BILL 150720 - An ordinance amending Title 22 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled "Public Employees Retirement Code," to expand the scope of "Plan '10" and "DC Plan" to cover additional employees, including employees represented by AFSCME, District Council 33, who work for the Office of Housing and Community Development...

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2 COUNCILMAN GOODE: Good
3 afternoon. This hearing is called to
4 order. This is a public hearing of the
5 Labor and Civil Service Committee on Bill
6 No. 150720. The title of the bill, Bill
7 150720, amending Title 22 of The
8 Philadelphia Code, entitled "Public
9 Employees Retirement Code," to expand the
10 scope of "Plan '10" and "DC Plan" to
11 cover additional employees, including
12 employees represented by AFSCME, District
13 Council 33, who work for the Office of
14 Housing and Community Development, and to
15 make technical amendments, all under
16 certain terms and conditions. My name is
17 W. Wilson Goode, Jr., Chair of the
18 Committee.

19 I note that a quorum is
20 present. To my left is Councilman Bobby
21 Henon, Vice Chair of the Committee. To
22 my right is Councilwoman Maria
23 Quinones-Sanchez and Councilwoman Cindy
24 Bass.

25 Our first witness is Mr. Dubow.

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2 (Witness approached witness
3 table.)

4 MR. DUBOW: Good afternoon,
5 Chairman Goode and members of the
6 Committee. I'm Rob Dubow and I'm here to
7 testify in support of Bill No. 150720.
8 The bill would implement provisions of
9 the collection bargaining agreement
10 between employees and OHCD who are
11 members of DC33.

12 You can see the rest of the
13 testimony gives the details of those
14 provisions.

15 That concludes my testimony.
16 I'd be happy to answer any questions.

17 COUNCILMAN GOODE: Thank you
18 for your testimony.

19 Are there any questions for
20 this witness?

22 COUNCILMAN GOODE: Is there

19 COUNCILMAN GOODE: Bill 150720
20 is reported out of this Committee with a
21 favorable recommendation and suspension
22 of rules to allow first reading at our
23 next Council session.
