19 We are a very diverse group.

19 gather together and pray and support the

20 families of those who have died.

21 God, beyond the violence in our

22 streets, we also know that we find

23 violence in people's hearts. Hostility,

24 hatred, despair, indifference are at the

25 heart of a growing culture of violence.
