9 would like to get it out of committee as a vehicle
10 for her to do what it is she needs to do in
11 Harrisburg and to further the discussion.

12 And prior to me seeking any final
13 passage of the bill, I would like to meet with
14 committee members before we do anything on the
15 record.

16 COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank you,
17 Councilman.

18 Any other concerns?

19 Having said that, Councilman Clarke, we
20 will leave the hearing and enter into the meeting.
