do  
3           or authorize, I don't know if that's  
4           going to happen. I'm optimistic and I  
5           continue to be optimistic. The reality  
6           is, that \$74 million translates into \$125  
7           million next year. That's significant  
8           funding from a local revenue stream.

9                       Now, I'm probably not supposed  
10          to get into this conversation because I'm  
11          sitting at the chair, but I don't want  
12          people to be misled about what we have  
13          done in this Council Chambers on a  
14          consistent basis and what we are doing  
15          now to provide opportunities for public  
16          education, because at the end of the day,  
17          if you look at the record, this Council  
18          has consistently stepped to the plate  
19          sometimes when no one else has. So I  
20          just want for the record.

21                      Now, with respect to our  
22          process, we ask people to respect our  
23          process. We have put eight public  
24          hearings, eight -- I want to make you  
25          sure you understand -- eight public

2       hearings where we allowed and asked  
3       people to come in and testify on behalf  
4       of schools and other City-related areas.  
5       There was a gentleman who referenced the  
6       rail up here earlier about we are  
7       separated by the railing. There's no  
8       other legislative body in the country  
9       where you can be this close to your  
10      elected official and be able to interact  
11      and have this much opportunity to have a  
12      process where you're allowed to have  
13      input into the process anywhere. And I'm  
14      proud about the fact that you have this  
15      opportunity to come to your City Council,  
16      because at the end of the day, we're here  
17      because you all supported us.

18                So with respect to the process,  
19      I ask that you please respect our  
20      process. We have had a significant  
21      number of speakers. We've had a  
22      significant number of public hearings,  
23      and we will continue this dialogue,  
24      because at the end of the day, as was  
25      referenced by a speaker earlier, guess

2           what, the \$300 million that the SRC is  
3           asking for is not enough. We clearly  
4           understand it's not enough, but it's to  
5           allow us to continue our education as is.  
6           And that's not enough. This City Council  
7           will continue to be involved in the  
8           process, as we currently are, for the  
9           broader picture, because at the end of  
10          the day, you have to have a sustained  
11          revenue stream to get some continuity in  
12          the school system, which we do not,  
13          because it's been an annual budget by  
14          crisis, and we got to stop that.

15                 So with respect to us, I ask  
16          that you please respect our process, and  
17          we will make sure that we do what we need  
18          to to continue for public education.

19                 MR. COHEN: I talked about this  
20          yesterday. They said show up at 10:30.

21                 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Sir,  
22          and I apologize for that. I will take  
23          that responsibility. I apologize for  
24          that. But we have to move on because we  
25          do have business to conclude today. And,

2 again, I want to thank you for coming  
3 down today, sir.

4 MR. COHEN: Thank you for  
5 letting me speak. I appreciate it.

6 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

8 So that would conclude our  
9 public comment. I will ask Mr. Decker to  
10 please read the titles of all the  
11 resolutions on the Consent Agenda. After  
12 each title is read --

13 (Audience members yelling.)

15 Folks, I'm telling you, please. Let us  
16 conclude our business.

17 I will ask Mr. Decker to please

18          adopted.

19                   CHIEF CLERK:   And Resolution  
20          No. 130508, entitled "A resolution

24          introduced by Councilwoman Bass.

25                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:   The

3                   COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you,

23                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
24       Chair recognizes Councilwoman Bass.

25                  COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you,

5                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: It's

11                   (No response.)

12                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The

15                   CHIEF CLERK: And Resolution

21                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
22          Chair again recognizes Councilwoman Bass.

23                   COUNCILWOMAN BASS: And thank  
24          you, Mr. President. I move for the  
25          adoption of the resolution.

3                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: It's  
4                   been moved and properly seconded.

5                   All those in favor?

6                   (Aye.)

10                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
11                  ayes have it, and that resolution is  
12                  adopted.

13                  CHIEF CLERK: There are no  
14                  other resolutions on the Final Passage  
15                  Calendar, Mr. President.

16                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
17                  Thank you very much, Mr. Decker.

18                  Are there any speeches on the  
19                  part of the minority?

20                  (No response.)

21                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Are  
22                  there any speeches on the part of the  
23                  majority?

24                  The Chair recognizes Councilman  
25                  Kenney.

2                   COUNCILMAN KENNEY: Thank you,  
3                   Mr. President. I just wanted to make an  
4                   announcement and to wish who will be a  
5                   former staff person tomorrow well in her  
6                   new endeavors. Stephanie Roza, who has  
7                   been our Legislative Assistant here for a  
8                   year and a half or so, is leaving us.  
9                   It's her last session today and her last  
10                  day of work tomorrow. She will be  
11                  getting married next week and will be  
12                  moving to Boston to continue her  
13                  education at a little known school called  
14                  Harvard University.

15                  So we want to thank her for all  
16                  her hard work and to wish her well on her  
17                  new endeavors.

18                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

19                  Thank you. Congratulations.

20                  (Applause.)

21                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
22                  Chair recognizes Councilman Jones.

23                  COUNCILMAN JONES: Again,  
24                  Mr. President, another good session in  
25                  Council. It's difficult handling the

2       people's business, but well worth it in  
3       the end. I, like you, have faith that  
4       the state will do the right thing. We  
5       have done our best to do the right thing,  
6       and I want to recognize the fact that  
7       yesterday was Juneteenth, which is the  
8       celebration of the final emancipation of  
9       slaves in this country that happened two  
10      and a half years after President Lincoln  
11      declared the Emancipation Proclamation.

12                   I think it's not by chance that  
13      we are talking about something so  
14      worthwhile as public education that was  
15      prohibited to most slaves during the  
16      country. So the heavy lifting, the  
17      shouting, the arguing, the debating, the  
18      discussion about which way to help our  
19      children is all worthwhile in the end,  
20      and I thank you for courageously leading  
21      this body to help our young people of all  
22      colors, and I think President Lincoln  
23      would be proud of you right about now.

24                   Thank you.

25                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

2           Thank you, Councilman. I'm not  
3           necessarily looking forward to President  
4           Lincoln's -- there may be some people  
5           that were here today that might actually  
6           want to do that right now, but I take it  
7           in a good spirit. Thank you. Thank you,  
8           Councilman.

9                   Councilman O'Brien, you raised  
10          your hand.

11                   COUNCILMAN O'BRIEN: Yes.

12                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: You  
13          want to concur with me, sir?

14                   COUNCILMAN O'BRIEN: Yes, I  
15          would like to concur with you.

16                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I  
17          got some other people teed up.  
18          Councilman O'Brien is in the minority.  
19          They came first. Councilman, go ahead.  
20          Are you okay?

21                   COUNCILMAN O'BRIEN: I'd like  
22          to speak, if that's okay, Mr. President.

23                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: All  
24          right. Well, can you go and --

25                   COUNCILMAN O'BRIEN: I'm very

2           patient. I can wait.

3                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I've  
4           been dealing with people in line all day  
5           and I'm a little wobbled by it. Let me  
6           get Councilwoman Brown. I'll get to you,  
7           Councilman.

8                   Councilwoman Brown.

9                   COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Thank you,  
10          Mr. President. Vice President Biden  
11          said, "Don't tell me what you value.  
12          Show me your budget and I'll tell you  
13          what you value."

14                   Repeatedly we've mentioned how  
15          young people learn to read from K through  
16          3 and then from 4th grade on, they read  
17          to learn. Stats, practices, and  
18          tendencies tell us that if young people  
19          are not reading by 6th grade, truancy  
20          kicks in. And we know that for every 100  
21          young people that enter our schools in  
22          9th grade, 45 of them will be gone by the  
23          end of 12th grade. For those who drop  
24          out, we know that they do not gain  
25          employment, and too often it leads to

2           drugs, violence, and too often it leads  
3           to incarceration.

4                   The set of facts provides an  
5           easy roadmap when considering the budget.  
6           We've pleaded repeatedly since we heard  
7           the School District's address that we  
8           need to invest in schools, and I join  
9           Councilman Jones and others who want to  
10          say thank you for putting that ball now  
11          at the foot of Governor Corbett.

12                   Governor Corbett's proposed  
13          budget spends 14 percent more on  
14          correction than higher education, and  
15          once again, Pennsylvania will be  
16          investing more in the state pen than we  
17          do in Penn State. His administration is  
18          also starting construction on two new  
19          prisons in Montgomery County, costing  
20          over \$400 million for 4,000 prison beds,  
21          while 23 schools have to close and  
22          thousands of layoffs persist in the  
23          District.

24                   On the Governor's website, it  
25          says, "Governor Corbett's proposed budget

2           makes historic investment in  
3           Pennsylvania's students and schools.  
4           These investments are a reflection of the  
5           Governor's commitment to ensure that  
6           Pennsylvania can compete in the new  
7           global economy with a trained and  
8           educated workforce," end quote.

9                   That sounds fabulous; does it  
10          not? But, again, Vice President said it  
11          best, "Don't tell me what you value.  
12          Show me your budget and I'll tell you  
13          what you value."

14                  We appreciate the important  
15          work you've led on in these Chambers  
16          around the issue of funding our  
17          Philadelphia public schools,  
18          Mr. President.

19                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

20          Thank you, Councilwoman.

21                  The Chair recognizes Councilman  
22          Squilla.

23                   COUNCILMAN SQUILLA: Thank you,  
24          Mr. President. I'd like to second what  
25          my colleagues have said about your

2       leadership and how important it is to  
3       have a leadership on Council that we're  
4       all able to work with and all our ideas  
5       are heard and listened to, and not that  
6       we always get everything that we want and  
7       everything that we need passed, but it is  
8       great to have a Council like this willing  
9       to listen and work together.

10                   During the AVI process, you  
11       heard me say a lot of different things  
12       and mainly the issue of assessments and  
13       fairness and accuracy. I still believe  
14       today that -- I know we passed AVI out,  
15       and I believe that there are still some  
16       inequities and unfairness in assessments  
17       that need to be looked at. I appreciate  
18       Council's vote on my tolling legislation  
19       that enabled anyone who does appeal their  
20       assessment would have to pay just last  
21       year's tax due and then would have to pay  
22       the rest depending on whenever their  
23       appeal is completed. But I still have  
24       some concerns about the legislation that  
25       we passed, and I'm just going to cite a

2           couple things from Coleman versus Green,  
3           the consent decree that was May 18, 1981.  
4           It just shows that according to this  
5           decree that where it says "Whereas,  
6           abandonment of the principles of  
7           graduations embodied in the consent  
8           decree will cause severe economic and  
9           administrative dislocations as well as  
10          undue hardship on certain citizens." And  
11          I believe AVI, the way it is set forth at  
12          this time, is doing that because of the  
13          assessments that are not only inaccurate,  
14          but unfair. And in the end, the Board  
15          essentially argues that an abrupt  
16          imposition of the mandate uniformity  
17          would cause severe administrative and  
18          economic dislocations. Courts in  
19          Pennsylvania and other jurisdictions have  
20          filed the gradualist approach, imposing  
21          reforms in tax assessments. Failure to  
22          follow a gradualist approach will cause  
23          Act No. 271 to violate the equal  
24          protection clause, because requiring  
25          immediate uniformity will

2           unconstitutionally discriminate against a  
3           class of moderate- and low-income  
4           families.

5                   So knowing that I believe that,  
6           I know this Council has passed AVI in its  
7           current form. I still believe that there  
8           are possibilities for that to change,  
9           but, again, I do want to thank you for  
10          your leadership and everything you have  
11          done this Council session, and I really  
12          appreciate it and look forward to working  
13          to next Council year.

14                   Thank you.

15                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

16          Thank you, Councilman, so much.

17                   The Chair recognizes Councilman  
18          Johnson.

19                   COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Thank you,  
20          Mr. President. I want to also echo the  
21          sentiments of my colleagues regarding the  
22          issue of education and really recognizing  
23          all of us in here understand the  
24          importance of it, but also stepping up to  
25          the plate and really looking at what can

2           we do differently.

3                   The definition of insanity is  
4           doing the same thing over and over  
5           expecting a different result. And in  
6           this particular case, it gives us an  
7           opportunity to see how can we come up  
8           with a long-term funding solution to  
9           address the issue of education, because  
10          quite honestly, we would be in the same  
11          predicament next year. And so hopefully  
12          throughout the summer, with the Chair of  
13          Education and I don't have a problem  
14          following up with you, Council President,  
15          as well as the members of the Education  
16          Committee to really begin grappling and  
17          putting our head together to kind of look  
18          at what's the long-term plan, what are we  
19          going to do to make sure that next year  
20          we're not in the same, as you mentioned  
21          earlier, crisis mode as it relates to the  
22          issue of public education, and what are  
23          some of the best practices that will  
24          enable us to get over to the hump so we  
25          can be able to fund public education as

2           efficiently and effectively as it should  
3           be.

4                   But as the ball is now on the  
5           state level, because we did do a lot of  
6           heavy lifting, I do acknowledge the  
7           partnership you formed with the  
8           Philadelphia delegation on the Senate  
9           side, acknowledging State Senator Anthony  
10          Hardy Williams for the heavy politicking  
11          that he has been doing in Harrisburg on  
12          the republican side. And I think a lot  
13          of times the work that he does as it  
14          relates to specifically public education  
15          isn't acknowledged, but I do know over  
16          the last couple weeks specifically, he  
17          has been politicking very hard in the  
18          Senate. And I acknowledge Cherelle  
19          Parker on the House side. And so  
20          hopefully as we continue to move forward,  
21          I remain optimistic that we will find a  
22          solution to the issue of funding public  
23          education.

24                   But on the issue of AVI, and I  
25          met with some constituents yesterday,

2           still talking about how this is going to  
3           have a significant impact on individuals  
4           primarily in the 2nd Councilmanic  
5           District who are low- and moderate-income  
6           and also individuals who are from  
7           working-class families who will be  
8           significantly impacted by the flawed  
9           implementation, from my perspective, of  
10          AVI. And so we will continue to work  
11          throughout the summer. I have an AVI  
12          town hall meeting that's going to be  
13          coming up in Southwest Philadelphia to  
14          explain to my constituents the various  
15          relief measures that we have introduced,  
16          but this will be a long-term process for  
17          us to make sure that individuals do not  
18          lose their homes, to make sure that  
19          individuals do have the means to also pay  
20          their tax bill.

21                   And so I just wanted to state  
22                   that for the record, that we will  
23                   continuously advocate on this issue.

24                   Thank you very much,  
25                   Mr. President.

3           Thank you, sir.

4                   The Chair recognizes  
5           Councilwoman Sanchez.

6                   COUNCILWOMAN SANCHEZ: Thank  
7           you, Mr. President. I too want to echo  
8           the sentiments of my colleagues. Who  
9           would have thought three years later we  
10          are still grappling with a crisis mode  
11          around how we fund public education? And  
12          in the middle of that, we're faced with  
13          the massive reform of AVI. And while AVI  
14          is imperfect, and I've learned to vote on  
15          many imperfect pieces of legislation in  
16          this Council in my tenure, we did find  
17          ways to protect folks through homestead,  
18          through deferrals, through the appeals  
19          process. We did the best we can with the  
20          tools that we have.

21                   Over the last 48 hours, we've  
22          received some very positive movement in  
23          Harrisburg, and I feel strongly that we  
24          have a small window of opportunity on the  
25          heels of an election next year that our

2           state delegation in this very public  
3           discussion about the conditions of our  
4           schools is the perfect storm to get  
5           Harrisburg to fulfill its obligation of  
6           our schools.

7                   What is going on in Harrisburg  
8           is historic in nature. All hands are on  
9           deck. Our Mayor, our Council leadership,  
10          our state delegation, our business  
11          community, and finally, as stated today  
12          in a very public way, Governor Corbett  
13          has acknowledged that Philadelphia and  
14          our children deserve additional funding.

15                   I want to thank all of the  
16          teachers, staff, parents, and students,  
17          especially those students who came in  
18          this Council and articulated sometimes  
19          better than our adults the crossroads in  
20          which we find ourselves in public  
21          education.

22                   I want to thank my Council  
23          colleagues and take them on the challenge  
24          that as soon as we finish this budget  
25          process, we begin to have a discussion,

2           not about a bare-bones budget but what we  
3           believe our values to be around public  
4           education.

5                   I would be remiss not to  
6           mention Dr. Hite and his team, who have  
7           made tough choices and have helped us  
8           present a good case to the federal,  
9           state, and city stakeholders. I want to  
10          echo what my colleague Blondell Reynolds  
11          said about our brave Unite fasting  
12          activists. Earlene Bly, Patricia Norris,  
13          Michael Mullins, Marcia Teagle are the  
14          face to our challenges and what we face.

15                   Over the next couple of months,  
16          as the dust settles, we will be reminded  
17          that we have another obligation. I don't  
18          want it to come as a surprise to anyone  
19          that next year we will be talking about  
20          long-term funding for the public  
21          education system. It, by no means, allow  
22          us to discuss the problems and the  
23          challenges that we still face in this  
24          bare-bones budget.

25                   I want to thank my Council

2           colleagues who, for a third year, as  
3           outlined by you, Council President, has  
4           not shied away from doing the heavy  
5           lifting. We are in line to provide  
6           74-plus million dollars to the schools  
7           over what they requested. Today as we  
8           bring our budget process to a close, all  
9           of us here, those who are here and who  
10          testified, those within listening ears,  
11          need to continue to join together and  
12          target all of our energies at Harrisburg.  
13          Corbett has to do more. Our Philadelphia  
14          Senate and House delegation have been  
15          steadfast in carrying our message and  
16          shepherding our request. I also want to  
17          thank them for the collaborative effort  
18          in which they work with our respective  
19          body.

20                   Today, united, we need to send  
21          the message, the people, we the people,  
22          the children, who have been phenomenal  
23          through all of this, will do whatever it  
24          takes. I look forward to that continuing  
25          discussion as we define and some of us

2           will say have to redefine what a common  
3           vision of good public education should  
4           be. I am so proud of everyone in their  
5           efforts. I've never felt prouder to be a  
6           Philadelphian and for my service -- my  
7           public service and my commitment to  
8           public education.

9                   Thank you, Council President.

10                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

11           Thank you, Councilwoman.

12                  The Chair recognizes Councilman  
13           Jones.

14                  Okay. Never mind.

15                  COUNCILMAN JONES: If you  
16           wanted me to say something else.

17                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: No.  
18           That's all right.

19                  COUNCILMAN JONES: All right.

20                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

21           Okay. I'm just following the screen.

22                  Councilman O'Brien, did you  
23           want to speak? If you did --

24                  COUNCILMAN O'BRIEN: Yes, I do.

25                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: We

2           got more one and then can you queue it  
3           up. I'm going to recognize Councilman  
4           Green first.

5                   COUNCILMAN GREEN: Thank you,  
6           Mr. President. I just wanted to talk  
7           briefly about the budget process or  
8           actually budgeting in the City of  
9           Philadelphia as we pass a budget today.  
10          We don't always agree on budgets, but  
11          there is one that passed Council today,  
12          and it was based on 2,000 separate  
13          spreadsheets, which is how our budget is  
14          put together. There is no integrated  
15          financial package or budgeting system for  
16          the City of Philadelphia, which is a --  
17          we spend between capital and operating  
18          budgets over \$4 billion a year. That is  
19          absolutely ridiculous, and we have this  
20          spring passed some measures in City  
21          Council that hopefully will lead to the  
22          requirement to have a financial package  
23          and allow us to be presented with a  
24          different way to look at the budget and  
25          judge the budget.

2                   For example, a Charter change  
3 was passed several years ago that allowed  
4 us to state specific requirements that we  
5 want from the Administration on an annual  
6 basis when the budget is presented to us,  
7 and we passed a program-based budgeting  
8 requirement, which will have a zero base  
9 goal the first year. The Administration  
10 is committed to start to present a  
11 program-based budget next fiscal year,  
12 and by 2015, we will see a full  
13 program-based budget from the zero base  
14 that has -- and the capital budget they  
15 will be required to present to us a  
16 cost-benefit analysis of each capital  
17 expenditure that is going to be spent,  
18 and I think -- I hope that these efforts  
19 that passed Council this spring will lead  
20 us to a financial package that allows  
21 program-based budgeting, a cost-benefit  
22 analysis to be shared, and makes the data  
23 with respect to budgeting and with  
24 respect to each program, not department,  
25 far more transparent to us and the

2           public.

3                   Thank you, Mr. President.

4                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

5           Thank you, Councilman.

6                   Councilman O'Brien.

7                   COUNCILMAN O'BRIEN: All ready,  
8           Mr. President? I'm only kidding. Thank  
9           you, Mr. President.

10                   Once again, I would like to  
11           remind everyone that in the last week,  
12           303 violent crimes were reported to the  
13           Philadelphia Police Department. This  
14           number includes three homicides, 50 gun  
15           robberies, and 37 assaults with a gun.

16                   Since the start of 2013, 109  
17           families lost a loved one due to violence  
18           in our city. I'm pleased to see these  
19           numbers are down from this time a year  
20           ago, but I hope the trend continues with  
21           the warmer weather.

22                   With that said, I believe we  
23           can do better. I believe the focused  
24           deterrence strategy can help us drive  
25           those numbers down even lower. I believe

2           we need to utilize smarter ways to stop  
3           the senseless end of so many lives and  
4           the destruction of families across our  
5           city.

6                   The focused deterrence strategy  
7           has repeatedly demonstrated that serious  
8           violence can be dramatically reduced when  
9           law enforcement, community members, and  
10          social service providers join together to  
11          directly engage with violent street  
12          groups to clearly communicate three  
13          things. One, a law enforcement message  
14          that future violence will be met with  
15          clear and predictable consequences; two,  
16          a community moral message that violence  
17          will no longer be tolerated; and,  
18          finally, three, a genuine offer to help  
19          those who want it.

20                   I believe we need to invest in  
21          the sustainability of focused deterrence  
22          and create a permanent structure to  
23          organize and administer the strategy.

24                   I would like to recognize  
25          Councilman Kenyatta Johnson and

2           Councilman Mark Squilla for their  
3           personal and fiscal support of this  
4           initiative. I look forward to hearings  
5           in the fall to explore a wider-scale  
6           implementation of focused deterrence to  
7           make Philadelphia a better and safer  
8           place.

9                   Finally, Mr. President, I would  
10          like to talk about the resolution I  
11          introduced today. The Pennsylvania Board  
12          of Probation and Parole presents an  
13          identifiable threat to public safety,  
14          most noticeably in Philadelphia. I  
15          believe public safety should be the  
16          Board's guiding priority, but I fear it  
17          is not. The Board is reckless in  
18          handling parole violations, irresponsible  
19          when assigning huge parole agent  
20          caseloads, and their chronic  
21          understaffing creates an experience  
22          deficit in Philadelphia. The Board's  
23          responsibility is to protect public  
24          safety and supervise parolees after their  
25          release from prison.

2                   The Public Safety Committee  
3           recently held two probing hearings at my  
4           request to examine the Board's risky  
5           practices related to public safety. I'm  
6           very grateful to our Committee Chair,  
7           Councilman Jones, the other Committee  
8           members and their staffs for helping me  
9           shed light on the shock of the Board.

10                   On April 12th, we examined the  
11           Board's general practices and the events  
12           leading up to the brutal murder of Police  
13           Officer Moses Walker. Last week we had  
14           the second hearing to examine agent  
15           caseload, technical violations by  
16           offenders, GPS offender monitoring, and  
17           the creation of a workgroup focused on  
18           Philadelphia's specific issues, as  
19           suggested by the Board's Chair at our  
20           first hearing. After all the razzmatazz  
21           and the merry-go-round of the Board, I  
22           was left with no other option but to  
23           introduce another resolution today.

24                   Philadelphia has a state high  
25           10,490 offenders under the supervision of

2       136 parole agents. Some of these  
3       offenders have extensive histories of  
4       guns and violence. Some have been less  
5       than model inmates. Some have served the  
6       maximum state sentence, and some merit  
7       strong supervision for successful  
8       reentry.

9                   Agent allocation, heavy  
10      caseloads, and their handling of serious  
11      violations reflect the Board's  
12      indifference to Philadelphia. When  
13      questioned, they are as transparent as  
14      mud. They now hide behind Act 122 of  
15      2012 as the reason for not issuing  
16      warrants, but the statute clearly gives  
17      them discretion to do the right thing  
18      when there is an identifiable threat to  
19      public safety. And when a police officer  
20      is murdered by a supervised offender, the  
21      agent, the agent takes the fall for the  
22      Board's risky gamble.

23                  Philadelphia warrants and  
24      deserves a real systemic and cleansing  
25      change to make our city safer. I believe

2           a higher investigative authority must now  
3           look at the threat the Board places on  
4           public safety in Philadelphia. This  
5           resolution I introduced today urges the  
6           Philadelphia District Attorney's Office  
7           to initiate an investigation into the  
8           Board of Probation and Parole's policies  
9           and procedures that are a risk to public  
10          safety for the citizens of Philadelphia.

11                   Thank you very much,  
12          Mr. President.

13                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

14          Thank you, Councilman.

15                   The Chair recognizes Councilman  
16          Johnson.

17                   COUNCILMAN JOHNSON: Thank you,  
18          Mr. President. I just want to make an  
19          announcement on behalf of Councilwoman  
20          Blondell Reynolds Brown. She invites all  
21          Councilmembers and female staff only to  
22          join the Moxie Women Advisory Board for  
23          their VIP luncheon in the Caucus Room.

24                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: I  
25          see our male staff is showing a sudden

2           interest in going to that event. Good  
3           luck on keeping them out.

4                   Folks, I would like to just  
5           thank you guys again, just reiterate my  
6           strong belief and, again, I know that for  
7           probably a couple of the former  
8           Councilmembers watching us or will see us  
9           at some point or somebody is going to  
10          tell them that I said that you guys are  
11          the best City Council that I've ever  
12          worked with, but, you know, they probably  
13          have to get over it.

14                  So I just want to again say  
15          that you guys are the best group of  
16          Councilmembers in my relatively short  
17          term that I've worked with. You guys are  
18          awesome, work hard, focused, genuinely  
19          have the people's interest. And every  
20          now and then we don't necessarily agree  
21          on the same issues, but at the end of the  
22          day, the positions that you take are in  
23          the best interest that you believe that  
24          will help our city.

25                  So I want to thank you all so

2           much for your support and being able to  
3           work with you and not only call you my  
4           colleagues but call you my friends.

5                   There are two things that I  
6           would like to do, not here. There are a  
7           couple of issues that have some small  
8           loose ends. One obviously is the school  
9           issue that we have been in the midst of.  
10          I will be reaching out to a couple of  
11          members about something that will happen  
12          over the next couple of days that we  
13          will -- I will ask you to get engaged in.  
14          I don't want to say it here. I'm sure  
15          I'll have some microphones in my face  
16          shortly about what that is.

17                   And the other thing is with  
18          respect to AVI, and I've talked to a  
19          number of members, including the Mayor,  
20          that while we have proceeded with a  
21          program that I believe we should do,  
22          obviously there are some issues with  
23          respect to AVI. We can't close our eyes  
24          and our ears and not acknowledge that  
25          there are some issues with respect to

2           assessments. There are some issues with  
3           respect, in a lot of people's minds, with  
4           fairness. The introduction and the  
5           passage of the OPA standards that was, I  
6           think, Councilman Henon, you introduced  
7           that and co-sponsored by with Oh and --  
8           who else was it?

9                   COUNCILMAN HENON: And you.

10                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: And  
11           myself, okay. (Continued) -- and  
12           supported by all members, I want to  
13           think, is going to be a key document that  
14           I'm going to ask people to work with OPA  
15           on over the next couple of months,  
16           because at the end of the day, people  
17           should understand why they're being  
18           assessed and how they're being assessed  
19           in a very public and transparent way.

20                  The second thing, I'm going to  
21           informally name a couple of members of  
22           Council or request a couple of members of  
23           Council participate in a process that  
24           will allow us to not only get a little  
25           more accuracy in some of the issues with

2       respect to AVI, but actually come up with  
3       a monitoring system with respect to some  
4       of the measures that have been put in  
5       place, homestead, gentrification,  
6       deferrals, because we want to make sure  
7       that those programs are adequately  
8       implemented and, in addition to which,  
9       there is probably going to be some  
10      budgetary impacts for this particular  
11      program. It's not clear what revenues  
12      will be generated by this new market  
13      value, but if there are excess revenues  
14      generated, we want to make sure that,  
15      one, Council knows about it and, two, how  
16      to either redirect it or utilize it for  
17      different issues with respect to Council,  
18      be it reducing taxes or funding some  
19      other more appropriate type of  
20      activities. So I'm going to ask a couple  
21      of members of Council to participate in  
22      that informal process.

23                   Councilman Kenney, you raised  
24      your hand. You want to be on that  
25      committee?

2                   COUNCILMAN KENNEY: No, no, no.

3                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Oh,  
4 you want to speak? All right.  
5 Councilman.

6                   COUNCILMAN KENNEY: Just I had  
7 to say it, because you're talking about a  
8 very full agenda for this summer and we  
9 have the construction and demolition  
10 committee going this summer. I read this  
11 morning that I was going to be at the  
12 shore, at the beach all summer long. The  
13 Inquirer Editorial Board told me I got a  
14 free pass to go to the shore for the  
15 summer. So the only thing that that  
16 proves to me is that we're in the  
17 building in the summer and they're not,  
18 because if they were here, like some of  
19 our reporters, they see us. So the  
20 Inquirer Editorial Board ought to visit  
21 us this summer and maybe they'd learn  
22 something.

23                   Thank you.

25 Councilman, I want to thank you for that.

8           thought -- I don't want the Inquirer to  
9           go alone. It's the Daily News too, both  
10          editorial boards.

11                  Thank you.

12                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
13          Yeah. After being here for a number of  
14          years, you just kind of like let it roll  
15          off your back, because at the end of the  
16          day, not only we know what we do, the  
17          people know what we do.

18                  So, guys, I want to thank you  
19          all so much for another great session,  
20          look forward to working with you over the  
21          summer on various measures, and we'll be  
22          in touch with a couple of you, several of  
23          you, over the next day or so.

24                  So with that, I'd like to
