2 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

3 Okay. Now we're going to go about the
4 business of funding schools.

5 We've established a quorum.

6 This is the public hearing of the
7 Committee of the Whole regarding Bills
8 No. 180162, 180163, 180164, 180165,
9 180178, and Resolution No. 180185.

10 Mr. Stitt, please read the
11 titles of the bills and resolution.

12 THE CLERK: Bill No. 180162, an
13 ordinance to adopt a Capital Program for
14 the six Fiscal Years 2019 through 2024
15 inclusive.

16 Bill No. 180163, an ordinance
17 to adopt a Fiscal 2019 Capital Budget.

18 Bill No. 180164, an ordinance
19 adopting the Operating Budget for Fiscal
20 Year 2019.

21 Bill No. 180165, an ordinance
22 amending Chapter 19-1800 of The
23 Philadelphia Code, entitled "School Tax
24 Authorization," to authorize the Board of
25 Education to impose a real estate tax for

2 the School District of Philadelphia,
3 under certain terms and conditions.

4 Bill No. 180178, an ordinance
5 amending Chapter 19-1500 of The
6 Philadelphia Code, entitled "Wage and Net
7 Profits Tax," by revising certain tax
8 rates, under certain terms and
9 conditions.

10 Resolution No. 180185,
11 resolution providing for the approval by
12 the Council of the City of Philadelphia
13 of a Revised Five Year Financial Plan for
14 the City of Philadelphia covering Fiscal
15 Years 2019 through 2023, and
16 incorporating proposed changes with
17 respect to Fiscal Year 2018, which is to
18 be submitted by the Mayor to the
19 Pennsylvania Intergovernmental
20 Cooperation Authority (the "Authority")
21 pursuant to the Intergovernmental
22 Cooperation Agreement, authorized by an
23 Ordinance of this Council approved by the
24 Mayor on January 3, 1992 (Bill No.
25 1563-A), by and between the City and the

3 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
4 Thank you, Mr. Stitt.

5 Today we consider the bills
6 read by the Clerk that constitute
7 proposed operating and capital spending
8 measures for Fiscal 2019, a Capital
9 Program, and a forward-looking Capital
10 Plan for Fiscal 2019 through Fiscal 2024.

11 At this time, we have no
12 individuals on the witness list, so we
13 will now go into our public --
14 Councilman, you want to be recognized
15 before we go into the public meeting or
16 are you just teeing up?

17 COUNCILMAN OH: Just teeing up.

18 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: All
19 right. We will now go into our public
20 meeting to consider the action to be
21 taken on Bills No. 180162, 180163, and
22 180164.

23 For the record, Bills No.
24 180165 and 180178 and Resolution No.
25 180185 are being held in committee and

19 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Not
20 at this time, okay. Just teeing it up
21 again. All right.

22 And, Councilwoman, would you
23 like to be recognized for your proposed

18 been seconded. Councilwoman?

19 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Yes.

20 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
21 Moved and seconded.

22 All in favor say aye.

23 COUNCILMAN OH: Aye.

24 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
25 Those opposed?

17 For clarity, the amendment failed; is

22 amendment has failed?

23 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:
24 Absolutely, the amendment fails.

25 COUNCILMAN HENON: Thank you,
