22 heard you.

23 I wanted to just welcome

24 our guests here today, specifically

11      the State House about human

12      trafficking, and that is about

13      training and awareness for hotel

14      workers and others in the

15      hospitality industry to make sure

16      that we are tracking and stopping

17      human trafficking. So I thank you

18      for you being here. We look

19      forward to your testimony.

20                   Thank you, Council

22                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT

23      JOHNSON: You're welcome.

24                   The Chair will now

9                   Chair recognizes the  
10   Councilmember Dr. Anthony Phillips.

11                   COUNCILMAN PHILLIPS:  
12   Thank you, Council President.

13                   Today I rise to just  
14   quickly recognize the CEO and  
15   founder of Inner Strength, Ms. Amy  
16   Edison, as well as her staff  
17   members Ms. Christina Smith as well  
18   as Mr. Doron Tall who are  
19   instructors for Inner Strength.  
20   Inner Strength delivers  
21   mindfulness-based social emotional  
22   learning to Philadelphia middle and  
23   high school students. Their  
24   curriculum helps youth build

2       emotional regulation, reduce  
3       stress, improve focus and gain  
4       resilience.

5                   Programming takes place  
6       directly in classrooms and includes  
7       teacher training so entire school  
8       communities benefit. They are  
9       reaching 35,000 Philadelphia  
10      students at 30-plus school  
11      districts, School District of  
12      Philadelphia schools. Amy and her  
13      team are here today. Can you  
14      please rise and be recognized for  
15      your over 10 years of work in the  
16      city of Philadelphia?

17                   (Applause.)

18                   COUNCILMAN PHILLIPS:

19      Thank you, Council President.

20                   Mental health matters  
21      and we're so thankful for Inner  
22      Strength and incredible work that  
23      they're doing.

24                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT

9       I just wanted to take one second to  
10      recognize, along with you, three  
11      incredible winners of Michelin  
12      awards last night, just last night,  
13      or two nights ago. So we have two  
14      restaurant owner chefs who won  
15      Michelin Stars and one who won the  
16      highly acclaimed as well

11 JOHNSON: Well done, Member Lozada.

12 Very, very inclusive. The floor

13 is yours, Member Lozada.

14 COUNCILWOMAN LOZADA:

15 Thank you so much. And good

16 morning, everyone. It is a

17 pleasure and an honor for me to

18 recognize Danny "Swift" Garcia, a

19 young man who was raised in the

20 same community as I was in the

21 community of Hunting Park.

22 Often times we don't

23 hear about success stories in

24 communities like mine. And so, to

2 me it is an honor and to celebrate  
3 all of his accomplishments Danny is  
4 more than just a boxer. And as we  
5 read and recognize him, we will see  
6 that he has done everything that he  
7 possibly can to uplift young people  
8 in our community, through boxing  
9 and through other initiatives that  
10 he's been involved in.

11 And so, thank you so  
12 much for everything that you do.  
13 This recognition is being supported  
14 by all of the Councilmembers, but  
15 really was in collaboration with  
16 Council President. And so, we  
17 begin by honoring and recognizing  
18 Danny Garcia on his retirement and  
19 celebrating his outstanding  
20 contribution to the City of  
21 Philadelphia and the 7th  
22 Councilmanic District.

23 Whereas, Danny Garcia,  
24 born and raised in the Juniata

2 neighborhood of North Philadelphia,  
3 has represented the City of  
4 Philadelphia and the Puerto Rican  
5 community with excellence and pride  
6 throughout his distinguished career  
7 as a professional boxer; and

8                   Whereas, Garcia began  
9 his journey in boxing under the  
10 guidance of his father Angel  
11 Garcia, training at local gyms such  
12 as Harrowgate Boxing Club and  
13 developing a work ethic and  
14 discipline that will propel him to  
15 become one of Philadelphia's most  
16 accomplished and respected  
17 athletes; and

18                   COUNCILMAN PHILLIPS:

19 Whereas, over the course of his  
20 illustrious career, Garcia became a  
21 two-division world champion,  
22 capturing unified titles in the  
23 Super Lightweight division,  
24 including WBC, WBA (Super), and the

2 Ring titles, and later winning WBC

3 Welterweight championship, and was

4 named the 2013 Philadelphia pro

5 Athlete of the Year by Philadelphia

6 Sports Writers Association; and

7 COUNCILWOMAN GILMORE

8 RICHARDSON: Whereas, Garcia's

9 achievements placed him among a

10 rare group of Philadelphia-born

11 boxers to win world titles in

12 multiple weight classes, standing

13 alongside legends such as Bernard

14 Hopkins and representing the City's

15 proud boxing tradition on the

16 global stage; and

17 COUNCILWOMAN GAUTHIER:

18 Whereas, Garcia has often expressed

19 that Philadelphia is at the heart

20 of his success, crediting the

21 City's grit, diversity and

22 resilience for shaping his

23 character and fighting spirit,

24 stating that he carries the pride

2 of Philadelphia with him every time  
3 he steps into the ring; and

4 COUNCILWOMAN LANDAU:

5 Beyond his achievements in the  
6 ring, Danny Garcia has remained  
7 deeply committed to his roots in  
8 Philadelphia, investing in his  
9 community through business  
10 ownership, mentorship and  
11 philosophy; and

12 Garcia established  
13 multiple small businesses in his  
14 home neighborhood, including a  
15 boxing gym, barbershop and service  
16 center and recording studio,  
17 creating local jobs and  
18 opportunities for residents of the  
19 7th Councilmanic District; and

20 COUNCILMAN YOUNG:

21 Whereas, in addition to his  
22 business ventures, Garcia has  
23 supported countless community  
24 events, youth initiatives, back-to-

2 school drives, donating supplies,  
3 engaging with students and serving  
4 as a mentor and role model for  
5 young people across the city; and

6 COUNCILWOMAN BROOKS:

7 Whereas, his efforts to inspire and  
8 empower the next generation,  
9 particularly Latino youth in  
10 Philadelphia, reflect his belief  
11 that success comes from hard work,  
12 perseverance and staying true to  
13 one's community; and

14 COUNCILMAN HARRITY:

15 Whereas, in recent years Garcia has  
16 taken on a new role as a boxing  
17 promoter and an advocate for local  
18 fighters, using his platform to  
19 uplift Philadelphia's boxing scene  
20 and create new opportunities for  
21 inspiring athletes from the City's  
22 neighborhoods; and

23 COUNCILMAN O'ROURKE:

24 Whereas, Garcia's legacy extends

2 far beyond his athletic triumphs

3 and is defined by his unwavering

4 commitment to giving back,

5 investing locally and uplifting the

6 community that helped shaped his

7 journey; and

8                   Whereas, on October 18,

9 2025 Danny Garcia concluded his

10 storied boxing career with a final

11 appearance at the Barclays Center

12 in Brooklyn, defeating Daniel

13 Gonzalez with a trademark left hook

14 45 seconds into the fourth round of

15 their scheduled 10 round fight; and

16                   COUNCILMAN DRISCOLL:

17 Whereas, Danny Garcia thanked fans

18 for their steadfast support

19 throughout his career, expressing

20 his gratitude both before and after

21 his final fight at the Barclays

22 Center, and used the event to

23 celebrate and inspire the next

24 generation of boxing talent,

2 highlighting his ongoing commitment  
3 to Philadelphia's boxing community;  
4 and

5 COUNCILMAN SQUILLA:

6 Whereas, as he transitions into  
7 retirement, Danny Garcia closed an  
8 extraordinary chapter in his  
9 athletic career while continuing to  
10 focus on his mentorship, business  
11 and community leadership, ensuring  
12 that his legacy of perseverance,  
13 pride and service to Philadelphia  
14 endures well beyond the ring; and

15 COUNCILWOMAN BASS:

16 Whereas, the City of Philadelphia  
17 proudly commends Danny Garcia for  
18 his years of dedication,  
19 championship, spirit and enduring  
20 contributions to the City of  
21 Philadelphia and the 7th  
22 Councilmanic District; now,  
23 therefore, be it resolved

24 COUNCILWOMAN AHMAD:

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PRESENTATIONS  
2 Resolved, that the Council of the  
3 City of Philadelphia hereby honors  
4 and recognizes Danny Garcia on his  
5 retirement and celebrates his  
6 outstanding contributions to the  
7 City of Philadelphia and the 7th  
8 Councilmanic District.

9 May it be further  
10 resolved that an Engrossed copy of  
11 this resolution be presented to  
12 Danny Garcia as an expression of  
13 the sincere gratitude and respect  
14 of this legislative body.

15 (Applause.)

16 COUNCIL PRESIDENT

17 JOHNSON: The Chair recognizes  
18 Danny "Swift" Garcia for remarks.

19 MR. GARCIA: First of  
20 all, I want to say thank you.  
21 After that speech, I don't know, I  
22 might come back out of retirement.  
23 Got me hyped. But I want to thank,  
24 you know, the City of Philadelphia

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2 for honoring me. Every time I step  
3 in that ring, I'm so happy to be a  
4 Philly fighter only because I know  
5 the guy across from me is scared of  
6 me because he knows I'm from Philly  
7 so I always take pride in Philly.  
8 I'm the first Latino boxing  
9 champion ever out of Philadelphia.

10 (Applause.)

11 MR. GARCIA: I love the  
12 city of Philly so much I named my  
13 first daughter Philly. Her name is  
14 actually Philly, Philly Garcia.

15 (Applause.)

16 MR. GARCIA: I'm just  
17 very proud. It's been one heck of  
18 a journey and I couldn't do this  
19 without, you know, my dad right  
20 here, Angel Garcia. He played a  
21 big role in my career. My father,  
22 my family, that's what inspired me.  
23 The City of Philadelphia, that's  
24 what inspired me to be who I am to

19 COUNCILMAN HARRITY:

20 Thank you, Council President.

21 This resolution was

22 co-introduced by me and

23 Councilwoman Quetcy Lozada.

24 Start off reading,

9 COUNCILWOMAN LANDAU:

10 Whereas, National Restorative  
11 Justice Month is observed every  
12 November by the National Center for  
13 Restorative Justice and the  
14 National Association of Community  
15 and Restorative Justice to increase  
16 awareness of restorative justice  
17 practices and programs; and

18 COUNCILWOMAN BROOKS:

19 Whereas, both NCORJ and NACRJ have  
20 played leading roles in advancing  
21 education, research and  
22 implementation of restorative  
23 practice throughout the United  
24 States. They define restorative

2 justice as both a set of practices  
3 and also a broad philosophy that  
4 focuses on identifying needs and  
5 repairing harm, active  
6 accountability, centering

10 Whereas, restorative justice offers  
11 an alternative to traditional  
12 punitive systems and enables  
13 offenders to take responsibility  
14 for their actions, while also  
15 empowering communities to engage in  
16 reintegration. Studies have shown  
17 that restorative justice practices  
18 can reduce recidivism by as much as  
19 32%; and

20 COUNCILWOMAN BASS:

21 Whereas, in Philadelphia  
22 incarceration and experiences in  
23 the justice system negatively  
24 impact individuals, children and

3 emotional well-being, economic  
4 stability, family structure and  
5 community stability, leading to  
6 challenges that span across

8 COUNCILMAN O'ROURKE:

11 progress in advancing criminal  
12 justice reform and reducing  
13 incarceration rates. According to  
14 the Philadelphia Prison Population  
15 Report as of September 2025, the  
16 City's total prison population  
17 decreased by 56.1% from a baseline  
18 of 8082 individuals in 2015 to 3544  
19 individuals in September 2025; and

20 COUNCILMAN DRISCOLL:

21 Whereas, this decline reflects the  
22 efforts of the First Judicial  
23 District of Pennsylvania, the  
24 Philadelphia Department of Prisons

3 They have worked to expand  
4 diversion programs, reduce the use  
5 of cash bail and address probation

9 data continues to show racial and  
10 economic disparities in  
11 incarceration as Black  
12 Philadelphians comprise  
13 approximately 71% of the current  
14 prison population, demonstrating a  
15 further need for incarceration  
16 reform and a focus on restorative  
17 justice; and

18 COUNCILWOMAN GAUTHIER:

19 Whereas, in Philadelphia Mural Arts  
20 Philadelphia's Restorative Justice  
21 program embodies the spirit of  
22 restorative justice through  
23 artistic avenues. The program  
24 supports justice-impacted

2 individuals through art, education,  
3 mural design and other community  
4 outreach. Participants develop  
5 artistic and vocational skills  
6 while creating public art that

10 Whereas, in partnership with the  
11 Barnes Foundation, Mural Arts  
12 Philadelphia and Creative  
13 Philadelphia, Councilmember  
14 At-large Jim Harrity is hosting an  
15 incredible, new Faces of Resilience  
16 art in City Hall exhibit. This  
17 collective exhibition celebrates  
18 the stories and portraits of  
19 individuals who have experienced  
20 the transformative power of second  
21 chances; and

22 COUNCILWOMAN BROOKS:

23 Whereas, National Restorative  
24 Justice Month offers an important

13 JOHNSON: The Chair recognizes Jane  
14 Golden, Val Gay and William Perthes  
15 for remarks.

16 MS. GAY: Good morning.  
17 I am Val Gay, Chief Cultural  
18 Officer for the City of  
19 Philadelphia and the Executive  
20 Director of Creative Philadelphia,  
21 your office of arts and culture.  
22 Today is a meaningful moment for  
23 Creative Philadelphia and for our  
24 presenting partners of Faces of

13 We bring community  
14 voices directly into the hallways

18 as a powerful tool for cultivating  
19 empathy, connection and community  
20 strength. It is also why we invite  
21 the public, everyone here, to visit  
22 the art. It's basically a free  
23 class trip. You hear that,  
24 Masterman students? It's a free

11 Philadelphia family and portfolio.  
12 My cousin Jane, you'll hear from  
13 her in a moment, and my former  
14 employer the Barnes Foundation,  
15 their commitment expands the ways

17 opportunity in our city.

18                   Congratulations to our  
19 partners, collaborators, City  
20 Council and, most of all, to the 46  
21 artists featured in Faces of  
22 Resilience. We are grateful we get  
23 to spend time with your art each  
24 day while it is on view. We also

13 Thank you. It takes a village to  
14 do this work. So we use this term  
15 restorative justice. And a long  
16 time ago we thought this was really  
17 important for us, because when  
18 crime happens, when violence  
19 happens, when trauma happens, the  
20 narratives of our lives get broken.  
21 And how does one start to repair  
22 that?

23 You repair it together.  
24 You come together. People who have

3 have been involved in the crime  
4 communities. And through art, you

11 couldn't -- like it's volumes,  
12 because it was humbling. It gave  
13 us strength. It opened our eyes to  
14 those who are nameless, faceless  
15 people behind these walls and yet  
16 they're people who have  
17 extraordinary talent.

18 And then in 2008 we  
19 started working in the County jail  
20 and we started working in the world  
21 of re-entry, because we want to  
22 make sure that everyone has  
23 opportunities and options. You've  
24 heard the word justice here used a

3 beautiful word. And for us,  
4 justice means opportunities,  
5 opportunities to have art in every  
6 single part of the city because art

10 sitting behind walls should have  
11 opportunities.

12                   What do we all want? We  
13 want a better world. We want a  
14 healthier world. We want a just  
15 world. And we see art as a tool of

17 as far as it can go. And then when  
18 we think we've done that enough, we  
19 shall push ourselves to go further,  
20 because we want this world to be a  
21 better place. And we believe  
22 strongly, deeply, passionately,  
23 relentlessly, tenaciously, that  
24 art, yes, art can ignite change and

18 Education at the Barnes Foundation.  
19 And I'm here to add the Barnes'  
20 enthusiastic endorsement of City  
21 Councilmember Harrity's resolution  
22 declaring November Restorative  
23 Justice Month.

24 The Barnes has a more

18 ongoing commitment is now on  
19 display, as has been said, in the  
20 galleries of Creative Philadelphia,  
21 the exhibition Faces of Resilience.

22 This exhibition presents  
23 works from currently and formerly  
24 incarcerated artists at the State

18 STATE REPRESENTATIVE

19 YOUNG: Thank you. Thank you.  
20 Councilwoman Ahmad, for leading the  
21 conversation around human  
22 trafficking awareness in the City  
23 of Philadelphia. Also a major  
24 shout-out to your colleagues for

3 My name is Regina Young.

4 I am a State Representative for

5 House District 185. I represent

6 parts of Philly and Delaware

7 County. I am too highlighting this

8 very serious topic on the state

9 level. House Bill 1286 speaks to

10 providing training in our public

11 lodging and third party listing

12 platforms and rental operations,

13 although there are several entities

14 that requires their employees to

15 take these trainings already.

16 My legislation makes

17 sure that it is a requirement

18 across the entire Commonwealth. As

19 public servants, we are required to

20 ensure that safety of the people

21 are a must. I am happy to announce

22 that House Bill 1286 passed

23 unanimously out of committee so we

24 are anxiously awaiting --

18 protecting the people through human  
19 trafficking awareness trainings.

22 COUNCIL PRESIDENT

23 JOHNSON: Thank you.

24 MS. SCANNAPIECO: Hi.

2 My name is Lindsey Scannapieco and  
3 I am the managing partner at Scout.  
4 And we are just beyond honored  
5 today for this recognition. When  
6 we started the Bok building 10  
7 years ago, we were taking on a huge  
8 undertaking, a huge challenge. We  
9 were the highest bidder. We were  
10 the youngest bidder. I was the  
11 only female bidder and came here to  
12 City Hall to pick up a big box of  
13 keys and we brought that back to  
14 the building and started something  
15 that I think many people didn't  
16 think we'd be able to do.

17 And I'm so proud of what  
18 we've built over the last 10 years,  
19 and this has just taken an enormous  
20 effort of so many in this room. So  
21 I really appreciate you,  
22 Councilmember Rue Landau, for this  
23 recognition. But I also want to  
24 acknowledge Councilman Mark Squilla

2 of our district and so many others  
3 who have supported this project in  
4 this room and supported spaces for  
5 creatives to be able to work, to be  
6 able to experiment, to be able to  
7 try something new, whether you're a

9 business, a maker. We need spaces  
10 like this in the city.

11 I really believe that.  
12 I want Philadelphia to be -- my  
13 hometown of Philadelphia to be a  
14 place that is the best city in  
15 America for creatives and cultural  
16 workers, to be able to come, to be  
17 able to grow and to be able to  
18 shine and thrive.

19 I just want to  
20 acknowledge my team who's here  
21 today. We have I think 17 members  
22 of our team here, because this  
23 would not be possible today without  
24 you. We have people who have been

3 of this project. We've got Everett  
4 and Brogan and Lily and Kelly and

8 Jermaine, Duncan, Morgan, Rob,  
9 Steve and Hannah and Liz, who  
10 aren't here with us today, but are  
11 with us in spirit. And so, thank  
12 you guys. We all deserve this  
13 moment and I'm really proud of what  
14 we built.

15 (Applause.)

16 MR. ROSENBERGER: My  
17 name is Noah Griffith Rosenberger.  
18 I'm a lifelong Philadelphian and an  
19 organizer in the No Sister to  
20 Genocide Campaign. I applaud  
21 Councilmember Brooks' resolution to  
22 recognize the International Day of  
23 Solidarity with Palestine. We must  
24 go further.

2 We have sat idly by  
3 while blood has dripped from the  
4 pages of our city's ledger. Since  
5 1966, we've been sister cities with  
6 Tel Aviv, the heart of the Israeli  
7 military, which for two years has  
8 been perpetrating an ongoing  
9 genocide. This relationship  
10 normalizes the illegal Israeli  
11 occupation of Palestine.

12 We have contracts with  
13 Israeli AI surveillance companies,  
14 which seek to turn their barbarity  
15 on our neighbors. We have refused  
16 to call for an arms embargo or to  
17 even fly the Palestinian flag above  
18 City Hall, as we do when we  
19 celebrate other nationalities'  
20 contributions to our great city.

21 Frankly, it is a stain  
22 on our city's long history of  
23 fighting for liberty. We must  
24 allow our Palestinian neighbors to

2 fly their flag as we do for others.  
3 We must call for an arms embargo to  
4 Israel. We must wash the blood  
5 away from our ledgers. We must cut  
6 all ties with Tel Aviv.

7 We must proclaim that we  
8 will not stand idly by while people  
9 are bombed into oblivion by bombs  
10 sometimes signed personally by our  
11 Governor. Thank you again for your  
12 resolution, Councilmember Brooks.  
13 But we must proclaim that we are no  
14 sister to genocide. Thank you.

15 (Applause.)

16 CHIEF CLERK: May we  
17 also have Peter Ahn, David  
18 Alexander Jenkins, Jeremy Blatstein  
19 come to the podium as well.

20 (Witnesses approached  
21 podium.)

22 MS. CORBY: Hello. My  
23 name is Elowyn Corby. I am the  
24 Mid-Atlantic Regional Director for

2 Vote Solar. We are a policy  
3 nonprofit that works to advance an  
4 equitable clean energy future that  
5 doesn't leave anyone behind, and I  
6 am here as one of the members of  
7 the Our Solar PA Coalition to  
8 testify in support of Councilman  
9 Gauthier's resolution that is  
10 calling for the passage of  
11 legislation in Harrisburg  
12 authorizing community solar and  
13 community energy.

14                   So first, thank you so  
15 much, Councilmember Gauthier.  
16 We're really appreciative. And  
17 also, thank you very much,  
18 Councilman President Johnson, my  
19 own Council representative. It is  
20 great to be here. We all know that  
21 solar energy brings with it  
22 enormous benefits for those who  
23 have access. We're talking about  
24 environmental benefits, health

2 benefits, community benefits and  
3 bill savings.

4                   Solar is the cheapest  
5 energy to bring onto the grid. And  
6 yet for many people, it is out of  
7 reach. This can be because they  
8 rent, because their roof is in poor  
9 repair, because they can't afford  
10 the upfront cost of going solar,  
11 and that mismatch has the potential  
12 to contribute to an inequitable  
13 energy future.

14                   We need to make sure  
15 that everyone has access and  
16 Community Solar is the perfect way  
17 to do that. Community Solar is  
18 shared (inaudible) where anyone can  
19 subscribe and get access and get  
20 guaranteed bill savings as a  
21 result. There is legislation in  
22 Harrisburg that would authorize  
23 Community Solar in Pennsylvania.  
24 It's happening across the country.

2 We're just a little behind.

3                   And so, our coalition is  
4 here, has formed around passing  
5 legislation that does not just  
6 Community Solar, but Community  
7 Solar that really puts people and  
8 communities first. That's what  
9 this bill does and that's what this  
10 resolution is in support of. So  
11 thank you so much and delighted to  
12 be here. Really excited for an  
13 equitable clean energy future with  
14 Philly leading the way.

15                   (Applause.)

16                   MS. FOLTZ: My name is  
17 Elaine Foltz. I'm from West  
18 Philadelphia and I also would like  
19 to express big appreciation to my  
20 Representative Gauthier for  
21 introducing Resolution 250992 and  
22 bringing the issue of the need for  
23 more solar energy in Philadelphia  
24 and to your attention.

2 As you just heard and as  
3 you're going to hear today from a  
4 number of witnesses, there are so  
5 many reasons for approving this  
6 resolution and urging the folks in  
7 Harrisburg to pass HB 504. Solar  
8 is the most economical form of  
9 energy that there is today, more  
10 economical than any fossil fuel,  
11 including natural gas.

12 It's the fastest way of  
13 getting more energy onto the grid,  
14 which we need in order to prevent  
15 our electricity bills from rising.  
16 And it's the cleanest energy. It  
17 will not pollute the air and it  
18 will not warm the planet. Those  
19 are all compelling reasons for  
20 passing this resolution in support  
21 of the bill, but I also want to  
22 underscore the equity reason for  
23 passing it and, that is, that  
24 people like me and many, many other

2 Philadelphians who do not have  
3 access to their roof cannot today  
4 get access to clean solar energy.

5 By passing this bill,  
6 you will democratize access to  
7 solar energy. You will make it  
8 available to everybody, including  
9 the 48% of Philadelphians who are  
10 renters. Today we renters, people  
11 like me who live in a condo and  
12 other folks who don't have access  
13 to their roof, will be able to buy  
14 into a solar facility, put some  
15 clean energy on the grid and get a  
16 credit on our electricity bill for  
17 doing that, because solar energy is  
18 cheaper.

19 24 states and the  
20 District of Columbia have already  
21 passed legislation like this and it  
22 has been approved by the State  
23 House in Harrisburg. So please  
24 help us break the log-jam by

2 sending a message to Harrisburg  
3 that the City of Philadelphia wants  
4 more clean energy on the grid and  
5 we want everybody to have access to  
6 it. Thank you.

7 (Applause.)

8 MS. PEREZ: Kate Perez.

9 Thank you so much to Member Brooks  
10 for introducing a resolution  
11 honoring Palestinian solidarity,  
12 and I encourage Mayor Parker to  
13 support a full Palestinian flag  
14 raising. Yesterday the Occupation  
15 killed 19 people at my friend's  
16 camp in North Gaza, 19 people who  
17 celebrated the ceasefire  
18 announcement. 19 people who were  
19 rebuilding their lives, children  
20 who went back to school for the  
21 first time in years, all killed by  
22 Israeli drone strikes yesterday,  
23 injuring hundreds more.

24 Palestinians should be

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 free from the hundreds of military  
3 checkpoints cutting up historic  
4 cities, free from the bombings that  
5 haven't stopped for a day and the  
6 occupying military force  
7 controlling their water and  
8 internet systems, making it nearly  
9 impossible to report updates.

10 We have Philadelphians  
11 arriving to the West Bank today for  
12 cultural exchanges, sharing updates  
13 from the ground and trying to  
14 prevent settler violence. American  
15 journalist Shireen Abu Akleh was  
16 killed by an IOF sniper while  
17 reporting on a West Bank raid May  
18 11, 2022.

19 As Day & Zimmerman is  
20 their primary munition supplier,  
21 it's possible that the bullets came  
22 from our city. Settler violence  
23 has escalated since 2022 and armed  
24 soldiers are regularly rounding up

2 Palestinian civilians, stripping  
3 them naked in front of their  
4 communities, blindfolding and  
5 zip-tying them together, stamping  
6 identifying numbers on their skin  
7 and kidnapping them away to torture  
8 camps, where more than 200 people  
9 have already been killed since  
10 2023.

11                   These are attempts to  
12 drive out the natives and further  
13 annex the West Bank, as we  
14 understand that Israel's goal is  
15 colonization. Beyond physical  
16 occupation means mental torture,  
17 like tanks spraying houses and  
18 civilians with skunk water to make  
19 them stink for days, then banning  
20 soap from entering the strip and  
21 turning off water supplies. Crops  
22 are burned down, farmers are beaten  
23 and houses are regularly turned  
24 into military outposts, with entire

2 families locked into a single room  
3 for days or weeks while soldiers  
4 eat their food, surveil their  
5 neighbors and sleep in their beds.

6           This is the reality of  
7 occupation, and they will never be  
8 free as long as we feed into the  
9 entity that is destroying them,  
10 with our weapons, our taxes, our  
11 politicians, all at our own  
12 expense. Solidarity with the  
13 people outside today, rallying  
14 against ICE contracts. I urge  
15 Philadelphia to reinstate our  
16 sanctuary city status and  
17 solidarity with Palestinians  
18 forever. Free Palestine.

19           (Applause.)

20           CHIEF CLERK: We have  
21 Peter Ahn, David Alexander Jenkins,  
22 Jeremy Blatstein. May Claire  
23 Alminde, Jenny McGill, Bonita  
24 Cummings, Andrew McClellan and

4 (Witnesses approached  
5 podium.)

6 PASTOR AHN: Hello. My  
7 name is Peter Ahn. I'm a  
8 Presbyterian pastor, but today I  
9 speak as a part of Korea Peace  
10 Committee of Philadelphia. I speak  
11 in support of Resolution 251000.  
12 The notion of having Hanwha  
13 Shipbuilding Group, formerly known  
14 as Korea explosive group, also  
15 known as the Merchant of Death for  
16 shipbuilding, is concerning, and  
17 now being considered for nuclear  
18 weapons and nuclear submarines is  
19 alarming.

20 I know Senator McCormick  
21 is excited to dovetail this effort  
22 to traffic liquefied natural gas.  
23 Go to his website. He believes  
24 this is a good idea. Hanwha is

3 imprison union members and impose  
4 astronomical damages claims on  
5 them, simply for demanding fair  
6 treatment and human dignity. This  
7 is coupled by this country with a  
8 long history of struggle between  
9 labor movement and the armed forces  
10 favored by the privileged.

11 Economic violence is  
12 often accompanied by military  
13 violence. One of the most clear  
14 examples is the Ludlow Massacre in  
15 Colorado in April 1914, when  
16 Rockefeller supplied the National  
17 Guards and the Colorado Governor  
18 sent the National Guard to destroy  
19 the strike. The Colorado Governor  
20 was referred to by Rockefeller Mind  
21 Manager as our little cowboy  
22 governor.

23 When we say we want to  
24 be business-friendly, we must not

2 mean billionaire-friendly. What do  
3 we see? Spending more in armed  
4 forces, reducing resources for  
5 labor and union busting, spending  
6 more on bombs while cutting  
7 spending on food. I'm wearing this  
8 pie chart today, which shows that  
9 we as a country spend half of our  
10 discretionary budget on arming  
11 ourselves. That's about the next  
12 nine top countries put together.  
13 Let's wake up.

14 COUNCIL PRESIDENT

15 JOHNSON: Thank you.

16 (Applause.)

17 MR. JENKINS:

18 Mr. President, members and guests,  
19 David Alexander Jenkins and I rise  
20 with steely resolve and a heavy  
21 heart today for this most deeply  
22 sobering issue addressed in  
23 Resolution 251004, calling for  
24 action on the House Bill 1286.

2 I don't know about you,  
3 but I'm burdened today with the  
4 ghost of James Weldon Johnson  
5 during this Restorative Justice  
6 Month of November, and particularly  
7 today, the James who penned the  
8 infamous, Stony the road we trod,  
9 bitter the chastening rod. Felt in  
10 the days when hope unborn had died.

11 I'm burdened with the  
12 profound actualization that many  
13 here in this City of Philadelphia  
14 still exist on that road and have  
15 been robbed of the pursuit of life  
16 and liberty, never mind happiness,  
17 bought and sold here in  
18 Philadelphia on modern auction  
19 blocks that you and I mistake as  
20 instruments of hospitality.

21 I'm burdened by the  
22 knowledge that our Commonwealth  
23 ranks among the top states and the  
24 nation and reported human

2 trafficking cases that last year  
3 alone, hundreds of Pennsylvania's  
4 children were funneled through the  
5 tunnels, motels, unmonitored rental  
6 platforms, transit hubs in the very  
7 corridors that we travel every day,  
8 the ones that run beneath this  
9 building as we sat here eyes wide  
10 shut.

11 According to the  
12 Administrative Office of  
13 Pennsylvania Courts, Philadelphia  
14 accounts for 11% of all human  
15 trafficking offenses filed in  
16 Pennsylvania. So I'm burdened with  
17 the knowledge that our silence has  
18 caused the unborn to die. While  
19 individuals bound by the shackles  
20 of their enslavement are packaged,  
21 sold and delivered, trafficked  
22 right here in our midst.

23 Our nation has more than  
24 500,000 souls who are trafficked

2 every year, 1 in every 4 of them  
3 victims who are children who have  
4 now laid in the grip of someone who  
5 sees their body as currency, to be  
6 exploited most viciously. So you  
7 see this resolution brought by  
8 Councilmember Ahmad supporting  
9 Representative Young's introduction  
10 to the aforementioned House Bill is  
11 a direct strike at the  
12 infrastructure that trafficks rely  
13 on, ignorance, autonomy and excess.  
14                   Forgive my tone, ladies  
15 and gentlemen, as I'm a bit worked  
16 up today. Allow me to reset. This  
17 resolution and bill represent the  
18 kind of leadership that saves  
19 lives, leadership that proclaims  
20 that in this fight no one is  
21 untouchable, not a landlord, not a  
22 business owner, not a corporation,  
23 not a Councilmember, not a  
24 Governor, not even the President of

2 the United States whose number is  
3 up today.

4                   If you participate in  
5 this building, in this buying or  
6 selling of human beings, if you  
7 turn an eye that is blind or  
8 conceal it, enable it, benefit from  
9 it, then the full weight of  
10 scrutiny and the outrage of the law  
11 itself will levy upon you and I and  
12 we will help it. This bill  
13 promises to drag into the light  
14 every such vile criminal wherever  
15 he hides.

16                   It is a bold statement  
17 of accountability that nevertheless  
18 through the chamber today, that the  
19 gloomy past we seek to stand at  
20 last, where the white gleam of our  
21 bright star is at least in respect  
22 to the law. At last, now hear.

23                   (Applause.)

24                   MR. BLATSTEIN: Good

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 morning. Jeremy Blatstein. I'm  
3 here to speak on Bill No. 250834,  
4 which will require a trip to the  
5 ZBA in order to open businesses of  
6 Sun Drugs Pharmaceuticals and  
7 Convenience Sales in the 7th  
8 Councilmanic District.

9 I do not know if it's  
10 the answer to addressing the issues  
11 with nuisance businesses, but I do  
12 know that this is another cost that  
13 small businesses will face in order  
14 to open and operate in the 7th  
15 district. At what cost \$5000 to  
16 \$10,000 in 6 to 12 months; is this  
17 the right process?

18 Speaking of processes,  
19 the Philadelphia Land Bank held  
20 their meeting on Tuesday. Shout-  
21 out to City Councilman Jay Young,  
22 who supported 85 Turn the Key homes  
23 via RFPs in the 5th District.  
24 That's 85 affordable homes coming

2 to the 5th District. Way to go,  
3 Councilman Young.

4                   Unfortunately, 30 Turn  
5 the Key homes were delayed another  
6 60 days in the 7th District. Why?  
7 Control and power, aka councilmanic  
8 prerogative. CDCs have controlled  
9 at least 150 lots from the Land  
10 Bank and have not built anything  
11 over the last several years. This  
12 is very disappointing and goes  
13 against what this body passed when  
14 it came to the Turn the Key  
15 legislation.

16                   Last but not least,  
17 given the issues Philadelphia  
18 schools have faced I would  
19 encourage the implementation of the  
20 Imani Pledge. What was the Imani  
21 Pledge? A Peace Pact that was  
22 written by the late David Fattah,  
23 Sr. and taken and signed by 80 gang  
24 members in Philadelphia in 1974.

2 And I would also  
3 encourage everybody to watch the  
4 Queen Mother Documentary on  
5 YouTube, if you're not familiar  
6 with the House of Umoja and Queen  
7 Mother Falaka Fattah.

8 And of course we're  
9 talking about SEPTA.  
10 Unfortunately, the tunnel is  
11 closed. I appreciate the advocacy  
12 from Councilwoman Gauthier on  
13 getting the tunnel back open. It's  
14 crucial to the City of  
15 Philadelphia, West Philadelphia,  
16 and we really need to make sure  
17 that SEPTA is funded. Thank you.

18 (Applause.)

19 MS. ALMINDE: Good  
20 morning. I'm Claire Alminde, Chief  
21 Nursing Officer -- okay. Good  
22 morning. I'm Claire Alminde, Chief  
23 Nursing Officer, Council President  
24 Johnson. Members of Council, thank

2 you for the tremendous honor of  
3 proclaiming November 30, 2025 as  
4 St. Christopher's Hospital for  
5 Children Day in the City of  
6 Philadelphia. That's got a great

8 I'd like to especially

10 Councilmember Quetcy Lozada for her  
11 strong and unwavering support of  
12 St. Christopher's mission of  
13 healing and hope. We truly  
14 appreciate you. For 150 years  
15 since our founding in 1875,  
16 St. Christopher's has stood as an  
17 essential force in the health and  
18 well-being of this city.  
19 Generations of Philadelphians have  
20 entrusted St. Chris with the care  
21 of their children, and we've never  
22 once wavered from our commitment to  
23 providing top quality and  
24 compassionate services to all

2 children.

3                   From St. Christopher's  
4 earliest days, the hospital's been  
5 especially dedicated to serving  
6 families in underserved  
7 communities, those who too often  
8 face barriers to care. That

11 of powerful, economic and political  
12 headwinds currently impacting  
13 health care nationwide.

14                   As we celebrate this  
15 milestone, we honor the countless  
16 individuals who make our healing  
17 environment possible, from nurses  
18 and physicians, social workers,  
19 therapists, our front desk staff,  
20 food services. Every St. Chris  
21 team member, their skill,  
22 dedication and humanity have made a  
23 positive impact on way more  
24 families in 150 years than we could

3 On behalf of

4 St. Christopher's, thank you for

5 recognizing our anniversary and for

6 affirming the role that

11 fabric of this city and we look

12 forward to the next 150 years of

13 caring for children and families in

14 need. Thank you.

15 (Applause.)

16 MS. CUMMINGS: Good

17 morning, Council President and

18 members of City Council. I'm here

19 or we're here regarding Bill Nos.

20 250708, 709, 834, 707 and 831.

21 Somewhere along the way,

22 Philadelphia has become a place

23 where businesses or what we in the

24 community now call the new nuisance

2 business culture, operate as if  
3 they can do whatever they want  
4 unchecked and without  
5 accountability to the communities  
6 they impact.

7                   So we would like to  
8 begin by thanking Councilmembers  
9 Katherine Gilmore Richardson, Cindy  
10 Bass, Quetcy Lozada, Brian O'Neill  
11 and Jeffrey Young for their courage  
12 and laser focus on addressing  
13 nuisance creation by businesses in  
14 the City of Philadelphia.

15                   Bill No. 250708  
16 strengthens with Class 3 offenses  
17 and meaningful penalties. This  
18 bill is worthy of being supported.  
19 Bill No. 250709 closes loopholes  
20 and hold successive businesses  
21 accountable. This bill is worthy  
22 of being supported. Bill 250834  
23 gives youth, growing youth in the  
24 7th District a voice as they come

2 up and a chance, so this bill is  
3 worthy of being supported.

4 Bill No. 250707 reduces  
5 development impact tax revenue,  
6 shifting costs back into residents  
7 rather than developers. This bill  
8 should be held. Bill 250831  
9 removes community voice entirely,  
10 allowing utility and telecom  
11 structures to be installed without  
12 notice, negotiation or appeal. Our  
13 longtime residents and elders  
14 deserve better. This bill should  
15 be held.

16 I want to thank you,  
17 Councilmembers. And I do want to  
18 caution that when you give away  
19 your power, you don't get it back.  
20 It's no such thing as 1000  
21 anything, and after that, I'm going  
22 to give it back to you. Because if  
23 I come in your house and I spend  
24 1000 hours in your house and I

2 don't pay your mortgage, I eat your  
3 food, I lay around on your sofa, I  
4 slap your children around, and at  
5 the 1,000th hour you say, time's  
6 up, I'm going to look at you like

8                   So prerogative is your  
9 prerogative. Privilege is your  
10 privilege. And without it, you  
11 have no power to represent your  
12 constituents. So I say thank you  
13 for today and thank you for  
14 allowing me to have a voice and  
15 thank you for not taking my voice.  
16 Thank you.

17                   (Applause.)

18                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT

19 JOHNSON: Chair recognizes  
20 Councilmember Quetcy Lozada.

21                   COUNCILWOMAN LOZADA

22 Thank you, Council President. I'd  
23 like to be excused for the rest of  
24 Council and I'd like to be marked

3 COUNCIL PRESIDENT

4 JOHNSON: Thank you very much.

5 Leave is granted.

6 Please begin, sir.

7 MR. McCLELLAN: Good

8 morning. I would like to speak on

9 the resolution regarding the

10 celebration of the International

11 Day of Solidarity with the

12 Palestinian people. My name is

13 Andrew McClellan and I lived in

14 South Philly my whole life.

15 One of my favorite parts

16 of growing up and living here is

17 how many different kinds of people

18 live in this city. I have many

19 memories from the Italian Festival

20 in the summer, Cherry Blossom

21 Festival in the spring and going to

22 the Vietnamese grocery stores and

23 restaurants down near 11th and

24 Washington, going through the

2 public school system in high school  
3 at the Academy of Palumbo, where  
4 most of my classmates were, be it  
5 Arab or Black.

6                   Philly is a city that  
7 many kinds of people call home and  
8 we should strive to continue making  
9 the city a place where all people  
10 are accepted. The international  
11 community has consistently found  
12 that Israel's actions against the  
13 Palestinian people are unjust and  
14 brutal. Philly can and should  
15 continue being a city that  
16 celebrates and fosters all people  
17 and stand against violence against  
18 all people of the world by  
19 celebrating the International Day  
20 of solidarity with the Palestinian  
21 people. Thank you for your time.

22                   (Applause.)

23                   CHIEF CLERK: We have  
24 Jasmine Green. May Jean Haskell,

2 Belle Sherwood, Lynn Landes, Chad  
3 Williams, Michael Cameron, Jude  
4 Husein and Sarah Bishop Stone also  
5 make their way to the podium.

6 (Witnesses approached  
7 podium.)

8 MS. GREEN: Good  
9 morning, Council President and  
10 members of Council. My name is  
11 Jasmine Green and I am a member of  
12 Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.  
13 members of our sorority have served  
14 the community for over 100 years,  
15 focusing on public service,  
16 advocacy and the protection of  
17 women and girls.

18 Through my experience  
19 serving, I've been inspired to come  
20 here today to speak on two  
21 measures: First, Resolution  
22 251004. Through programs and  
23 community outreach, Delta Sigma  
24 Theta members and local residents

2 have shared stories that have  
3 stayed with me. One young woman  
4 shared her story as a trafficking  
5 survivor, telling me about her  
6 stays in motels across the city.

7 She had signs of  
8 distress, bruises, panic, fear, but  
9 the staff didn't know what to look  
10 for or how to intervene. And I  
11 remember her exact words, I wasn't  
12 invisible, people just didn't know  
13 what they were seeing.

14 Training hotel, motel  
15 and short-term rental workers, as  
16 HB 1286 requires, is a life-saving  
17 prevention-focused measure that  
18 could change someone's story.  
19 That's why I strongly support  
20 Resolution 251004.

21 Secondly, I've come to  
22 speak on Ordinance 250849. In my  
23 sorority volunteer work, I also  
24 hear regularly from women in our

2 city about the daily challenges  
3 managing fibroids, heavy bleeding  
4 or menopause symptoms and how these  
5 impact their work. Many Black  
6 women especially have shared  
7 experiences of being penalized or  
8 dismissed at work simply for  
9 needing accommodations.

10                   This measure helps  
11 prevent workplace discrimination  
12 against Black women, who are  
13 disproportionately affected by  
14 fibroids and heavier menstruation.  
15 Research shows that the pain and  
16 health impacts associated with  
17 these conditions are often  
18 dismissed or minimized, making  
19 workplace protections like this  
20 essential to ensure equity, dignity  
21 and fair treatment. This is why I  
22 strongly support Ordinance 250849.

23                   Together these measures  
24 both protect the safety and dignity

2 of vulnerable community members,  
3 whether preventing exploitation or  
4 supporting workers health. I thank  
5 Councilmember Ahmad and urge City  
6 Council to advance both measures  
7 with urgency and compassion. Thank  
8 you.

9 (Applause.)

10 MR. HASKELL: Good  
11 morning. I'm Jean Haskell. I'm a  
12 longtime Philadelphian and a  
13 longtime member of the Granny Peace  
14 Brigade, a peace activist. I was  
15 13 years old when the United States  
16 dropped the atomic bomb on  
17 Hiroshima and Nagasaki.

18 I looked at the grainy  
19 TV and the destruction of people  
20 and land. And I said, why does  
21 this have to happen, why do human  
22 beings have to kill each other in  
23 such destructive ways. In today's  
24 world, as few as 100 Hiroshima-

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 sized bombs, very small if used to  
3 attack an urban area like  
4 Philadelphia, would put at least 5  
5 million tons of radioactive soot  
6 into the upper atmosphere, causing  
7 climate disruption across the  
8 planet, cutting food production and  
9 putting at least 2 billion people  
10 into starvation.

11               So today I ask the same  
12 question, why do we in our society  
13 feel the need to destroy each other  
14 rather than value and respect each  
15 other? People want to modernize  
16 nuclear weapons. We have enough to  
17 destroy the whole world.

18               So I ask the Pension  
19 Fund Board, why do you feel the  
20 need to invest in weapons that will  
21 destroy your citizens, your planet,  
22 your city, your lives? And I say  
23 to City Council, why would you want  
24 to support that investment? So I

2 urge you, City Councilmembers, to  
3 vote for divestment. I thank  
4 Councilman O'Rourke for introducing  
5 the bill and I thank you all for  
6 listening today.

7 (Applause.)

8 MR. WILLIAMS: Good  
9 morning. I'm Chad Williams, the  
10 chef and owner of Friday Saturday  
11 Sunday. I just want to thank the  
12 City of Philadelphia, the state of  
13 Pennsylvania for allowing me to be  
14 here and bringing Michelin to the  
15 City of Philadelphia.

16 I was born in  
17 Philadelphia, grew up here and had  
18 to leave to go pursue my dream. I  
19 decided to come back and there was  
20 never a chance that Michelin would  
21 come. It was not a possibility.  
22 When it was announced they would be  
23 here, it changed my life. We knew  
24 we had a goal to shoot for and that

2 it would really give us a chance to  
3 show the talent that we have in  
4 Philadelphia.

5 When we received the  
6 star, I couldn't be more proud. As  
7 a (inaudible) of Philadelphia meant  
8 the world that we could bring it  
9 here and I'm eternally grateful for  
10 everything. Thank you.

11 (Applause.)

12 MS. SHERWOOD: Good  
13 morning. My name is Belle  
14 Sherwood, and I'm a clean energy  
15 advocate with Penn Environment.  
16 We're the statewide citizen-based  
17 environmental nonprofit. And  
18 first, I just want to thank  
19 Councilmember Gauthier for putting  
20 forth the resolution today calling  
21 on the Pennsylvania State Senate to  
22 approve House Bill 504, also known  
23 as the Community Energy or  
24 Community Solar Act.

2 Establishing Community

3 Solar in Pennsylvania would allow  
4 neighbors, businesses, schools and  
5 other community members to come  
6 together to directly participate in  
7 and receive the immense benefits  
8 from a solar project connected to  
9 their local grid. This would be a  
10 gamechanger for many Pennsylvanians  
11 who want to go solar but can't put  
12 it on their own roofs because they  
13 rent, they have old or shaded roofs  
14 or face financial barriers with  
15 community solar.

16 Pennsylvanians from all  
17 walks of life, like the many  
18 Philadelphians who rent their own  
19 homes, will have the option to opt  
20 in together and expand access to  
21 clean energy for their community.  
22 Bringing Community Solar to the  
23 Commonwealth will allow more  
24 Philadelphians and more

2 Pennsylvanians to access solar  
3 energy, which will lower climate  
4 pollution, clean up our air,  
5 support more energy independence  
6 and help people save money on their  
7 energy bills. For these reasons.  
8 Penn Environment asks the Council  
9 to vote in favor of the Community  
10 Energy resolution. Thank you.

11 (Applause.)

12 MS. LANDES: Good  
13 morning. I'm Lynn Landes of the  
14 newly-formed Philly's Republican  
15 Network. I support the resolution  
16 calling on the General Assembly in  
17 Harrisburg to pass a house bill to  
18 combat human trafficking in  
19 Pennsylvania.

20 However, at the same  
21 time it must be acknowledged that  
22 City Council has made Philadelphia  
23 a haven for human trafficking on a  
24 global scale through its Sanctuary

2 City policy which since 2016, over  
3 a decade now, has invited into our  
4 city countless illegal immigrants  
5 and their human traffickers from  
6 all over the world.

7               Illegal immigration is  
8 the most common form of human and  
9 sex trafficking in men, women and  
10 children. If City Council really  
11 wants to do something about human  
12 trafficking, then they would  
13 support enforcing our federal  
14 immigration laws and work with  
15 agents. But they're not. Instead  
16 they're fighting them every inch of  
17 the way and so is our recently  
18 re-elected District Attorney.

19               This is not irony. It  
20 is stunning hypocrisy on our City  
21 Council's part. And worse than  
22 that, it is also a dreadful reality  
23 for the victims of human  
24 trafficking and the citizens of

2 Philadelphia. Thank you.

3 CHIEF CLERK: We have  
4 Michael Cameron, Jude Husein, Sarah  
5 Bishop Stone. May Tina Shelton,  
6 Robert Sadler, David Gibson, Samuel  
7 Kuttub and Phoebe Bachman also make  
8 their way to the podium.

9 MR. CAMERON: Mike  
10 Cameron speaking on Palestine Day.  
11 Councilwoman Brooks, your  
12 resolution is a spark in this  
13 year's long silence on Gaza that  
14 Council has practiced, like the  
15 fire that started at Harpers Ferry  
16 and made its way to Gaza and back  
17 to Philadelphia.

18 Since 1948, this country  
19 has been drained to uphold the  
20 violently, racist, disgusting White  
21 colony of Israel. Right now I'm  
22 thinking about Camp of Hope that  
23 Kate Perez had mentioned earlier, a  
24 Palestinian refugee camp run by my

2 friend Nada. I think about all the  
3 family she's lost and all the  
4 children she's saved.

5 I think a lot about how  
6 much I love my Palestinian comrades  
7 here and how much their sorrow  
8 rends my heart, how much their joy  
9 brings me bliss. Across the sea in  
10 occupied Palestine, our comrades in  
11 the resistance are young. It makes  
12 me vomit to remember what I've  
13 seen.

14 Every one of them is  
15 John Brown to me, John Henry.  
16 Every one of them gives everything.  
17 They are students of liberty with a  
18 battlefield education provided by  
19 Israel and funded by us. The very  
20 act of inception in Palestine of  
21 planting a seed in the soil is met  
22 with nuclear holocaust. Yet the  
23 power inside them, the refusal to  
24 accept the life chosen by others,

2 is infectious. And here in  
3 Philadelphia, the same force rises  
4 beneath the surface, a modern  
5 socialist coalition coming together  
6 to give this city to the people.

7               They refused you at the  
8 doors when you tried selling them  
9 Kamala Harris like a cheap parlor  
10 trick. Philadelphians deserve  
11 their power back in their hands.  
12 People are enraged that their  
13 futures are in the hands of lawless  
14 Zionists who practice displacement  
15 here in this city, a university  
16 city and in North Philadelphia.

17               Mayor Cherelle Parker  
18 has denied Palestinians their  
19 dignity of raising their flag. I  
20 would be elated to stand corrected  
21 once I see it hang on that pole  
22 outside. Either way that flag will  
23 be raised. It was raised at the  
24 barricades first at UPenn, where

2 you let the young be beaten. It  
3 was raised on these streets while  
4 you were lobbied by two expensive-  
5 looking goons sent by Josh Harris,  
6 another Zionist, while Josh Shapiro  
7 sent weapons to Israel while we  
8 came out for Mumia, Iran,  
9 Venezuela, Congo, Sudan and union  
10 workers.

11 As a child, I didn't  
12 even know Palestinians existed  
13 because my educators were already  
14 indoctrinated. The JCC was my  
15 community center. Christian  
16 Zionism and Jewish supremacy were  
17 my companions there. It wasn't  
18 until I was 18 and I met my friend  
19 Natalie that I knew a Palestinian.

20 In 2023, Council's cops  
21 dragged her, her mother and my  
22 comrade screaming from these  
23 chambers and assaulted her mother  
24 until she passed out. That Council

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 gave racist, wealthy Zionist  
3 attorneys the power of the bullet  
4 and the baton. Even so, the  
5 steadfastness of the Palestinian  
6 people inspires. It will outlive  
7 us, this calamity, and the world  
8 that made Israel. Free Palestine.  
9 Free Mumia. Free them all.

10 (Applause.)

11 MR. HUSEIN: Good  
12 morning, Council President and  
13 Councilmembers. My name is Jude  
14 Husein. I'm happy to be speaking  
15 on the Philadelphia Palestine  
16 resolution. Thank you,  
17 Councilmember Brooks, for  
18 introducing it.

19 My entire life I grew up  
20 in North Philadelphia and  
21 Philadelphia has always been home,  
22 but I see Palestine in Philadelphia  
23 every single day. It took two  
24 years for this Council body to

2 introduce Philadelphia Palestine,  
3 when there's over 17,000  
4 Philadelphians who are Palestinian.  
5               We have over four dozen  
6 businesses, taxpayers that  
7 contribute to this great city  
8 day-in and day-out. But, you know,  
9 it's never too late because as a  
10 Palestinian, we always give people  
11 the opportunity to come back, to  
12 come back and see humanity, not  
13 just for our community but for  
14 communities across the city and  
15 this country.

16               So today I have the  
17 great privilege to welcome you all  
18 in the Palestinian community,  
19 whether you like it or not, because  
20 you don't have to be Palestinian --  
21 to be born in a Palestinian family  
22 to be Palestinian. Being  
23 Palestinian means you felt hurt,  
24 pain, grief, but you're capable for

2 anything. And so, you strive for  
3 excellence.

4 And I look at this  
5 Council body as trying to strive  
6 for excellence, even with all of  
7 you guys' flaws which I accept.  
8 And so, we can have different  
9 opinions and we can have different  
10 perspectives. But I urge this  
11 Council body, as you try to govern  
12 and pass legislation, to please,  
13 please, do not censor people. Do  
14 not silence people. Because if you  
15 do in these chambers, you are no  
16 different than the people outside  
17 of these chambers. I won't name  
18 names.

19 But Frederick Douglass  
20 once said, I would unite with  
21 anybody to do right and nobody to  
22 do wrong. And so, as a Palestinian  
23 Philadelphian I've experienced  
24 wrong. I've experienced going

2 through checkpoints and having an

3 AK pointed at my head just two

4 months ago seeing my grandmother

5 who's 112. So please from a

6 Palestinian Philadelphian, do your

7 job and see humanity. Thank you.

8 (Applause.)

9 MS. BISHOP STONE: Good

10 morning, Council President and

11 members of Council. My name is

12 Sarah Bishop Stone. I'm a lifelong

13 Philadelphian, a proud South Philly

14 resident, arts worker and

15 organizer. I speak today in

16 support of Councilmember O'Rourke's

17 resolution to hold a hearing on

18 global approaches to equitable

19 public budgeting.

20 I'm here as the project

21 manager of the People's Budget

22 Office, a program housed within

23 Mural Arts that works to imagine

24 what a fully-funded city could look

2 like. We use public art, education

3 and advocacy to empower residents

4 to engage in the budget process.

5 We facilitate workshops all around

6 Philadelphia, teaching

7 Philadelphians about the city

8 budget, and we run an interactive

9 office at LOVE Park in the spring.

10 In the FY26 budget

11 season, we surveyed over 650

12 Philadelphians about the budget

13 process and what they wanted to see

14 funded. Unknown, opaque, obscure,

15 confusing, these are the words we

16 heard over and over again when we

17 asked Philadelphians what is one

18 word that comes to mind when you

19 think about the city budget.

20 Overwhelmingly, responses to our

21 survey tell us they don't know how

22 to get involved and don't feel that

23 their voices matter.

24 You all say on your

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 mailers, your billboards and in  
3 emails that this is your city, your  
4 budget. But by the time the budget  
5 process opens for public comment,  
6 the public and indeed City Council  
7 can only do so much to shape a  
8 budget that is 99% finalized behind  
9 closed doors.

10                   The City's budget  
11 process can and should change. It  
12 should be a people-first approach,  
13 informed by engagement. We are  
14 asking for the City to invest in  
15 true participatory, equitably  
16 engaged budgeting plan that allows  
17 Philadelphians voices to be  
18 integrated into every step of the  
19 city budget, including the  
20 formation of the documents  
21 themselves and the priorities and  
22 metrics that guide the process.

23                   The City should resume  
24 plans for direct participatory

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 budgeting, host regular feedback  
3 sessions on the city budget,  
4 restore budgeting for racial equity  
5 and add an environmental justice  
6 lens to the budget process.  
7 Research shows that participatory  
8 democracy strategies such as these  
9 can increase understanding of and  
10 trust in government, inspire civic  
11 learning and leadership and direct  
12 resources to communities with the  
13 greatest needs. Philadelphians  
14 know what their neighborhoods needs  
15 and it's time we trust them to help  
16 shape our city's future. Thank  
17 you.

18 (Applause.)

19 MS. SHELTON: My name is  
20 Tina Shelton. I would like to  
21 extend my appreciation to all the  
22 Councilors who have met with us,  
23 Divest Philly from the War Machine,  
24 over the years to advance the cause

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 of a nuclear-free world, and for  
3 Councilmember O'Rourke for  
4 introducing 251000.

5 I would like to thank  
6 the citizens who have come here  
7 today, who represent 31  
8 organizations that have endorsed  
9 this effort, if you would like to  
10 stand now. We salute the City and  
11 the Pension Board for its previous  
12 divestment from tobacco, guns,  
13 private prisons, Russia and  
14 El Salvador. It's time to divest  
15 from nuclear weapons too.

16 The Greater Philadelphia  
17 Branch of Women's International  
18 League for Peace and Freedom has  
19 advocated for nuclear abolition for  
20 nearly 80 years. We have members  
21 all over this great city. We  
22 currently see an increased emphasis  
23 on the false dialogue that we do  
24 not have resources for human needs.

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2 In fact, according to  
3 reports from the United Nations on  
4 disarmament, there has been a  
5 record high military spending and  
6 that military solutions are being  
7 prioritized over social and  
8 economic justice. This step  
9 towards moral investments that  
10 weigh the impact of nuclear threat  
11 on all Philadelphia residents and  
12 beyond is celebrated as a way to  
13 live up to our obligations as  
14 members of Mayors for Peace, which  
15 we joined as a city in 1985 and to  
16 show other US cities that investing  
17 in a nuclear free world is the  
18 financially-wise decision, in  
19 addition to being moral and just we  
20 carry the hopes and wishes of  
21 victims of nuclear explosion  
22 elsewhere and nuclear testing in  
23 the United States as we support  
24 this resolution.

3 MR. SADLER: Good

4 morning. My name is Robert Sadler.

5 I'm a longtime resident of

6 Philadelphia, Philadelphia. I'm a

7 longtime resident of Philadelphia,

8 in the Mount Airy and I'm here

9 today to lend my support to

10 Resolution 25099(sic) to urging the

11 Pennsylvania Senate to approve the

12 Community Energy Act HB 504 in

13 support of community solar.

14 About three years ago,

15 my wife and I looked into putting

16 solar in our house and found it

17 financially unfeasible due to a

18 number of factors, most largely

19 because we did not qualify for any

20 cover, any federal government

21 energy credits. So I do believe

22 that this bill would make solar and

23 affordable energy more accessible

24 to a large proportion of

2 Philadelphians. And thank you very  
3 much.

4 (Applause.)

5 MR. GIBSON: David

6 Gibson. Thank you for the time.

7 I'm the Co-coordinator of Peace,  
8 Justice, Sustainability Now. We're  
9 an associate member group of Peace  
10 Action. We're part of the Best  
11 Philly from the War Machine  
12 Coalition.

13 Nuclear Arms Control  
14 reduced nuclear weapons in the  
15 world from 70,000 to around 12,000  
16 nuclear weapons today. Now, that  
17 progress is being reversed. None  
18 of the nine nuclear armed states is  
19 disarming. Instead, all invest in  
20 new and more hazardous nuclear  
21 weapons.

22 Since nuclear armed  
23 governments are failing to reduce  
24 the threat, it has become incumbent

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 upon everyone else to do something  
3 about it. It is up to us to keep  
4 us safe. In 2017, the UN Treaty on  
5 the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons,  
6 the TPNW, was adopted by 50  
7 non-nuclear states.

8                   After 2021 when it went  
9 into force, we are now up to 197  
10 states party to the treaty. This  
11 gained recognition within the  
12 financial sector. The number of  
13 financial institutions taking  
14 action has grown steadily over the  
15 last decade. In 2014, there were  
16 35 institutions moving to divest  
17 from nuclear weapons. In 2018,  
18 there were 63. In 2019, 77. There  
19 are now 109 financial institutions  
20 that restrict investments in  
21 nuclear weapons production.

22                   With such policies,  
23 banks, pension funds, asset  
24 managers, other financial actors

2 can demonstrate the stigma attached  
3 to nuclear weapons and such  
4 policies have the potential to  
5 undermine nuclear weapons  
6 production and profitability and  
7 desirability.

8 More and more  
9 institutions that adopt  
10 environmental social governance  
11 standards are choosing to turn  
12 their backs on nuclear weapons.  
13 This is a growing international  
14 movement. We applaud City Council  
15 for joining this movement and  
16 calling for reinvesting pension  
17 funds into wealth-creating  
18 investments here at home, funding  
19 services that build healthy  
20 communities, like housing, public  
21 transit, education and the like.  
22 It is time for Philadelphia to join  
23 this growing movement.

24 With this vote, we call

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 on the Philadelphia Board of  
3 Pensions to go to the next step,  
4 adopt the policy of divestment from  
5 weapons of mass destruction. And  
6 by the way, we also support the  
7 Palestinian resolution. Thank you.

8 (Applause.)

9 CHIEF CLERK: We have  
10 Samuel Kuttub, Phoebe Bachman. May  
11 Shakaboona Marshall, Amy Edelstein,  
12 Ogonna Hagins, Karen Melton, Nika  
13 A. and Carmen Galero also make  
14 their way to the podium.

15 (Witnesses approached  
16 podium.)

17 MS. BACHMAN: My name is  
18 Phoebe Bachman. Great to see you  
19 all today. A lot of faces I know.  
20 Hello to members of City Council.  
21 Thank you for giving me the  
22 opportunity to give public  
23 testimony. You may know me from my  
24 work at Mural Arts where I lead our

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 Prison program for restorative  
3 justice as well as my work with the  
4 People's Budget Office, which I'll  
5 speak to both today. A huge thank  
6 you to Councilman Harrity for  
7 introducing the resolution to honor  
8 National Restorative Justice Month.

9 As Mural Arts Prison  
10 Program Manager, I see firsthand  
11 the effect of this work, of this  
12 body, on the work that I do in the  
13 prison. And it's incredibly  
14 meaningful to see the stories  
15 represented here. A big thank you  
16 also to all the Councilmembers who  
17 actually came to SCI Phoenix or who  
18 are planning to come to SCI  
19 Phoenix. It really means so much  
20 to those folks who can't be here to  
21 see you come to their house.

22 These men do not  
23 actually get to see these exhibits  
24 in person and many of them are

2 serving death-by-incarceration

3 sentences, so I can only hope by

4 acknowledging that if restorative

5 justice is possible, we are also

6 thinking about how we can get these

7 men free and bring them home.

8 Today I'm also here to

9 offer testimony in support of the

10 resolution to call for a hearing on

11 equitable budgeting practices,

12 introduced by Councilmember

13 O'Rourke. Thank you. Budgets are

14 more than numbers, right. They're

15 a narrative. They tell the story

16 of our city.

17 And when I give people

18 our Budget 101 across Philadelphia,

19 I tell people that city budgets are

20 a plan with a price tag, a forecast

21 for the future of our city, a law

22 and a moral document. There are

23 moral documents because they

24 reflect our values, whether we

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2 invest in incarceration or

3 education, whether we invest in

4 parks or police.

5 Our current budget

6 process offers limited availability

7 for people to shape the budget, and

8 only after it has been proposed

9 thanks to City Council efforts.

10 Our hearing will shape research on

11 different approaches to equitable

12 budgeting practice such as Porto

13 Alegre in Brazil, where

14 participatory budgeting redirected

15 millions of dollars to community

16 priorities, in Paris, France where

17 residents have proposed to vote on

18 hundreds of millions of euros and

19 projects that revitalize

20 neighborhoods. These examples have

21 shown that equitable budgeting

22 processes strengthen both local

23 trust and international reputation.

24 We will be also looking

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 closer to home at Baltimore's  
3 outcome-based budgeting, Boston's  
4 participatory budgeting and  
5 thinking about how these different  
6 opportunities can reflect on our  
7 work in Philadelphia. We know that  
8 lessons -- okay. All right. Well,  
9 thank you so much for the time  
10 today.

11 (Applause.)

12 MR. KUTTAB: Honorable  
13 members of City Council, I stand  
14 before you today to urge you to  
15 support this resolution celebrating  
16 the International Day in Solidarity  
17 with the Palestinian people on  
18 November 29th, a day of deep  
19 cultural and historical  
20 significance that deserves  
21 recognition in our city,  
22 Philadelphia strength  
23 has always been rooted in our  
24 embrace of diverse communities. We

2 are a city built on immigrants,  
3 shaped by the contributions of the  
4 people from every corner of the  
5 world. Our Palestinian community,  
6 now spanning four generations in  
7 this city, embodies the same spirit  
8 of resilience, hard work and civic  
9 engagement.

10 Many of you know members  
11 of our community. Personally,  
12 you've attended our community  
13 events, you've been into our  
14 houses, you've eaten with our foods  
15 and we have stood with you during  
16 your campaigns. You understand  
17 firsthand that this is not an  
18 abstract issue. These are your  
19 neighbors, your constituents, your  
20 friends. They are teachers, they  
21 are educators, they are doctors,  
22 they are lawyers. They are every  
23 aspect of this society.

24 The resolution doesn't

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT

2 ask us to take sides in a distant  
3 conflict. Rather it asks us to  
4 affirm what we already know to be  
5 true, that the Palestinian  
6 Americans are an integral part of  
7 Philadelphia and that their  
8 culture, history and humanity  
9 deserves to be seen and honored.

10 City Council, you have  
11 been afforded to be with the people  
12 who have safeguarded the Holy Land,  
13 the holy sites for 2000 years.  
14 Whether you're Jewish, whether  
15 you're Christian, whether you're  
16 Muslims, embrace us and welcome us.  
17 Thank you very much. Samuel  
18 Kuttab.

19 (Applause.)

20 MR. MARSHALL: Good  
21 morning. My name is Shakaboona  
22 Marshall. I'm Executive Director  
23 of Human Rights Coalition. I'm  
24 here before you today with my

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 coalition partners, Our Soul Solar  
3 PA, and we're supporting the  
4 resolution submitted by  
5 Councilmember Jamie Gauthier. And  
6 what we want to do is talk about  
7 community solar, right.

8                   And so, what I'd like to  
9 say is that our Governor and his  
10 lightning bill has endorsed our  
11 bill and is championing our bill.  
12 Our Mayor is championing it also  
13 and we're about to have this  
14 wonderful Council champion a  
15 resolution for community solar as  
16 well.

17                   We have an opposition  
18 with our state legislature. Our  
19 legislature right here in  
20 Harrisburg is preventing us from  
21 getting community solar in this  
22 city. And so, this is a big  
23 problem because I travel throughout  
24 the city and many people want their

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 high utility costs reduced, and  
3 solar paneling of residential homes  
4 can be this thing that helped  
5 reduce their costs. So we're  
6 trying to get this.

7 We're trying to be in  
8 line with all the other counties,  
9 at least about six of them on  
10 record by now that has also passed  
11 resolutions for community solar and  
12 we want Philadelphia to send a  
13 message to the state legislature  
14 that we need community solar within  
15 this city and to lower the cost of  
16 the PECO cost of utility bills for  
17 everyone. Thank you.

18 (Applause.)

19 MS. EDELSTEIN: Hi. My  
20 name is Amy Edelstein and I'm the  
21 founder and Executive Director of  
22 Inner Strength Education, which  
23 brings mindfulness and social  
24 emotional tools for our students'

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 long-term success. And I really  
3 want to thank Councilmember  
4 Phillips for his citation and for  
5 the support of other Councilmembers  
6 over the last 10 years where we've  
7 brought these tools to more than  
8 35,000 Philadelphia high school  
9 students.

10 In this age of AI,  
11 empowering our young people with  
12 human skills, the ability to manage  
13 stress and tension, to communicate  
14 effectively, to build teams, to be  
15 responsible, to be ready to enter  
16 the workforce as mature and  
17 accountable adults is more and more  
18 important, and that means that they  
19 need to learn how to manage thought  
20 and emotion. Last week I saw this  
21 one comment from a student who just  
22 finished one of our programs. She  
23 said, One day we were discussing  
24 how thoughts aren't facts and

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 suddenly it clicked, I realized how  
3 often I let a single negative  
4 thought spiral into a full-blown  
5 bad mood or argument. That moment  
6 made me pause and reflect on how  
7 much control I actually have over  
8 my reactions. It was like flipping  
9 a switch. I don't have to believe  
10 or act on every feeling that pops  
11 into my head.

12 Now, I think we all know  
13 a lot of adults who we would like  
14 them to be able to have that kind  
15 of self-knowledge, self-regulation  
16 and care about their effect on  
17 other people. So I just want to  
18 thank the Councilpeople for this  
19 support. We want to spread these  
20 tools far as across our city, in as  
21 many places as possible. We look  
22 forward to continuing the  
23 partnership. Thank you.

24 (Applause.)

2 MR. HAGINS: Good

3 morning. My name is Ogbonna

4 Hagins. I'm the President of the

5 Philadelphia Reparations Coalition

6 for American Freedmen, and I'm a

7 fourth generation chattel slavery

8 survivor. I'm here today in

9 connection with legislation

10 introduced by Councilmember Nicolas

11 O'Rourke.

12 Let's just keep it real.

13 How can Philadelphia say no to

14 millions and millions of dollars of

15 revenue from building a nuclear

16 submarine right here, a project

17 that the Trump Administration once

18 built and we know is going to be

19 built somewhere. The Mayor

20 definitely wouldn't turn down this,

21 just like she couldn't turn down

22 federal funding because of the

23 unconstitutional DEI policy.

24 If we can really call it

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 a policy, DEI was never law. It  
3 was a voluntary framework created  
4 by non-lawmakers, promoting  
5 aspirational values like  
6 representation and belonging. It  
7 diluted the real equity and allowed  
8 organizations to claim compliance  
9 while avoiding constitutional  
10 obligations, and that ends now.  
11 This is positive for the  
12 American Freedmen. Just like  
13 having the nuclear submarine built  
14 here in Philadelphia is positive  
15 for the economy of Philadelphia,  
16 DEI mostly benefited so-called  
17 White women, and that's a fact.  
18 The Mayor did the right and legal  
19 thing by disbanding it, ensuring  
20 the city operates with its  
21 constitutional obligations. Just  
22 like we cannot afford to not have  
23 that submarine built here, we  
24 cannot afford not to establish the

2 Office of Freedman Affairs.

3 Its existence is

4 necessary to uphold equal

5 protection under the Reconstruction

6 amendments between the American

7 Freedmen and the United States

8 government, ensuring the

9 descendants of the Emancipated have

10 access to the rights and

11 opportunities guaranteed under the

12 Constitution. Ogbonna Hagins.

13 Over and out.

14 (Applause.)

15 MS. MELTON: Good

16 afternoon. My name is Karen

17 Melton. I live in East Falls and

18 I've been a Philadelphia resident

19 since 1979. I appreciate the

20 opportunity to express my support

21 for Councilperson Gauthier's

22 Resolution 250992.

23 Community energy is a

24 small but important step to

1 11/20/25 - STATED - PUBLIC COMMENT  
2 increase equitable access to clean  
3 energy by allowing Pennsylvanians  
4 to benefit from solar power  
5 regardless of whether they rent,  
6 own a home or have a roof that can  
7 support solar panels. I'm in the  
8 latter category. I would be  
9 willing to invest in rooftop solar,  
10 but my house faces the wrong  
11 direction, has dormers that break  
12 up the surface of the roof and we  
13 have a large pin oak tree that  
14 shades the house in the afternoon.  
15 24 other states have  
16 enabled community solar, so this is  
17 a well-known method for allowing  
18 anyone to subscribe to clean energy  
19 and have that reflected on their  
20 electric bill. It provides cost-  
21 savings for participants. It's a  
22 potential income generator for  
23 farmers or landowners and supports  
24 jobs in the solar industry.

2                   There is no downside to  
3 House Bill 504. It has broad  
4 bipartisan and public support and  
5 has been passed by the Pennsylvania  
6 House in two different sessions,  
7 but remains locked in Senate  
8 committee by a chairperson who  
9 refuses to bring it up for a  
10 committee vote. I ask you to  
11 approve this resolution. Thank  
12 you.

13                   (Applause.)

14                   MS. A.: Good morning,  
15 Council. My name is Nika A. And  
16 I'm a community organizer and  
17 educator here in our city and I  
18 stand here in front of you today in  
19 support of not only oppressed  
20 people everywhere, but also for the  
21 Palestinian people, and in  
22 particular in support of  
23 Councilmember Brooks' resolution to  
24 recognize the International Day of

2 Solidarity with the Palestinian  
3 people this November 29, 2025.

4 Today the Occupation is  
5 still impeding aid flow, starving  
6 an entire population with full-  
7 grown adults reduced to bones,  
8 12-year-olds weighing 33 pounds and  
9 93% of babies under 2 not being  
10 able to meet their nutritional  
11 needs. Israel is either directly  
12 killing them or permanently  
13 damaging 93% of all children's  
14 cognitive and physical growth.

15 As a proud  
16 Philadelphian, I have been  
17 disgusted and outraged by every day  
18 that we have stood idly by and in  
19 many ways contributed to an ongoing  
20 genocide of people whose sons,  
21 daughters, aunties and cousins have  
22 strong, familial ties to the people  
23 of the city.

24 Our hosting of the Day &

2 Zimmerman Corporation, whose  
3 munitions are used to massacre  
4 Palestinians on a daily basis, our  
5 sister city's connection to the  
6 murder capital of the Middle East,  
7 Tel Aviv, our legitimization of  
8 ties to entities using surveillance

14      Food Stamp program and create SNAP.

15      She fought for the legalization of

16      abortion and opposed the Vietnam

17      War. She made history with her

18      campaign for President in 1972,

19      which is the year I was born, under

20      the slogan Unbought and Unbossed,

21      and she became a role model for

22      generations of progressive Black

23      women leaders. Her courage and

24      independence have been an

2        inspiration to me and countless  
3        other progressive Black women in  
4        politics.

5                    I also introduced a  
6        resolution with Councilmembers  
7        Jones and O'Rourke to celebrate the  
8        International Day of Solidarity  
9        with the Palestinian People here in  
10       Philadelphia. The Palestinian  
11       people have faced threats of  
12       genocide and cultural erasure over  
13       a course of their history.

14                   The current conflict has  
15       claimed the lives of over 70,000  
16       people with independent  
17       international bodies stating that  
18       the number is expected to be more  
19       accurately in the hundreds of  
20       thousands. This includes over  
21       20,000 children. I've heard from  
22       countless Philadelphians about the  
23       deep sadness, anger and  
24       hopelessness that they have felt

2    watching this humanitarian crisis  
3    unfold and I want to recognize and  
4    thank the coalition of over 20  
5    local organizations that have come

11   Palestinian people, support  
12   Palestinian communities in  
13   preserving their culture and  
14   broaden the movement for

19   Minority Whip Nicolas O'Rourke. I  
20   also want to acknowledge every  
21   person who has spoken out in

3       popular. Your voice mattered.

4                       And finally, each year  
5       on November 20th, the city

10      lists the names of 58 transgender  
11      and gender-expansive people who  
12      have been killed in the U.S. in the

18      of Sonny and all the others who

24        your willingness to stand on them.

2                   I also want to give my  
3   colleagues their props, all of  
4   y'all, for introducing bills that  
5   have me very excited to vote yes as  
6   well. I'm thinking back to last  
7   week and Dr. Phillips' bill on the  
8   local contact for landlords who  
9   don't live here. That, by  
10   definition, is what we call a good  
11   jawn.

12                   This week I'm loving the  
13   Just Water package by Member  
14   Gauthier and the bill introduced by  
15   Member Driscoll. The bills put  
16   forward by Member Gauthier are  
17   focused on making sure our water  
18   remains affordable for  
19   Philadelphians. And I definitely  
20   feel the synergy between that and  
21   the Affordable Philly Now  
22   Initiative proposal to ban  
23   privatizing our Water Department,  
24   which everywhere and every time

2   inevitably leads to even worse  
3   service and even higher rates after  
4   the sell-off.

5                   Also, Member Driscoll,  
6   it should be no surprise that your  
7   BIRT exemption plan got the  
8   Minority wings' instant support as  
9   we've been thinking about what's  
10   coming for small businesses in  
11   Philly all year and we haven't been  
12   alone in thinking about that.

13                   Folks will recall that  
14   Leader Brooks and I introduced a  
15   plan to raise the BIRT exemption  
16   during the budget season to try and  
17   protect those same businesses that  
18   your bill does, Member Driscoll.  
19   So I'm glad the need for that  
20   protection is still being  
21   articulated, advocated for and  
22   addressed now in this body. It's a  
23   point that we should not be shy to  
24   take pride in. I think it's good

2   work.  
3                   I'm also excited to  
4   authorize a hearing today in  
5   Council's Committee on Global  
6   Opportunities and the Creative  
7   Innovative Economy in collaboration  
8   with Mural Arts and the People's  
9   Budget Office that many of you may  
10   have heard of during the public  
11   testimony. As Chair of the  
12   Committee, I'm ready now finally to  
13   activate the Committee in an  
14   innovative and creative way towards  
15   this end to spotlight global  
16   budgeting practices and deepen  
17   democratic engagement in a time  
18   when democratic norms are  
19   constantly being eroded and really  
20   attacked. So, Committee members,  
21   get into it. Buckle up. I think  
22   that we are going to have a good  
23   time deliberating over the public  
24   good when that time does come.

2                   Ladies and gentlemen,

3   let me lift up that baristas across

4   the nation are still on strike.

5   That's good. Yes, indeed. And

6   while they stopped steaming the

7   milk, Starbucks workers are still

8   turning up the heat. It was --

9   yeah, thank you very much.

10   Appreciate it.

11                It was such an honor to

12   join Philly baristas in York

13   yesterday. I drove out there where

14   a picket of workers from around the

15   region, it wasn't just Philly

16   folks, I'm talking about folks from

17   Harrisburg, Pittston, Pittsburgh,

18   Lancaster, all over the place.

19   They came and shut down the

20   Starbucks Regional Distribution

21   Center. Folks may not realize that

22   I think the biggest distribution

23   center for Starbucks on the Eastern

24   Seaboard is right there, it may be

2    in the country, right there in  
3    York.

4                   It was a classic labor  
5    action and demonstration, shutting  
6    down the point of production and  
7    disrupting the wider production,  
8    demonstrating that workers are the  
9    means of production. In other  
10   words, they weren't playing with  
11   Starbucks yesterday. They shut  
12   that thing down. The semis were  
13   backed up and they were very  
14   annoyed by the work that they were  
15   doing. But I think it's good  
16   trouble, as the late John Lewis  
17   would say. So until they get what  
18   they deserve, I want to remind the  
19   listening public, no contract, no  
20   coffee.

21                  And finally, I want to  
22   invite all of my colleagues and the  
23   public to a town hall that I'm  
24   hosting tonight on transit

2        affordability from 5:30 to  
3        7:00 p.m. at the Friends Center  
4        around the corner at 1501 Cherry  
5        Street. Despite an unprecedented  
6        push for transit advocates, SEPTA  
7        didn't get a red penny from  
8        Harrisburg this year and was forced  
9        to raid its capital budget for  
10       hundreds of millions of dollars,  
11       all right.

12                    To avoid being in the  
13       same bind come 2027, which we will  
14       be if we don't do something about  
15       it, Senator Nikil Saval and myself,  
16       joined by Transit Forward  
17       Philadelphia, are hosting a town  
18       hall tonight. We need to start  
19       building the people power now to  
20       avoid a repeat of this year's  
21       harmful, horrible and shameful  
22       outcome, if I can use those words.

23                    We're going to talk  
24       about what's next at the state

2    level. But I also want to remind  
3    you of the proposed Transit Access  
4    Fund, which we'll also talk about  
5    tonight. Folks might remember it  
6    as being an intervention to  
7    preserve the Zero Fare program, and  
8    it certainly is that. But I'm  
9    excited to share that its scope has  
10   expanded a bit, along with making  
11   zero fare permanent.

12                   The fund could provide  
13   matching grants for employers to  
14   join SEPTA's Key Advantage program,  
15   providing all access transit to  
16   thousands of employees citywide.  
17   There are a number of employers  
18   that have already named  
19   transportation as a huge hurdle to  
20   recruiting and retaining talent in  
21   the city of Philadelphia. So why  
22   don't we sweeten the deal, right.  
23   The Transit Access Fund could also  
24   leverage private dollars in a

2       serious way to support SEPTA fair  
3       revenues and ridership.

4                       Members, if you haven't  
5       felt invited, allow this to serve  
6       as an invite to join us tonight and  
7       to learn more. If you can't make  
8       it, last-minute invitation, I get  
9       it. No stress, don't worry. My  
10      team and I will be sharing much  
11      more about the Transit Access Fund  
12      in due time, and I hope you'll hear  
13      us out about it. I think it's a  
14      really good word.

15                    Thank you so much,

19                    Any speeches on behalf  
20      of the Majority?

21                    The Chair recognizes  
22      Councilmember Dr. Anthony Phillips.

23                    COUNCILMAN PHILLIPS:

24      Thank you, Council President.

2                   Before I begin, I want

3   to recognize and extend my deep

4   appreciation to pastor Lynn Parks

5   from Oxford Circle Mennonite Church

6   who prayed today. She's a

7   longstanding member of our

8   community and we appreciate her.

9   She was joined by her husband,

10   Pastor Vance Parks as well as

11   Pastor Ron Tinsley, who serves here

12   as well. We're grateful for the

13   leadership and for the spiritual

14   grounding they provide to our

15   communities.

16                I'm also thankful for

17   Councilman Nicolas O'Rourke and

18   also Councilwoman Kendra Brooks.

19   We're constantly always trying to

20   figure out how to work together, I

21   mean, and bring ideas together.

22   And I appreciate Councilman Nicolas

23   O'Rourke's work, shout-out because

24   when we work together as a city, we

2       are much better.

3                       Yesterday our office was  
4       proud to deliver more than 200  
5       turkeys to schools, community  
6       organizations across the district.  
7       This would not be possible without  
8       the hard work and support of our  
9       team, especially a dedicated  
10      volunteer in our office,  
11      Ms. Celestine, along with Enon  
12      Tabernacle Baptist church and  
13      Mr. Mack and Mount Airy Concerned  
14      Neighbors.

15                    I know that during this  
16      time of the year folks aren't just  
17      calling their state and city  
18      officials for help. They're also  
19      calling our schools, community  
20      organizations and committee people.  
21      That's why this year I wanted to  
22      make sure our partners have  
23      resources. They needed to directly  
24      support our neighbors and ensure

2       families in our district can have a  
3       wonderful holiday.

4                   I'm grateful that our  
5       colleague and neighbor,  
6       Councilmember At-large Isaiah  
7       Thomas, is hosting a turkey  
8       giveaway in the 9th District this  
9       year. I am incredibly thankful  
10      that he's doing it with State  
11      Representative Andre Carroll. The  
12      turkey giveaway Councilman Isaiah  
13      Thomas is hosting in our district  
14      is on November 22nd from 10:00 a.m.  
15      until supplies run out basically.  
16      It's at 5801 North Broad Street,  
17      Philippian Baptist Church. And  
18      also, if you don't have enough  
19      turkeys, Enon Tabernacle Baptist  
20      Church is doing a giveaway as well  
21      from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 while  
22      supplies last at 2800 West  
23      Cheltenham Avenue.

24                   Today I introduced a

2        privileged resolution honoring  
3        Inner Strength Education on the  
4        celebration of its 10th anniversary  
5        as part of our City Council's  
6        Children and Youth spotlight. As  
7        the Chair of Committee on Children  
8        and Youth, it is especially  
9        important to me that we uplift  
10       organizations that are  
11       strengthening the emotional, social  
12       and mental well-being of our young  
13       people.

14                    For 10 years, Inner  
15       Strength has equipped  
16       Philadelphia's youth with  
17       mindfulness-based social emotional  
18       learning, trauma-sensitive  
19       mentoring and whole-person  
20       developmental tools. Their  
21       programming helps students manage  
22       stress, build emotional regulation  
23       and deepen resilience and navigate  
24       adversity with a sense of calm,

2    confidence and belonging. This is  
3    what it looks like when we invest  
4    in the whole child, not just  
5    academically, but emotionally and  
6    socially as well.

7                   And before I close, I  
8    want to recognize that Aspen Bibbs  
9    Wilson, a student from my alma  
10   mater La Salle College High School,  
11   is shadowing our office today.  
12   Aspen is a Germantown resident in  
13   the 8th District. He has clear and  
14   growing interest in government and  
15   public service.

16                   He shared with me that  
17   his passion began with his  
18   grandfather, whose influence  
19   encouraged him to look at the world  
20   around him and find ways to make an  
21   impact. At La Salle, we say boys  
22   will be boys but La Salle boys will  
23   be gentlemen, and it's great to  
24   have La Salle gentlemen here today.

3                   COUNCILMAN PHILLIPS:

4   Thank you, Council President.

5                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT

6   JOHNSON: Thank you, Dr. Phillips,

7   and welcome.

8                   Chair recognizes

9   Councilmember Landau.

10                  COUNCILWOMAN LANDAU:

11   Thank you so much, Council

12   President.

13                  I was excited today to

14   introduce a resolution recognizing

15   and celebrating the 10th

16   anniversary of the revitalization

17   of the Bok Building into a hub for

18   artists, makers and small

19   businesses. Huge shout-out to

20   Lindsey Scannapieco and all of Team

21   Bok who are here today.

22                  Bok has become a

23   thriving hub for artists,

24   entrepreneurs and small businesses.

2       Since 2015 they've been a beacon of  
3       small business support, adaptive  
4       reuse and creative space. During  
5       my time as a Councilmember, I've  
6       tried to prioritize artists around  
7       the city. And what I've heard time  
8       and time again is the need for  
9       affordable studio space. Bok has  
10      been a pivotal provider of such  
11      spaces for our creative economy and  
12      I commend them on 10 incredible  
13      years.

14                   I also signed as a  
15      primary co-sponsor to Councilmember  
16      Brooks' resolution recognizing  
17      Trans Day of Remembrance today.  
18      Just this year around the country  
19      more than 1000 anti-trans bills  
20      have been introduced already. 124  
21      of them have passed and we've lost  
22      at least 58 trans and non-binary  
23      lives, at least because crimes  
24      committed against trans people are

2   often underreported and  
3   misrepresented.

4                   As an LGBTQ+ legislator,  
5   I know that we cannot claim to be  
6   the City of Brotherly Love,  
7   Sisterly Affection and Sibling  
8   Solidarity without acknowledging  
9   the violence still inflicted on the  
10   trans community. Every day I am  
11   here to say we are here for you, we  
12   stand with you and we will work to  
13   protect every Philadelphian.

14                  If you'd like to show  
15   your support, please join myself  
16   and Councilmember Brooks and other  
17   members and advocates on the South  
18   Apron by the Catto statue for a  
19   press conference immediately after  
20   session, meaning now.

21                 And finally -- a  
22   two-partner here -- but I  
23   introduced a resolution recognizing  
24   the restaurants in Philadelphia

1           11/20/25 - STATED - SPEECHES  
2   that earned our first Michelin  
3   Stars: Her Place Supper Club;  
4   Friday Saturday Sunday and  
5   Provenance as well as the  
6   restaurants that were Michelin-  
7   recommended include my very own  
8   brother and sister-in-law's  
9   restaurant Vedge. Congratulations  
10   to our winners and those who were  
11   recommended and made it to the  
12   Guide. This is a big  
13   accomplishment for Philly and I  
14   commend you for your prestigious  
15   contributions to our food scene.  
16   Thank you to Carlos, Nick and Chad  
17   who joined us in Council today.  
18   And thank you, Council President,  
19   for your collaboration on this  
20   resolution.  
21               As we and the rest of  
22   the world know now, dining culture  
23   is incredibly important to  
24   Philadelphia, which is why I

2   introduced legislation that expands  
3   sidewalk cafe seating in  
4   Philadelphia. This should be the  
5   easiest, low-barrier option for a  
6   restaurant or cafe to offer outdoor  
7   dining to their customers.

8           I've spoken to all our  
9   District Councilmembers, bids,  
10   civics, RCOs across the city and  
11   hundreds of owners and operators  
12   and many more about this, and I  
13   look forward to engaging further  
14   around this as we head to  
15   committee. Thank you very much.

17   JOHNSON: Thank you.

18           Chair recognizes  
19   Councilmember Dr. Nina Ahmad.

20           COUNCILWOMAN AHMAD:

21   Thank you, Council President.

22           I want to begin by  
23   recognizing the significance of the  
24   vote we took today. This body

2       passed my legislation Bill No.

3       250849, to protect workers from

4       discrimination based on menopause,

5       perimenopause or menstruation.

6       These are not niche issues. They

7       are everyday realities for a huge

8       share of our workforce. And for

9       too long, people have been expected

10      to push through silently or pretend

11      nothing is happening.

12                 Recently WHYY covered my

13      bill, and out of curiosity I took a

14      look at the online comments. And

15      what I saw there was exactly what

16      many workers deal with behind

17      closed doors: sarcasms, jokes and

18      a whole lot of dismissive remarks

19      from people who clearly have no

20      idea what these experiences

21      actually involve.

22                 Most of these comments

23      came from misogynists. And

24      honestly, that didn't surprise me,

1           11/20/25 - STATED - SPEECHES

2       but it did reinforce the point, if  
3       strangers online feel free to mock  
4       something so openly, imagine how  
5       comfortable people feel making  
6       those comments in workplaces where  
7       women and impacted people don't  
8       have power to push back. That's  
9       why this bill is necessary.

10                   It's about making sure  
11       workers are not punished or  
12       belittled for changes in their own  
13       bodies. It is about dignity. It  
14       is about treating people like human  
15       beings. And today Philadelphia  
16       took that seriously. I thank all  
17       my colleagues for that.

18                   I would be remiss if I  
19       didn't also highlight the  
20       resolution Council passed today  
21       calling on Pennsylvania General  
22       Assembly to act on House Bill 1286.  
23       This bill would require human  
24       trafficking awareness training for

1        11/20/25 - STATED - SPEECHES  
2        hotel, motel and short-term rental  
3        workers. These are the people who  
4        often see the first signs someone  
5        appearing distressed, someone being  
6        monitored too closely, someone not  
7        allowed to speak for themselves.  
8        Training them to recognize those  
9        moments could make a life-changing  
10       difference.

11                This is not complicated  
12       or controversial. It's common  
13       sense and we are urging Harrisburg  
14       to move. Again, I want to thank  
15       Representative Young for her  
16       steadfast leadership on this issue  
17       and for joining us today to express  
18       support for my legislation.  
19       Together we can work to combat  
20       human trafficking once and for all  
21       in Philadelphia and the  
22       Commonwealth.

23                Thank you, Council

5   Councilmember Jamie Gauthier.

6                   COUNCILWOMAN GAUTHIER:

7   Thank you, Council President.

8                   Water is a basic human  
9   right and we are lucky to live in a  
10   city where our water system belongs  
11   to taxpayers, not corporate  
12   interest. But water rates  
13   increased 9.4% in September and  
14   another rate hike of 5.5% is slated  
15   for next year. This means even  
16   more working families pinching  
17   pennies just to pay the bills. And  
18   for those already beyond their  
19   means, it means dry pipes.

20                  Every Philadelphian  
21   deserves water. That's why today I  
22   introduced Just Water, a package of  
23   bills and resolutions that will  
24   keep the water flowing. The

1        11/20/25 - STATED - SPEECHES

2        legislation I'm proposing today

3        expands eligibility for the Tiered

4        Assistance Program and requires the

5        City to share responsibility for

6        long-term water meter failures that

7        result in runaway water bills.

8        Because for far too long, the City

9        has held residents accountable for

10       faults in government

11       infrastructure.

12                    Take, for example, my

13       constituent Alexandra. When she

14       closed on her new home in the 3rd

15       Council District, the Water

16       Department reported an actual meter

17       reading and promised her water bill

18       was accurate. Months later after

19       upgrading her meter at PWD's

20       recommendation, Alexandra was hit

21       with an \$8,000 bill.

22                    Even though PWD told her

23       otherwise, they reversed course and

24       said the old meter in Alexandra's

1           11/20/25 - STATED - SPEECHES

2     home had not been transmitting  
3     information for eight years. As  
4     the new owner of the home, the City  
5     told Alexandra that she is  
6     responsible for coming up with 8  
7     grand, even though she did  
8     everything right.

9                     As a part of Just Water,  
10    we will also be holding a hearing  
11    on solutions for tenants who lose  
12    access to water or are ineligible  
13    for water assistance programs,  
14    because unlike other utilities, PWD  
15    doesn't allow renters to put water  
16    bills in their names.

17                    Rick, a long-time West  
18    Philadelphia tenant, lost water  
19    service because his landlord  
20    stopped paying his water bill.  
21    Even though he was not responsible  
22    for the debt, Rick spent days  
23    traveling to the Municipal Services  
24    Building with every document he

1           11/20/25 - STATED - SPEECHES  
2    could gather, only to be turned  
3    away repeatedly and told he would  
4    need to pay more than \$3,000 in  
5    charges that were his landlord's  
6    responsibility. After completing a  
7    meter upgrade, PWD still refused to  
8    restore service because Rick's  
9    landlord did not have a rental  
10   license.

11                   Let me be clear, the  
12   City of Philadelphia is responsible  
13   for these injustices. It is a  
14   choice that we have allowed these  
15   policy failures to continue for so  
16   long, and I hope that through Just  
17   Water we will make sure that every  
18   Philadelphian has access to the  
19   clean, affordable and reliable  
20   water they deserve.

21                   I want to thank my  
22   co-introducers Councilmembers  
23   Kendra Brooks, Mike Driscoll,  
24   Anthony Phillips and Nicolas

1           11/20/25 - STATED - SPEECHES

2       O'Rourke. I also want to thank my  
3       co-sponsors Councilmembers Rue  
4       Landau, Isaiah Thomas, Quetcy  
5       Lozada and Mark Squilla as well as  
6       Community Legal Services for their  
7       partnership.

8                   I also thank my Director  
9       of Constituent Services and  
10      Engagement Alexis Wright-Whitley,  
11      the brains behind Just Water. My  
12      mission as a Councilmember is to  
13      bridge the divide between the  
14      community and City Hall, and this  
15      legislation, borne from the issues  
16      my Constituent Services team gets  
17      calls about every single day, is an  
18      example of this philosophy in  
19      action. Thank you so much.

20                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT

21      JOHNSON: Thank you very much.

22                   Chair recognizes

23      Councilman Jeffrey Jay Young.

24                   COUNCILMAN YOUNG: Thank

2       you, Mr. President.

3                       I think the Water  
4       Department is on notice. I mean,  
5       Dr. Phillips got issues.  
6       Councilwoman Gauthier has issues.  
7       I introduced a bill to make sure  
8       that they can't charge late fees.  
9       So we love to figure this out in  
10      the city to make this city much  
11      more affordable for its residents  
12      here.

13                    But, Mr. President, I  
14      want to start by congratulating  
15      former Captain of the 22nd Police  
16      District Michael Goodson on his  
17      promotion to the rank of Inspector  
18      as the leader of the 22nd District.  
19      Inspector Goodson was accessible.  
20      He was present in the community and  
21      responsive. He and I always didn't  
22      agree, but as strong leaders do  
23      with a passion for making the  
24      cities better, we always found the

2        way to make it work. And to the  
3        many residents in the 22nd  
4        District, they actually call him  
5        Captain Good Man. That's just how  
6        much of his reputation, great  
7        reputation, he had in the  
8        community. His leadership will be

10       Inspector Goodson well on his new  
11       chapter with the City of  
12       Philadelphia's Police Department.

13                    And on this Saturday at  
14       9:00 a.m. at The Dell with the  
15       Brothers of Strawberry Mansion  
16       along with the Advancing Families  
17       Foundation, along with our office,  
18       State Rep Keith Harris, State Rep  
19       Ronnie Green and State Senator  
20       Sharif Street will be having a  
21       turkey and food giveaway from  
22       9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Again,  
23       that's at The Dell on 33rd Street.  
24       And it is first-come first-served.

3   my office will be hosting our

11   and a few other organizations in

4       Councilmember Mike Driscoll.

5                   COUNCILMAN DRISCOLL:

6       Thank you, Mr. President.

7                   Today I introduced

8       legislation to exempt

9       entrepreneurs, independent

10      contractors and neighborhood

11      businesses from portions of the

12      BIRT tax, one of the most

13      significant tax burdens facing

14      small and micro businesses in this

15      city.

16                  And I want to thank

17      Member O'Rourke for the kind words

18      on that and for all my co-sponsors.

19      Nine of us have signed onto this

20      bill. I think it's an important

21      bill. It is designed to help

22      thousands of sole proprietorships

23      and single-member limited liability

24      companies to keep more of what they

2   earn and reinvest directly into  
3   their communities. A \$50,000  
4   business should not face a \$3,200  
5   tax hike. That is not policy.  
6   That is displacement.

7                   Philadelphia small  
8   business owners deserve a tax  
9   system that works for them, not  
10   against them. Sole proprietors and  
11   single member LLCs make up the  
12   backbone of our commercial  
13   corridors, neighborhood services  
14   and entrepreneurial ecosystem.  
15   This bill helps level the playing  
16   field and sends a clear message  
17   that Philadelphia welcomes and  
18   supports the people who power our  
19   local economy.

20                   And lastly,  
21   Mr. President, on another note I  
22   read in the Inquirer yesterday that  
23   the Philadelphia Housing Authority  
24   plans to lay off 300 folks next

3   workforce. They're going to be

6                   So I'm asking our

10   going on over there and see where  
11   we can intervene in any way. Look,  
12   I know crazy policies are coming  
13   out of Washington. I'm not deaf to  
14   that, but I'm very concerned about

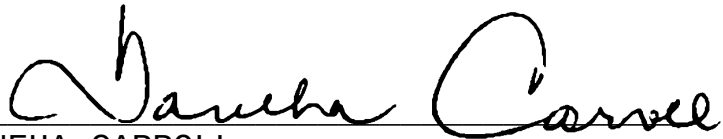
