24 moment while we get our quorum together.

1 (Brief recess.)

2 COUNCILWOMAN QUINONES-SANCHEZ:

3 Council Chair, I am on call and present.

4 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you,

5 Councilwoman Sanchez. We appreciate

6 your presence. So I'm going to ask the

7 Clerk to please call the roll again.

8 THE CLERK: Councilmember

9 Gauthier.

10 (No response.)

11 THE CLERK: Councilmember

12 Brooks.

13 (No response.)

14 THE CLERK: Councilmember

22 COUNCILWOMAN QUINONES-SANCHEZ:

23 Present.

24 THE CLERK: Thank you. And,

25 Chair Bass.

1 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you.

2 So we do have a quorum of Committee
3 members, and this hearing is now called
4 to order. This is the public hearing of
5 the Committee on Parks, Recreation and
6 Cultural Affairs regarding Bill No.
7 210743.

8 Madam Chair, will you please
9 read the title of the bill.

10 THE CLERK: Bill No. 210743, an
11 ordinance renaming and redesignating the
12 property commonly referred to as the
13 11th and Venango Playground located at
14 3600 North 11th Street as the Williams
15 Moore Reed Memorial Park in the City of
16 Philadelphia.

17 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you.
18 Before we begin to hear testimony from
19 the witnesses we have for today,
20 everyone who has been invited to the
21 meeting to testify should be aware that
22 this public hearing is being recorded.
23 Because the hearing is public,
24 participants and viewers have no
25 reasonable expectation of privacy. By

1 continuing to be in the meeting, you are
2 consenting to being recorded.

3 Additionally prior to
4 recognizing Members for questions and
5 comments that they have for the
6 witnesses, I will note for the record at
7 this time that we will use the chat
8 feature available in Microsoft Teams to
9 allow Members to signify that they wish
10 to be recognized. In order to comply
11 with the Sunshine Act, the chat feature
12 must only be used for that purpose.

13 Before I call on the Clerk to
14 call up the first panel, would any of my
15 colleagues like to make any opening
16 comments? And I do want to recognize
17 the presence of Councilman Curtis Jones,
18 Jr.

19 (No response.)

20 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: And seeing
21 no comments or requests for comments
22 from my colleagues, Clerk, will you
23 please have the first panel of witnesses
24 to testify today on Bill No. 210743.

25 THE CLERK: Panel 1 witnesses,

1 Ms. Chris Creelman and Cynthia Barnes.

2 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Good

3 afternoon to our panel.

4 Are you connected and ready to
5 proceed? It looks like you both are.

6 Mr. Creelman, please state your name for
7 the record and proceed with your
8 testimony.

9 MR. CREELMAN: Good afternoon,
10 Chairperson Bass and members of the
11 Committee on Parks & Recreation. My
12 name is Chris Creelman. I am the
13 Director of Special Projects for the
14 Department of Parks & Recreation. I'm
15 here today to testify in support of Bill
16 No. 210743, an ordinance renaming and
17 designating the property commonly
18 referred to the 11th and Venango
19 Playground as Williams Moore Reed
20 Memorial Park in the City of
21 Philadelphia.

22 Tragic accident occurred near
23 the vicinity of this playground, which
24 resulted in the death of Keisha Williams
25 and three of her children, Keiearra

1 Williams, Joseph Reed, Jr. and Terrence
2 Williams Moore. The children along with
3 her mother were selling food at the
4 stand to raise money for their local
5 church so a playground can be built when
6 a carjacked vehicle struck them.

7 A joint contribution was made
8 by the families and their attorneys
9 Morris Wilson Knepp Jacquete, P.C. in
10 memory of the decedents so that Keisha
11 Williams and her children's dream of a
12 new playground to the neighborhood be
13 located at 11th and Venango Streets can
14 be realized. Phase 1 of the new
15 playground was completed and was opened
16 in the summer of 2021 and planning is
17 under way now for Phase 2.

18 The Williams, Moore and Reed
19 families are honored and grateful that
20 the City of Philadelphia is
21 memorializing their loved ones with the
22 remaining of the playground at 11th and
23 Venango Streets in a space that
24 neighborhood children and adults will be
25 able to enjoy for years to come.

1 The Department of Parks &
2 Recreation supports this measure and
3 accordingly and respectfully request
4 that City Council approve Bill No.
5 210473 -- 743, I'm sorry. I'm also
6 requesting the suspension of the rules
7 so as to allow for first reading at the
8 next session of Council. I will be
9 happy to answer any questions that you
10 may have.

11 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you,
12 Mr. Creelman. We're going to hold
13 questions until the end.

14 Ms. Barnes, if you would like
15 to state your name for the record and
16 proceed.

17 MS. BARNES: Good afternoon.
18 My name is Cynthia Barnes. I am the
19 Director of the Nicetown-Tioga
20 Improvement Team and I'm here to testify
21 in support of Bill No. 210743. I am
22 here -- okay, I just said that. I'm
23 sorry -- regarding the renaming of 11th
24 and Venango Street Playground to the
25 William Moore Reed Memorial Park.

1 The playground was a glass
2 strewn, black-tarred area that was
3 repurposed in 2003. Thanks to Council
4 President Clarke, Deputy Commissioner of
5 Recreation at that time Carlton Williams
6 and the residents of this community,
7 later donations from Temple University,
8 funding from State Representative
9 Thomas. We put basketball courts up,
10 were assembled and installed and
11 dedicated by committed residents of this
12 community.

13 In 2017, the Council President
14 who frequently rides through the
15 neighborhood unannounced saw that this
16 program desperately needed an overhaul.
17 He was also trying to get the title
18 turned over from the School District to
19 Parks & Recreation, a process which took
20 almost 20 years.

21 So one warm day in March,
22 Council President, a Water Department
23 representative along with a couple of
24 lawyers met out on the playground site
25 and went over the vision for a new

1 playground, which would include greenery
2 and being capable of being a water
3 run-off location. While everyone was
4 discussing the possibility, Bob Morris,
5 one of the lawyers told us a very sad
6 story.

7 He was there representing the
8 surviving children of Keisha Williams,
9 who along with three of her children,
10 15-year-old Keiearra Williams, 10-year-
11 old Joseph Thomas Reed and 7-year-old
12 Terrence Moore were tragically killed
13 just blocks away from the playground by
14 a carjacked SUV in 2014. The family was
15 on the corner of Germantown and
16 Allegheny selling fruit to build the
17 playground when the tragedy happened.

18 Attorney Morris asked if I
19 thought the community would be opposed
20 to renaming the playground in memory of
21 this family. We the members of the
22 Nicetown-Tioga Improvement Team
23 heartedly agreed and are proud to being
24 a catalyst to memorialize this family,
25 and thanks for letting me testify. I

1 would also add that I live directly
2 across the street from the playground.

3 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you
4 very much for your testimony. And we
5 also want to thank the Council President
6 for having the foresight to work on this
7 issue and to make sure that the folks
8 involved in this tragedy, the victims in
9 this tragedy, are never ever, ever
10 forgotten. It was a horrible incident
11 here in the City of Philadelphia, and we
12 want to keep that family's name alive.
13 So thank you so much for the Council
14 President in his absence.

15 Are there any questions from
16 members of Council for this panel?

17 (No response.)

18 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: No, okay.
19 Well, thank you very much for your
20 attendance today.

21 Madam Clerk, are there any
22 additional witnesses or panelists to
23 testify?

24 THE CLERK: There are no other
25 witnesses.

1 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Okay.

2 There being none, that concludes the
3 hearing, and we're now going to go into
4 our public meeting. Again, there being
5 no further questions from members of the
6 Committee and no other witnesses to
7 testify, I'm going to ask once again if
8 there's anyone else present in this
9 hearing whose name we have failed to
10 call and that wishes to offer testimony
11 on the bill being considered today?

12 (No response.)

13 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: And hearing
14 none, I want to thank all the panels and
15 witnesses for their participation today.
16 We value your opinions. And I now
17 invite all panels and witnesses to
18 please disconnect from the meeting
19 before we go into our public meeting,
20 which we will pause the proceedings
21 briefly as multiple participants leave
22 the hearing, so that will be the two
23 participants leaving the hearing. Thank
24 you. Thank you so much.

25 MR. CREELMAN: Thank you,

1 everyone. Appreciate it.

2 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Have a
3 great day.

4 MR. CREELMAN: Bye-bye.

5 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Bye-bye.

6 That concludes the public hearing of the
7 Committee. We will now go into a public
8 meeting to consider the action to be
9 taken on the bills before this Committee
10 today.

11 Clerk, will you please call the
12 roll to take attendance. Members that
13 are in attendance will please indicate
14 that you are present when your name is
15 called. Also, please say a few brief
16 words when responding so that your image
17 will be displayed on screen when you
18 speak.

19 Madam Clerk.

20 THE CLERK: Councilmember
21 Gauthier.

22 (No response.)

23 THE CLERK: Councilmember

1 for a motion on Bill No. 210743.

2 COUNCILMAN JONES: I move that
3 Bill No. 210743 be moved from this
4 Committee with a favorable
5 recommendation and further move that the
6 rules of Council be suspended to allow
7 this bill's reading at our next session
8 of Council.

9 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Can we get
10 a second?

11 COUNCILWOMAN QUINONES-SANCHEZ:
12 Second.

13 COUNCILWOMAN BROOKS: Second.

14 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Very good.
15 Thank you. Council recognizes
16 Councilmember Maria Quinones-Sanchez and
17 Councilmember Brooks as seconding the
18 motion. It has been moved and properly
19 seconded that Bill No. 210743 be
20 reported from this Committee with a
21 favorable recommendation and further
22 move that the rules of Council be
23 suspended to permit first reading of
24 this bill at the next session of
25 Council.

1 All of those in favor of this
2 motion will signify by saying aye.

3 (Aye.)

4 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Is there
5 anyone opposed?

6 (No response.)

7 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: The ayes
8 have it and the motion carries.

9 This concludes the business
10 before the Committee on Parks,
11 Recreation and Cultural Affairs. And I
12 would like to thank you all very much
13 for your attention and participation
14 today. Thanks, everyone.

15 COUNCILMAN JONES: Well done,
16 Madam Chair. Well done.

17 COUNCILWOMAN BASS: Thank you,
