17 Peace. We say "he." We say "she." We
18 say "you."

23 distance and we find you in our souls.
24 But above all, we who lead know you by
25 what you expect of us.

10 create an atmosphere of hope, energized
11 by fairness and justice.

12 Guide us, God, as we work
13 together with our current Mayor and with
14 he whom our citizens have chosen to lead
15 us in the future. We work together to
16 provide efficiently and effectively,
17 economically and ethically for the needs
18 of our brothers and sisters who have
19 entrusted their lives and the lives of
20 their children into our care.

21 Be with us as we make tough
22 decisions so that we do what is best for
23 our City as a whole even in the face of
24 noisy self-serving opposition. Help us
25 to be the best servants we can be to our

18 of all members of City Council, I welcome
19 you to our Council session. We
20 appreciate your taking the time to join
21 us as we attend to the legislative
22 affairs of our City. We certainly invite
23 you to come again.

24 At this time, the Chair
25 recognizes Councilwoman Tasco, who will

10 Councilwoman Tasco.

11 COUNCILWOMAN TASCO: Thank you,
12 Madam President.

13 It certainly gives us great
14 pleasure to stand here this morning and
15 recognize one of our outstanding police
16 officers in the City of Philadelphia and
17 particularly someone who works in the
18 Ninth Councilmanic District. So I am
19 honored here today to stand with
20 Councilman Savage to present this
21 resolution honoring the bravery of Police
22 Officer Mark Mroz.

23 Whereas, the Council of
24 Philadelphia is pleased and proud to
25 honor Police Officer Mark Mroz, community

2 relations officer in the 2nd Police
3 District, for his heroic deeds on the
4 afternoon of Friday, July 27, 2007 when
5 his quick action saved the life of a
6 two-year-old boy; and

7 Whereas, on that afternoon, an
8 hysterical Jasim Olibrice ran into the
9 2nd Police District holding his
10 23-month-old nephew and begging for help;
11 and

12 COUNCILMAN SAVAGE: Whereas,
13 Police Officer Mark Mroz heard the
14 commotion and ran up and took the child
15 from Olibrice and immediately began to
16 perform CPR and asked his Captain to call
17 an ambulance; and

18 Whereas, Police Officer Mroz
19 realized that the child was having a
20 seizure, had stopped breathing and had
21 become unconscious; and

22 Whereas, Police Officer Mroz
23 revived the boy twice with CPR, with help
24 from Police Officer Stephanie Ahrndt,
25 before the ambulance arrived about eight

2 minutes later; and

3 COUNCILWOMAN TASC0: Whereas,
4 the boy, Kinji, was rushed to St.
5 Christopher's Hospital for Children,
6 where he was treated and released that
7 night; and

8 Whereas, Police Officer Mroz
9 has been nominated for the Officer of the
10 Month award by his Sergeant, Frank
11 Barclay, who was witness to the incident;
12 and

13 Whereas, a few days after this
14 incident, Officer Mroz and Officer Ahrndt
15 were united with a happy and smiling
16 Kinji, who had completely recovered from
17 the incident; and

18 COUNCILMAN SAVAGE: Whereas,
19 NBC 10's Edie Huggins remarked that it
20 was a day that Kinji will probably never
21 remember, but it's a day that his family
22 and police officers of the 2nd District
23 will probably never forget; and

24 Whereas, Police Officer Mroz
25 has been praised for his quick action

2 that saved a boy's life, he responds
3 with, "I was in the right place at the
4 right time and I was just doing my job";
5 and

6 Whereas, Police Officer Mroz is
7 an 11-year veteran of the Philadelphia
8 Police Force and lives in Northeast
9 Philadelphia with his wife and
10 six-year-old daughter.

11 Now therefore

12 COUNCILWOMAN TASC0: Resolved,
13 by the Council of the City of
14 Philadelphia, that we hereby recognize
15 and congratulate Police Officer Mark Mroz
16 for his bravery and quick action which
17 saved the life of a two-year-old
18 Philadelphia resident.

19 Further resolved, that an
20 engrossed copy of this resolution be
21 presented to Police Officer Mroz as
22 evidence of the sincere admiration of
23 this legislative body.

24 Certification that this is a
25 true and correct copy of the original

10 Chair recognizes Officer Mroz for
11 remarks.

12 OFFICER MROZ: Thank you,
13 ladies and gentlemen. As I was saying
14 before, all this that I've been
15 recognized for this one task is
16 unbelievable. I just was basically doing
17 what I try to do every day, doing the job
18 that I love to do and helping the
19 citizens of Philadelphia.

20 I wanted to thank all of you.
21 And I just recently ran into little Kinji
22 on Sunday with his mother and he's still
23 doing good, and I expect to pay a visit
24 to him over the holidays. He lives
25 pretty close to my house. So he's doing

7 OFFICER MROZ: I'd also like to

9 and my Lieutenant, Lisa Harner, from the
10 2nd District here.

11 (Applause.)

12 LIEUTENANT HARNER: I'd just
13 like to say a few words about Officer
14 Mroz. It's great that he's being
15 recognized today for this true act of
16 courage that he did. However, he does a
17 great job every day in serving the
18 citizens of the City, and we're proud to
19 have him protecting the community and as
20 a part of our police family.

21 (Applause.)

22 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA:
23 Council will be at ease.

24 COUNCILWOMAN TASCO: Let me
25 also recognize Bill Dolbow, who is our

7 (Council at ease.)

8 OFFICER MROZ: I did forget to
9 introduce Mike Frist of the FOP. I'm
10 sorry.

11 (Applause.)

12 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA: The
13 Chair now recognizes Councilwoman Brown,
14 who will present a resolution honoring
15 Experience Corps on the occasion of their
16 10th anniversary.

17 Will Mr. Robert Tietze and
18 those accompanying him please join the
19 Councilwoman at the podium. And I
20 believe Councilwoman Miller is going to
21 also be joining Councilwoman Brown.

22 COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Thank you,
23 Madam President.

24 As I read this, I would like
25 all of the members of the Experience

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2 Corps to please rise so we know who you
3 are and remain standing while we salute
4 you with this resolution.

5 To my colleagues and those of
6 us in the audience, we know that young
7 people in schools from grades K through
8 3, children learn to read, but from 4th
9 grade on, children read to learn, and the
10 Experience Corps is in the business of
11 ensuring that many, many more of our
12 young people are graduates of our
13 Philadelphia public high schools and they
14 are not in the twilight of their lives,
15 but these are vibrant, energetic
16 attentive, caring citizens who care about
17 the young people who we are trying to
18 learn to read and then the others who we
19 want for sure to move on and read to
20 learn.

21 With that, we are honoring the
22 Experience Corps Philadelphia on the
23 occasion of its 10th anniversary.

24 Whereas, Experience Corps
25 Philadelphia began in the 1995-1996

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2 school year by engaging older adult
3 volunteers in tutoring and mentoring our
4 young people K through 3 students in
5 order to increase literacy support in our
6 Philadelphia's public elementary schools;
7 and

8 Whereas, Experience Corps
9 Philadelphia, which started in just two
10 schools with a handful of devoted
11 volunteers, now operate in over 40
12 schools with more than 500 volunteers
13 providing more than 200,000 hours of
14 support to 3,500 students. They are
15 making a difference.

16 Whereas, students supported by
17 Experience Corps Philadelphia have raised
18 their reading ability by an average of
19 1.5 grade levels per year; and

20 COUNCILWOMAN MILLER: Whereas,
21 Experience Corps Philadelphia is the
22 flagship and leader within the national
23 Experience Corps program, which spans 14
24 cities, serves as a model for similar
25 projects in cities such as Boston,

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2 Cleveland, New York, Washington, DC,
3 Portland, Minneapolis, Port Arthur,
4 Chicago, Baltimore, Kansas City, San
5 Francisco, Indianapolis and others;

6 Whereas, volunteers of
7 Experience Corps Philadelphia have been
8 shown to benefit through improved
9 physical and psychological health,
10 increased community connections and
11 rewarding friendships with fellow
12 volunteers; and

13 Whereas, Experience Corps
14 Philadelphia has been hailed by local
15 teachers, principals, community leaders
16 and legislators; and

17 COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Whereas,
18 Philadelphia Experience Corps has
19 developed a national model, Leadership
20 Institute, for older adults to develop
21 their skills as community and civic
22 leaders; and

23 Whereas, these achievements
24 were recognized nationally in 2004 when
25 the United States Administration on Aging

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2 selected Experience Corps Philadelphia as
3 an, quote, "Aging Well, Living Well
4 Program Champion," end quote, calling the
5 program a pioneering model for the
6 nation, and in 2006 was recognized by the
7 National Council on Aging as one of four
8 premiere models for the civic engagement
9 of retirees and older adults, and was
10 selected by Harvard University's Robert
11 Putman as one of the 12 most effective
12 programs in the United States at building
13 social capital.

14 Now therefore resolved, by the
15 Council of the City of Philadelphia, that
16 we hereby honor all of you of Experience
17 Corps on the occasion of your 10th
18 anniversary.

19 Further resolved, that an
20 engrossed copy of this resolution be
21 presented to Robert Tietze, Director of
22 Experience Corps Philadelphia, as
23 evidence of the sincere sentiments of
24 this legislative body.

25 Introduced by Blondell Reynolds

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2 Brown, my colleague Councilwoman Donna
3 Reed Miller, and sponsored by all the
4 members of the Philadelphia City Council.
5 We salute you, the Experience Corps
6 Philadelphia.

7 Thank you, Madam President.
8 (Applause.)

9 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA: The
10 Chair recognizes Mr. Tietze for remarks.

11 MR. TIETZE: Thank you, Madam
12 President and esteemed members of
13 Council. The volunteers you see behind
14 you represent just the tip of the iceberg
15 of the over 3,000 older adults in
16 Philadelphia who have provided over a
17 million hours of support to children over
18 the past ten years, and our hats are off
19 to them for the incredibly hard work they
20 do to change the lives of children, to
21 increase literacy skills and to support
22 what our school system is doing.

23 A program like this is really a
24 team effort from everyone. The
25 leadership of Councilwoman Reynolds

2 Brown, who we could not be -- we would
3 not be here, we would not be where we are
4 without her support, and many other
5 members of Council, as well as State
6 Representatives Dwight Evans, Speaker
7 O'Brien and others.

10 schools to come out and we'll give you a
11 tour and show you what these great
12 incredible people are doing. Over the
13 years, we've had many staff people build
14 this program, and behind me are just some
15 of the staff, and I want to tip my hat to
16 them and to recognize them for the great
17 work they do to make this program happen
18 on the ground.

19 Thank you guys.

20 Thank you all.

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2 President, I might add to that the
3 retirees are former homemakers, former
4 school teachers, former principals, but
5 the common thread is that they all care
6 about our Philadelphia's children.

7 Thank you, Madam President.

8 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA:

9 You're welcome.

10 The Chair now recognizes
11 Councilwoman Miller, who will present a
12 resolution recognizing Double Lyte Posse
13 Sportbike.

14 Will Ms. Patricia Redmond and
15 Mr. Harold Best and those accompanying
16 them please join the Councilwoman at the
17 podium.

18 I see that Councilman Clarke is
19 also joining Councilwoman Miller for the
20 presentation.

21 COUNCILWOMAN MILLER: Good
22 morning, everyone. It is my pleasure to
23 honor and recognize Double Lyte Posse
24 today. This is a group that has been so
25 actively involved in the Northwest, and

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2 these are the types of groups that many
3 times don't get a lot of public
4 recognition and it's really great to be
5 able to do that, to honor them today.

6 Recognizing, honoring and
7 celebrating Double Lyte Posse Sportbike
8 Motorcycle Club of Pennsylvania for their
9 invaluable efforts, community involvement
10 and their pledge to always remember those
11 that are less fortunate.

12 Whereas, in 1994, on the
13 Plateau in Fairmount Park, a small group
14 of friends sharing the commonality of the
15 thrill of the ride decided to officially
16 unite under the name of Double Lyte
17 Posse, DLP; and

18 Whereas, through this
19 unofficial family tree a seed of
20 philanthropy was planted and the group
21 grew into a full-fledged campaign to give
22 back; and

23 Whereas, Double Lyte Posse's
24 core commitment is to always remember
25 those that are less fortunate than we

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2 are; and

3 COUNCILMAN CLARKE: Whereas, in
4 2006 at an anti-gun rally in Harrisburg,
5 Double Lyte Posse met Patricia Redmond, a
6 conscientious philanthropist, and the
7 doors to more City involvement were
8 opened; and

9 Whereas, through this meeting,
10 Double Lyte Posse, Patricia Redmond and
11 Councilwoman Miller began targeting
12 volunteer work in the Philadelphia public
13 school system's Safe Corridor Project,
14 helped with motorcades for funerals of
15 child victims, Town Watch Integrated
16 Services programs, and the list goes on
17 and on; and

18 Whereas, Double Lyte Posse
19 received the Volunteer of the Year award
20 and will continue to participate in
21 events such as Philadelphia AIDS Walk;
22 Breast Cancer: Walk for a Cure; Stop the
23 Violence; Town Watch Integrated Services:
24 National Night Out; Philadelphia public
25 school truancy programs; the Jena 6, and

4 Whereas, over the past 13
5 years, Double Lyte Posse has successfully

10 steadfast in their determination to give
11 and to see twice as much impact in their
12 next 13 years.

15 Chair recognizes Ms. Redmond for remarks.

16 MS. REDMOND: First I'd like to
17 thank God for what he has done for me,
18 and I thank God for Double Lyte Posse and
19 Councilwoman Donna Reed Miller and
20 Councilman Clarke for helping Donna with
21 this. And I wanted to say for the first
22 time in my life to be here to say, Good
23 morning, Madam President.

24 COUNCIL PRESIDENT VERNA: Good
25 morning and welcome.

2 MS. REDMOND: Double Lyte Posse
3 is a group that would get together, try
4 to stop the violence, try to do things to
5 help the City. I consider us being an
6 ambassador of Philadelphia when we leave

10 the last 13 years they have not been
11 recognized. We're trying to do a lot of
12 different things to stop the violence
13 here in the City, to make Philadelphia a
14 better place and bring it back, as they
15 call, the Brother of Love.

16 With your help, when we send
17 out papers, our proposal to you guys in
18 City Council, please help us out, and
19 anything that we can do in anybody's
20 district, you may contact us on our
21 website, which is DLP website, Double
22 Lyte Posse Sportbike. You can reach us
23 through there or through Councilwoman
24 Donna Reed Miller. We also call
25 ourselves Donna Boys, because in the end,
