2 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
3 morning, everyone.

4 (Good morning.)

5 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: We  
6 have a quorum. Council will start.

7 I'm going to ask all the  
8 visitors and guests to please go behind  
9 the rail so we can get started. Thank  
10 you so much. I ask the members to take  
11 their seat.

12 To give our invocation this  
13 morning, the Chair recognizes the  
14 Reverend Peter Hwang, Bishop of First  
15 Korean Baptist Church of Philadelphia.  
16 He is here today as the guest of  
17 Councilman Oh.

18 I would ask all members and  
19 visitors to please rise.

20 (Members and guests rise.)

21 REVEREND HWANG: Dear God, in  
22 light of the recent tragedy our city had  
23 endured, with the loss of the two brave  
24 firefighters, Lieutenant Robert Neary and  
25 Firefighter Daniel Sweeney, killed in the

2   fire, I open up this prayer by pleading  
3   for your mercy and comfort for their  
4   families who are suffering and mourning  
5   at this time. We know that our words can  
6   only do so much, and so we pray that  
7   you'll be God of a provision in their

9           Now, we have gathered here this  
10   morning to also pray for your wisdom and  
11   guidance as our City Council has come to  
12   meet and discuss how they can address the  
13   needs of our city, as well as make the  
14   necessary changes to better the  
15   communities here in Philadelphia. Lord,  
16   grant them your strength that they may  
17   make decisions that will help stimulate  
18   growth in our economy and create jobs and  
19   opportunities for the many who have been  
20   unemployed and in financial need.

21           Grant them vision to see how  
22   the building of our educational programs  
23   will raise up our children to be the new  
24   generation of movers and shakers in our  
25   society, that through their education,

4           Oh Lord, we pray that through

17   in our prayers by interceding on their  
18   behalf.

19           We pray to you for the  
20   leadership that is represented here, and  
21   we give you all honor, glory and praise.

22           In the name of Jesus, we pray.  
23   All the God's people say amen.

16 Thank you so much.

22 COUNCILMAN GREENLEE: Thank  
23 you, Mr. President. I move that the

18 COUNCILMAN JONES: Thank you,

24 The Chair now recognizes

3                   COUNCILMAN O'NEILL:

4   Mr. President, on behalf of the  
5   republicans, there are no requests for  
6   leave of absence.

7                   COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

8   Thank you so much.

9                   Right now we'll dispense with  
10   the regular order of business. I would  
11   just like to welcome everybody here and  
12   thank you so much for taking time out of  
13   your day and coming to see us in action.  
14   We hope you walk away saying that your  
15   tax dollars are well spent. So thank you  
16   again for coming here, and we look  
17   forward to you coming again.

18                  At this time, the Chair would  
19   like to recognize Councilman Oh, who will  
20   present a resolution recognizing Anne  
21   O'Callaghan on her retirement as the  
22   Founder and Executive Director of the  
23   Welcoming Center for New Pennsylvanians.  
24   Would Ms. O'Callaghan and those  
25   accompanying her please join the

3           I see we also have Councilman

4       Kenney joining Councilman Oh.

5           (Members and guests approached  
6       podium.)

7           COUNCILMAN OH: Thank you so  
8       much, Council President.

9           I would simply note that both  
10      Councilman Kenney and myself serve on the  
11      Board of the Welcoming Center for New  
12      Pennsylvanians, and that is an  
13      organization founded by Anne O'Callaghan.

14          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
15      Thank you. You're doing a great job.

16          COUNCILMAN OH: Recognizing  
17      Anne O'Callaghan on her retirement as the  
18      Founder and Executive Director of the  
19      Welcoming Center for New Pennsylvanians.

20          Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan, a  
21      naturalized U.S. citizen, was born in  
22      Ireland and emigrated to America in 1970;  
23      and

24          Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan has  
25      been a prominent advocate for immigrants

2   in the Greater Philadelphia region for  
3   nearly 40 years;

4           Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan  
5   received her training and certification  
6   at the University of Dublin (Trinity  
7   College) School of Medicine and the  
8   Oswestry and North Staffordshire School  
9   of Physiotherapy; and

10           Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan was a  
11   physical therapy practitioner for twenty  
12   years and an instructor at the University  
13   of Pennsylvania; and

14           Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan later  
15   founded a software development company  
16   serving the home healthcare industry; and

17           Whereas, by 1999, the  
18   Philadelphia area was home to a large  
19   Irish immigrant population, some of whom  
20   needed community assistance in finding  
21   work, housing, education, food, and even  
22   how to travel back to Ireland if a loved  
23   one had died; and

24           Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan was  
25   well known in Philadelphia's Irish

2   immigrant community and respected as a  
3   thoughtful person with good reasoning  
4   skills and the power of persuasion to  
5   find appropriate help; and

6           Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan was  
7   asked by community leaders to provide  
8   informal assistance at an immigration  
9   center being opened in Upper Darby to  
10   assist this community; and

11           Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan then  
12   volunteered her time and lent her skills  
13   to assist immigrants of all backgrounds  
14   in obtaining the vital information they  
15   needed to establish their new American  
16   lives; and

17           COUNCILMAN KENNEY: Whereas, to  
18   support this work, Anne O'Callaghan began  
19   to use her fundraising and development  
20   skills to raise awareness and support  
21   among the local philanthropic community  
22   for this work; and

23           Whereas, in the course of her  
24   volunteer work, she identified a need for  
25   the region to have a centralized

2   employment and referral center for  
3   immigrants, and invested her own personal  
4   resources in the research necessary to  
5   design such a center, including traveling  
6   to New York, Boston and other cities that  
7   provided services for immigrants; and

8           Whereas, in 2003, Anne  
9   O'Callaghan brought together her  
10   knowledge and experience to found the  
11   Welcoming Center for New Pennsylvanians,  
12   to meet immigrants' employment needs and  
13   to serve to connect newly arrived  
14   individuals from around the world with  
15   all manner of economic opportunities  
16   through programs such as job skills and  
17   language training, job placement, legal  
18   services, support for small and startup  
19   businesses, and resource referrals;

20           Whereas, under the leadership  
21   of Anne O'Callaghan, the Welcoming Center  
22   for New Pennsylvanians grew from one  
23   volunteer to a 22-person staff with an  
24   annual budget of 1.5 million that has  
25   served more than 8,000 immigrants from

2   140 countries, including placing more  
3   than 1,400 work-authorized immigrants in  
4   a wide range of positions at 170 area  
5   companies;

6           Whereas, in 2006, Anne  
7   O'Callaghan was recognized for her  
8   contributions to the immigrant community  
9   by the United States Citizenship and  
10   Immigration Services with their  
11   Outstanding American by Choice Award; and

12           Whereas, in 2010, Anne  
13   O'Callaghan was presented with the  
14   inaugural Matthew Carey Hibernian Award  
15   by the Irish Immigration Center in  
16   recognition of her continued service to  
17   the Irish community and support of the  
18   immigrant community;

19           Whereas, in 2011, Anne  
20   O'Callaghan was recognized as a Purpose  
21   Prize Fellow for her achievements with  
22   the Welcoming Center;

23           Whereas, Anne O'Callaghan has  
24   continued to dedicate significant  
25   personal, professional, financial and

2   human resources to further the mission  
3   and the work of the Welcoming Center;

4           Whereas, in addition to her  
5   work with immigrants, Anne is active in  
6   the Alliance for the Mentally Ill, the  
7   Visiting Nurses Association of Greater  
8   Philadelphia, and the Southwest Community  
9   Enrichment Center; now, therefore, be it

10           Resolved, that the Council of  
11   the City of Philadelphia, hereby  
12   recognizes Anne O'Callaghan on her  
13   retirement as the Founder and Executive  
14   Director of the Welcoming Center for New  
15   Pennsylvanians.

16           Further resolved, that an  
17   engrossed copy of this resolution be  
18   presented to Anne as evidence of the  
19   respect and admiration of this  
20   legislative body for her dedication to  
21   Philadelphia's newcomers and helping make  
22   Philadelphia a more attractive and  
23   welcoming city.

24           And may I say personally, I  
25   admire and respect Anne. She represents

3    the opportunity to come from somewhere  
4    else and to have a great life and impact  
5    others in a great way here in this  
6    country.

7           So with that, I'd like to say  
8    congratulations on your retirement.

11   Chair recognizes Ms. O'Callaghan for  
12   remarks, please.

13           MS. O'CALLAGHAN: Well, I  
14   hardly know what to say. It's kind of  
15   like an out of body experience for a  
16   young woman from Ballybay. I still see  
17   myself as a young woman, all evidence to  
18   the contrary, to be standing here in this  
19   wonderful room listening to these  
20   accolades and I'm deeply, deeply  
21   grateful.

22           I am deeply grateful to my two  
23   fellow Board members, Councilman David Oh  
24   and Jim Kenney, but also to many other  
25   friends on City Council, Councilperson

2   Green, Councilperson Quinones-Sanchez,  
3   Bobby -- I can hardly call you  
4   Councilperson yet. I'll get used to it,  
5   though -- and Councilwoman Jannie

7   all of you who have supported in  
8   different ways the work of welcoming our  
9   new friends and our new prospective  
10   Americans to our region.

11               However, none of this work and  
12   none of these accolades could happen at  
13   all were it not for the people standing  
14   here behind me. These are the heroes and  
15   the workers. These are the folks that do  
16   the work. I get to stand up and be  
17   praised like this, but none of it would  
18   happen without these folks and also  
19   without our courageous and extraordinary  
20   clients who come here with one thing in  
21   mind, which is to make a new life and  
22   contribute to the tax base and to the  
23   diversity, the culture and the economy of  
24   our wonderful city and region.

10                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:   At  
11    this time, the Chair recognizes  
12    Councilwoman Tasco, who will present a  
13    resolution recognizing Delta Sigma Theta  
14    Sorority.   Would Ms. Terry  
15    Pearsall-Hargett and those accompanying  
16    her please join the Councilwoman at the  
17    podium.

18                  And we also have Councilwoman  
19    Blondell Reynolds Brown joining us.

20                  (Members and guests approached  
21    podium.)

22                  COUNCILWOMAN TASCO:   Good  
23    morning.   It always gives us a great  
24    pleasure to welcome our sorority sisters  
25    here in City Council.   Each year they

2    come for their day of working with City  
3    government, which is in keeping with one  
4    of their national agenda items and the  
5    Quaker City Chapter, one of the active  
6    chapters in this City of Philadelphia and  
7    Delaware County, and we always welcome  
8    them. And we invite our Councilmembers  
9    to come into the Caucus Room after  
10   Council and share your thoughts with  
11   these young ladies who are very active in  
12   our community.

13               City Council of the City of  
14   Philadelphia, recognizing and  
15   acknowledging Delta Sigma Theta Sorority  
16   on the occasion of its Fifth Annual  
17   Philadelphia City Delta Day.

18               Whereas, Delta Sigma Theta  
19   Sorority, Incorporated was founded at  
20   Howard University on January 13th, 1913  
21   by twenty-two African American collegiate  
22   women. Nearly six weeks after its  
23   inception, the founders of this  
24   illustrious organization participated in  
25   their first collective act of public

3   Suffrages March in Washington, DC; and

4           Whereas, the twenty-two

5   founders envisioned an organization that

6   would use their collective strength to

7   promote academic excellence, provide

8   scholarships, provide assistance to

9   persons in need, educate and stimulate

10   participation in the establishment of

11   positive public policy, and to highlight

12   issues and provide solutions for problems

13   in their communities; and

14           Whereas, Delta Sigma Theta has

15   been incorporated since 1930 and now

16   boasts more than 200,000 members with

17   over 900 chapters located in the United

18   States, England, Japan, Germany, the

19   Virgin Islands, the Bahamas, and the

20   Republic of Korea; and

21           COUNCILWOMAN BROWN: Whereas,

22   the major programs of the sorority are

23   based upon the organization's Five Point

24   Thrust of: Economic Development,

25   Educational Development, International

5           Whereas, Delta Sigma Theta is  
6   highly recognized for its commitment to

10          Whereas, as a national and  
11   international body, Delta Sigma Theta has  
12   participated in numerous Delta Days in  
13   the Nation's Capital, and in March of  
14   2003 became a Non-Governmental  
15   Organization at the United Nations,  
16   granting the organization special  
17   consultative status to the Economic and  
18   Social Council of the United Nations; and

19          Whereas, chapters from across  
20   Pennsylvania participate annually in  
21   Legislative Days in Harrisburg, and we  
22   are honored and pleased to be joined by  
23   the members of Quaker City Chapter --  
24   Councilwoman Tasco and I are members of  
25   Philadelphia Alumnae Chapter -- all who

22   Darrell Clarke, introduced by Marian

14   entitled "Licenses," to add a new  
15   subsection requiring licensees operating  
16   a business premises to cooperate in the  
17   reporting and investigation of violent  
18   crimes on or near the premises; and

19                   There will be a device at the

12          UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: She's  
13       sick.

14          CHIEF CLERK: Brett Anderson.

15          (Witness approached podium.)

16          COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
17       morning.

18          MR. ANDERSON: Good morning.

19       First I want to thank the Council for  
20       challenging this ban, which we see as  
21       immoral and ungodly for a number of  
22       reasons. And the one reason I wanted to  
23       look at is that we feel it targets  
24       religious freedom.

25          As a Christian, too often we

2   are sadly represented by what we stand  
3   against instead of what we stand for, and  
4   I just wanted to definitively state that  
5   one of the things we stand for, according  
6   to Matthew 25, is the feeding of the  
7   hungry, the giving of shelter to the  
8   stranger, visiting those who are sick and  
9   those who are in prison. We don't see  
10   this as an option. We see this as a  
11   command, and it is where our faith stands  
12   or falls.

13           The second thing is linked to  
14   health regulations. We support where  
15   they hope that food can be given out  
16   healthily and more accessibly, but we are  
17   against where it creates more hurdles in  
18   feeding those outside.

19           With Mayor Nutter's ban and the  
20   fact that it specifically targets Love  
21   Park and the park in front of the museum  
22   that's being about to be opened, it's a  
23   lot easier to join the dots and see where  
24   it comes from, and it really looks like  
25   an attempt to hide the homeless so that

2    tourists can come and tour in freedom,  
3    and we want to say that we are  
4    categorically against that.

5           And then just to close off, in  
6    the words of Jesus, this is kind of what  
7    he said to us. He said, those on his  
8    left, depart from me, you who are cursed  
9    into the eternal fire prepared for the  
10   devil and his angels. For I was hungry,  
11   and you gave me nothing to eat. I was  
12   thirsty, and you gave me nothing to  
13   drink. I was a stranger, and you did not  
14   invite me in. I needed clothes, and you  
15   did not clothe me. I was sick and in  
16   prison, and you did not look after me.

17           They answered and said, Lord,  
18   when did we see you hungry or thirsty or  
19   estranged or needing clothes or sick or  
20   in prison and did not help you?

21           He will reply, I tell you the  
22   truth, whatever you did not do for one of  
23   the least of these, you did not do for  
24   me. Then they will go away to eternal  
25   punishment, but the righteous to eternal

2 life.

3 The last point is that  
4 Philadelphia comes from the word "philao"  
5 meaning brotherly love, and when Jesus  
6 was asked who his brothers and family  
7 were, he didn't talk about blood  
8 relatives. He talked about those people  
9 standing alongside him and the people  
10 that are on the streets. The homeless  
11 people are our family and our relatives,  
12 and we want to make sure that the Council  
13 will do whatever is necessary to do so  
14 that they can be protected and looked  
15 after and well fed.

2                   MS. LEE: Good morning, and  
3 thank you. I think that this regulation  
4 brought upon by the Department of Parks  
5 and Recreation is abhorrent on multiple  
6 levels that we can all universally agree  
7 on.

8                   Wherever you stand on the  
9 political spectrum, I think we can agree  
10 that we don't want the government to  
11 interfere in the private lives of private  
12 citizens and however we choose to carry  
13 out who we share food with and what we  
14 eat.

15                   Also I think we can all agree  
16 that civil rights is important to us,  
17 that oppression is something that's  
18 against the foundations of our country,  
19 and here in this city is where all of  
20 that began.

21                   We can agree that anything that  
22 oppresses those who are mentally ill,  
23 physically or mentally disabled, children  
24 and other vulnerable people should not be  
25 subject to laws that will further oppress

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2   them.

3                   Also, on an economic level, a  
4   study done in 2001 by my alma mater, the  
5   University of Pennsylvania, showed that  
6   the high cost spent on -- taxpayers'  
7   money spent on things like emergency  
8   rooms or police interventions, that same  
9   amount of money can be used for support  
10   for those who don't have homes and it  
11   will be more effective. And I think  
12   private citizens willing to help those  
13   who are vulnerable is a benefit for the  
14   City, who is experiencing funding cuts  
15   all around.

16                  But, most importantly, on a  
17   spiritual level, I think we can all  
18   universally agree that love is the higher  
19   truth and love is the way. And as a  
20   follower of Jesus, I believe that when he  
21   died on that cross and rose again, it was  
22   for the sake of our own darkness and  
23   brokenness, which we all share. It was  
24   for the sake of all wrongdoing that he  
25   took that consequence. And when he rose

2   again from the dead, it was to bring us  
3   new life.

4                   But I also believe that not  
5   only the dividing wall between us and God  
6   was broken through what Jesus did, but  
7   also the dividing wall between one  
8   another, that through Jesus there is  
9   neither poor nor rich nor male nor female  
10   nor black nor white nor yellow or brown.  
11   There is no more wall between us. We are  
12   all one. We're one family.

13                  And I really want to encourage  
14   the City to rethink these regulations  
15   that would enforce dividing walls instead  
16   of breaking down dividing walls.

17                  Thank you.

18                  COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

19   Thank you.

20                  (Applause.)

21                  CHIEF CLERK: Erica Moulinier.

22                  (Witness approached podium.)

23                  MS. MOULINIER: Hi there. I'm  
24   a taxpayer and resident of Philadelphia  
25   in zip code 19134, and I'm here with The

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2   Simple Way, a Kensington faith-based  
3   non-profit that has worked for over 15  
4   years to advocate for the poor in our  
5   city. And I want you to know that I  
6   believe that you as governing officials  
7   must do something to stop these  
8   regulations which are barriers to  
9   compassion and love.

10               We believe that it's  
11   appropriate for the City to intervene  
12   when there are specific groups that are  
13   sharing food in a way that is unsafe,  
14   unsanitary or irresponsible, but a  
15   citywide food ban or ban on sharing food  
16   is not a necessary or sensible response  
17   to those exceptional cases. We are  
18   concerned that these new regulations and  
19   policies do more harm than good and  
20   create bureaucratic barriers to  
21   compassion.

22               Also, I fear that these  
23   regulations target and will be  
24   selectively enforced against some of our  
25   most vulnerable citizens. And failure to

2   enforce this type of legislation is a  
3   clear civil rights violation as well as  
4   an act of discrimination.

5           The park and public spaces of  
6   our city should be enjoyed by all  
7   citizens, rich or poor. Sharing food  
8   with those who are hungry is a  
9   fundamental act of human conscience. The  
10   thousands of people who share food in any  
11   way, both inside and outside, make our  
12   world a better place. The economic  
13   challenges facing our nation have  
14   awakened us in a sense of solidarity,  
15   knowing that there is a fine line between  
16   us and them. Additional cuts in City  
17   funding threaten to make such acts of  
18   generosity even more necessary.

19           Deputy Mayor Schwarz has noted  
20   that most funds for the City's human  
21   services come from the state, where a new  
22   budget cut threatens to cut 41 million in  
23   social service funding, representing a 20  
24   percent cut, threatening even those  
25   services that currently exist and do so

2   much good.

3           For many of us, sharing food is  
4   not only a matter of conscience, but an  
5   act of faith, a spiritual practice and  
6   exercise of religious freedom.

7           As Jesus bids us to come and  
8   follow, feed the poor, care for the  
9   hungry, we are not willing to allow  
10   unjust policies to be obstacles to our  
11   love. We deeply value dialogue and are  
12   convinced we can do more together than we  
13   can do on our own.

14           Thank you.

15           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

16   Thank you.

17           (Applause.)

18           CHIEF CLERK: Rachel Hosan,  
19   commenting on 120254.

20           (Witness approached podium.)

21           MS. HOSAN: Thank you. Good  
22   morning, President Clarke and members of  
23   the Philadelphia City Council. My name  
24   is Rachel Hosan. I'm on staff at a  
25   church called Liberty Fairmount. We meet

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2    in the Fairmount neighborhood. Our  
3    pastor is unable to be here today to  
4    represent our church, but I'm speaking on  
5    his behalf and for our congregation of  
6    about 250 people.

7           We've been sharing hot meals  
8    with our neighbors on the Ben Franklin  
9    Parkway every night for the past seven  
10   years -- every Friday night, excuse me,  
11   for the past seven years. Our church's  
12   ministry of serving meals on the Parkway  
13   is an expression of our faith in Jesus  
14   Christ and a response to his commands  
15   that we believe he's told us to feed  
16   those who are hungry, and we're concerned  
17   that this regulation will prohibit us  
18   from practicing our faith by sharing food  
19   with our neighbors.

20           Mayor Nutter has stated that  
21   one of his reasons for this regulation is  
22   a desire to offer dignity to individuals  
23   by providing them a place to eat indoors.  
24   And while we do agree that all people  
25   have great dignity, that should be

2    preserved whether or not they can afford  
3    to buy food. We do not feel that this  
4    regulation will truly be seeking dignity  
5    for all Philadelphians.

6           Over our years of serving meals  
7    in the City, we have come to believe that  
8    in order to meet the needs of the  
9    homeless and the hungry, we have to go to  
10   them rather than dictate that they come  
11   to us. We empathize with a reluctance to  
12   seek meals indoors, where the conditions  
13   are not always ideal and some of them are  
14   physically unable to go. We find it  
15   unsatisfactory to just send everyone who  
16   is hungry to sit at a table provided at  
17   the City Hall apron, and feel that the  
18   City's proposed alternative for serving  
19   meals in this way doesn't provide  
20   adequate long-term resources for the  
21   amount of people who are currently being  
22   served outside.

23           As Christians, as Erica and  
24   others have stated, our definition of  
25   family does extend beyond those who are

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2   biologically related to us, so that any  
3   of our neighbors is a brother or sister,  
4   and we want to continue to share our  
5   abundance with part of our family that's  
6   in need, in the same way that you would  
7   give us permission to have a picnic in  
8   the park with our biological family.

9           We believe this regulation will  
10   take away resources that are necessary to  
11   the health and wellbeing of many  
12   Philadelphians who are homeless,  
13   disabled, elderly, mentally ill and  
14   vulnerable, and our church is committed  
15   to pursuing justice on behalf of these  
16   individuals.

17           So we ask you that rather than  
18   passing this regulation, that you would  
19   please gather representatives who can  
20   discuss solutions to our city's hunger  
21   problems that will incorporate both  
22   indoor and outdoor meals in a way that  
23   will best meet the needs that are  
24   present. We desire to help with this,  
25   and our ministry of our church not only

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2   allows us to practice our faith, it also  
3   relieves some of the burden of public  
4   services from our city, and we know that  
5   there's not enough cash available to  
6   replace the services that we are  
7   offering. So we ask you to honor our  
8   efforts and worship to serve our city in  
9   this manner.

10               Thank you very much.

11               COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

12   Thank you so much.

13               (Applause.)

14               CHIEF CLERK: Veronica Joyner,  
15   commenting on 120254.

16               (Witnesses approached podium.)

17               MS. JOYNER: Good morning.

18   Thank you, President Clarke,  
19   Councilmembers present, parents and  
20   students. I would also like to offer a  
21   special thanks to Councilwoman Jannie  
22   Blackwell for her continued support in  
23   holding the hearings.

24               I'm Veronica Joyner and I'm the  
25   Founder and Chief Administrative Officer

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2   of the Mathematics, Civics and Sciences  
3   Charter School, and we're one of the  
4   largest charter schools in the State of  
5   Pennsylvania with a population of nearly  
6   1,000 students in Grade 1 through 12.

7           I am here and committed to  
8   public education in the City of  
9   Philadelphia, which started as a  
10   Philadelphia public school teacher. I am  
11   also the founder of Parents United for  
12   Better Schools, a non-profit parent  
13   advocacy corporation based in Germantown  
14   Philadelphia.

15           I'm here today to discuss my  
16   disagreement with the recent ruling by  
17   Mayor Nutter to ban outdoor feeding of  
18   the homeless. Let me begin with some  
19   disturbing facts about the homeless in  
20   Philadelphia according to Trevors  
21   Campaign on Homeless.

22           There are 13,000 homeless  
23   annually. Four hundred thousand people  
24   in the City live in poverty. One  
25   thousand five hundred families become

2   homeless each year. Twenty-five percent  
3   of homeless have mental illness. Seventy  
4   percent are shelter and children.  
5   Thirty-three percent of the homeless  
6   women are the domestic violence cases,  
7   and 30 percent of the homeless adults are  
8   substance abusers.

9           Homeless people don't choose to  
10   be homeless. The Mayor indicated that  
11   feeding lacks both sanitary and dignity.  
12   Would it give dignity and would it be  
13   sanitary to have homeless people eat out  
14   of trash cans and dumpsters?

15           I ask that you allow some of  
16   the students that I have here to talk  
17   about some of the things that they have  
18   experienced and learned from the  
19   homeless, but I would first like to  
20   mention that the Mathematics, Civics and  
21   Sciences Charter School's homeless  
22   project was founded and it is operated by  
23   youth enrolled in the school. Students  
24   from Grades 1 through 12 donate a dollar  
25   to feed over 500 homeless citizens, and

2       students raise about a thousand dollars  
3       to fund the project.

4                   Clothes, blankets, shoes,  
5       clothes, food, hats, coats are  
6       distributed every Thursday. There are  
7       teams of students that sort and  
8       distribute clothes and make hundreds of  
9       bags of toiletries and undergarments.  
10      Students meet every Thursday.

11                   We have a graduate of our  
12      school, Nehemiah Davis, who feeds the  
13      homeless in Center City every Monday  
14      using his own funds, and we also have  
15      another student that co-founded the  
16      King's House, a 20-bed shelter, with his  
17      father, and another student that's using  
18      the project as a required plan for his  
19      business degree.

20                   I would like to relinquish just  
21      a minute or so to the students to talk to  
22      you about what they've gained from the  
23      civics project at our school.

24                   MR. WITHERSPOON: Good morning,  
25      City Council President Darrell Clarke and

2   other Councilmembers present. I would  
3   also like to acknowledge Councilwoman  
4   Blackwell for holding this public  
5   hearing. My name is Jabri Witherspoon.  
6   I am in ninth grade at the Mathematics,  
7   Civics and Sciences Charter School of  
8   Philadelphia, Incorporated. I'm aspiring  
9   to be a good citizen, and I believe it is  
10   my civic duty as well as others to help  
11   the homeless.

12               As a good citizen, I have  
13   donated many dollars towards the homeless  
14   project at my school, and I enjoy doing  
15   it. At our school, giving, helping and  
16   caring is part of our civic curriculum.  
17   We are encouraged to help others because  
18   it is the right thing to do.

19               Every Thursday for the past  
20   seven years at 8 o'clock p.m.,  
21   Mrs. Joyner, Founder and Chief  
22   Administrative Officer, supervises our  
23   homeless project, along with the  
24   dedicated students and me. We serve over  
25   500 homeless citizens in the City of

2 Philadelphia distributing food,  
3 toiletries and clothes. Men make up the  
4 largest number of the homeless population  
5 we serve. Some of the men we serve are  
6 homeless veterans who fought for our  
7 freedom. If these homeless men risked  
8 their lives for America, why should they  
9 suffer?

10               Every man and woman is entitled  
11 to life, liberty and the pursuit of  
12 happiness. That means everyone has the  
13 right to live and the right to be happy.  
14 Taking away food does not give that right  
15 to the homeless.

16               I disagree with the ban on  
17 outdoor feeding our Mayor is passing.  
18 This immoral decision will in fact  
19 destroy the lives of thousands. The  
20 economy is also to blame for this  
21 increase in homelessness. Many people  
22 are homeless because there are no jobs.

23               If this ban takes place, not  
24 only will crime rise, so will  
25 Philadelphia's death rate. If people

2       don't have food, they die. If people are  
3       not clean, there's a risk of spreading  
4       diseases, and diseases do kill.

5           Thank you.

6           (Applause.)

7           MISS PECK: Good morning, all.  
8       My name is Myettia Peck. I am an eighth  
9       grade student at the Mathematics, Civics  
10      and Science Charter School.

11           It is important for human  
12      beings to eat in order to survive. No  
13      one should have to eat from garbage  
14      disposals or any unsanitary place. That  
15      is why our school buys and donates food  
16      to the homeless.

17           In this bag we have a turkey  
18      and cheese sandwich, crackers, fruit, a  
19      dessert and a bottle of water. This meal  
20      provides nutritional food for them in  
21      order to live.

22           MISS CHRISTIAN: Good morning,  
23      President Clarke, Councilwoman Blackwell  
24      and all members. Thank you for holding  
25      this hearing to give our students a

2    chance to speak. My name is Shawayna  
3    Christian and I attend the Mathematics,  
4    Civics, Science Charter School.

5           To ban feeding the homeless is  
6    not cruel, but it is inhumane. It's not  
7    going to help. It will only exacerbate  
8    the problem.

9           When people are hungry and they  
10   are not fed, they die. This is also  
11   going to increase the death rates. And  
12   then how great will Philadelphia look to  
13   tourists?

14           This ban is placed to hide our  
15   homeless from tourists. We will be known  
16   as the city that doesn't care, the city  
17   that doesn't love. It contradicts the  
18   whole brotherly love image that we try so  
19   hard to withhold.

20           I myself can't imagine the  
21   standing fact Philadelphia, the city I  
22   call home, a city I respect and love,  
23   turns to basically a pure act of  
24   selfishness.

25           Every state has homeless people

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2 and it is sad to be judged -- it is sad  
3 to judge the state on how they treat  
4 their children, old, sick and, in this  
5 case, their homeless. You have to love  
6 the people and understand it is not their  
7 fault that they are homeless. This  
8 choice -- and never their choice.

9 Thank you.

10 (Applause.)

11 MR. DOOLEY: Good morning, City  
12 Council President Darrell Clarke,  
13 Councilwoman Jannie Blackwell and all  
14 members present. My name is Gregory  
15 Dooley. I am in ninth grade and I attend  
16 the Mathematics, Civics and Science  
17 Charter School of Philadelphia.

18 I'm here to speak on the recent  
19 ban on feeding homeless outdoors. I  
20 disagree with the ban because it's wrong  
21 and unsympathetic. I don't understand  
22 why our Mayor wants to stop citizens from  
23 feeding homeless people. It clearly does  
24 not make any sense.

25 In a recent article, the Mayor

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2    stated it is a health hazard to feed  
3    homeless people and we may poison people.  
4    It is clear to the ban -- it is clear the  
5    ban is for the look of Philadelphia, to  
6    make it appear that we don't have any  
7    homeless people. The City of Brotherly  
8    Love is expected to show brotherly love.

9           Citizens serving food to hungry  
10   homeless people is not a health hazard.  
11   Starving homeless people is the health  
12   hazard.

13           I volunteer with Ms. Veronica  
14   Joyner every Thursday night for the past  
15   two years. I enjoy taking my time out to  
16   help homeless people eat and receive  
17   clothing.

18           My school actually teaches me  
19   to care about homeless citizens. We want  
20   to help homeless people succeed and help  
21   them get off the streets. Banning  
22   homeless people from being fed will only  
23   make the problem worse. Homeless people  
24   need our help. Our Mayor should respect  
25   the fact that helping people is not bad

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2   at all.

3           Thank you.

4           (Applause.)

5           MISS GEORGE: These are some of  
6   the items we give out to the homeless  
7   whenever we go to feed them. We give  
8   them a blanket, pants, shirt, socks,  
9   undergarments, soap, toothpaste, sneakers  
10   and deodorant. These are basic needs  
11   that need to be met, and by giving out  
12   these products, we help them stay warm,  
13   safe and clean.

14           We have suffered from outbreaks  
15   from diseases and viruses before. By  
16   giving out fresh clothes and washing  
17   products, we can help prevent that in the  
18   future.

19           Thank you.

20           (Applause.)

21           MR. SHEPPERD: By giving away  
22   these products, we show that we respect  
23   our brethren on the streets. We show  
24   that these are essential needs, food,  
25   shelter and clothing. They need to stay

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2 warm, and this is how they will. More  
3 schools need to act the way we do and  
4 deliver everything that we have. They  
5 should give away clothing that they do  
6 not need. We students do. We outgrow  
7 our clothing, and another person has not  
8 yet, so they may need them. So when we  
9 outgrow our clothing, we give them to the  
10 school and they are donated to the  
11 homeless. That is our goal, to make sure  
12 the homeless are like brethren, clean,  
13 they are in order, organized. Even  
14 though they are on the streets, they need  
15 to be fed. This is just a start. This  
16 is a good start.

17 Thank you.

18 (Applause.)

19 MS. JOYNER: Thank you very  
20 much. Thank you.

21 (Standing ovation.)

22 CHIEF CLERK: Adam from Philly  
23 Restart, commenting on 120254.

24 (Witness approached podium.)

25 ADAM: Thanks so much for

2   having us out today. I just want to say  
3   that though I oppose the regulation, I  
4   have a great respect for the City, this  
5   country and this Council and the Mayor  
6   himself.

7           That being said, I want to  
8   speak to specifically about my experience  
9   in working with the homeless.

10           About 11 years ago, I came to  
11   Philadelphia, and I would see many  
12   panhandlers. One guy said to me, What's  
13   the greatest nation in the world? And I  
14   paused to say something patriotic, and he  
15   said, Donation, give me a dollar.

16           And so sometimes I would give  
17   the guys a dollar, but eventually I spoke  
18   out loud the thing that was in my heart,  
19   which is, Why don't you just get a job,  
20   why don't you just walk into McDonald's  
21   and get a job. So I finally asked the  
22   guys.

23           The guy said, Well, I can't get  
24   a job. I don't have an ID, and I spend  
25   most of my day trying to get food to

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2 survive.

3 So I got some food for the  
4 guys. I picked a small group. I helped  
5 them get their IDs and I tried to get  
6 them back on their feet.

7 Those guys told their friends.  
8 They told their friends, and now we've  
9 got a program on Monday afternoons in the  
10 Parkway that feeds outside. We serve  
11 meals outside. We don't feed outside.  
12 Feeding is for farms. We serve meals to  
13 people.

14 (Applause.)

15 ADAM: And so our program is on  
16 the Parkway. And I want to address some  
17 of the specific things that the Mayor  
18 addressed as his reasons why not to have  
19 these programs continue.

20 The safety of the food. I  
21 think it's been said that there's a worry  
22 about this quality of food. What's going  
23 to happen if you ban this is just what  
24 was said before, people will eat out of  
25 the trash. Desperate people do desperate

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2   things. Stealth little grandmas will  
3   come by with food and they'll set it down  
4   on a park bench and they'll run away, and  
5   then the rest of the day people are going  
6   to pass around that food. It's going to  
7   get handed down, passed around. The food  
8   will get worse.

9           The second issue was the  
10   dignity of the men. I think there's some  
11   great indoor facilities in this city, but  
12   they choose often to come to our meals.  
13   They choose to leave the hotdog soup at  
14   some of the shelters and come to eat a  
15   meal with people that care about them.

16           We believe dignity comes from  
17   having a choice of where you want to eat  
18   as opposed to being told when and where  
19   to do it.

20           We believe that dignity comes  
21   when people care and show that they care  
22   and come forward and ban together.

23           And these guys will see then  
24   that the next piece of this, which is the  
25   criticism that social services are not

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2    allowed on the Parkway. Well, our group  
3    now helps thousands of people get state  
4    IDs in the City. The social services  
5    refer their clients to us. Project HOME  
6    sends a volunteer. We're trying to step  
7    in the gap. We are trying not to give  
8    people just food, but really to try to  
9    get them back on their feet. Our program  
10   runs a \$60,000 a year budget that is  
11   about IDs and a small part of that for  
12   food. We really help people, and we want  
13   to help people, but we want to do it with  
14   the City and not in opposition to the  
15   City.

16               The other point was the  
17   appropriateness of the Parkway. As it's  
18   been said before, this is the City of  
19   Brotherly Love. We don't want to be  
20   regulated where we love our brothers and  
21   sisters on the Parkway of Philadelphia.  
22   We want to work with the City to have a  
23   collaboration and to meet those guys,  
24   those veterans, those men who don't want  
25   to go into shelters, the families who

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2       don't want to bring their children when  
3       they need food at the end of the month  
4       into a homeless shelter, but just want to  
5       come to the park. We are their barbecue,  
6       and we just ask that you allow us to  
7       continue to have that.

8                   Thank you so much for your  
9       time.

10                   (Applause.)

11                   CHIEF CLERK: Jay Barbieri,  
12       commenting on 120254.

13                   (Witness approached podium.)

14                   MR. BARBIERI: Thank you,  
15       Council President Clarke and City  
16       Council. My name is Jay Barbieri. I'm  
17       an Elder at Liberty Church in the  
18       Fairmount section of Philadelphia. I  
19       also live in the Fairmount section of  
20       Philadelphia.

21                   My wife and I have been  
22       feeding -- excuse me; serving the  
23       homeless and disadvantaged on Logan  
24       Circle for the last eight years, and I'm  
25       speaking today against Resolution 769785

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2    by Mayor Nutter because I feel that it  
3    restricts my ability to be a Christian  
4    and serve out of a heart of love and care  
5    for those around me that don't have the  
6    ability to provide for themselves.

7           I want to help to protect the  
8    disadvantaged, those that can't fend for  
9    themselves, and that's what we do when we  
10   serve food on the Parkway. As Adam just  
11   said, a lot of these folks come to us  
12   because we have relationships with them,  
13   because they know that we care, because  
14   we meet and slip into the gap between the  
15   City and other services to give them the  
16   dignity that Mayor Nutter says he wants  
17   to give them.

18           For you to help block this  
19   resolution, you will be indeed giving  
20   these folks the dignity that you want to  
21   give them by allowing us to come  
22   alongside them and serve them. And my  
23   hope is that you would as a City Council  
24   empower us to be a bridge between the  
25   City services and the need that is among

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2 these folks. Would you please block this  
3 resolution, and would you please look for  
4 a way to enable us, those of us that are  
5 in churches, civic groups, to partner  
6 with the City so that we can provide the  
7 services that these folks need.

8 Thank you.

9 (Applause.)

10 CHIEF CLERK: Katie-Jo  
11 Claiborne.

12 (No response.)

13 CHIEF CLERK: Katie-Jo  
14 Claiborne.

15 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: She's  
16 sick too.

17 CHIEF CLERK: Janell Anema,  
18 commenting on 120254.

19 MS. ANEMA: Good morning. My  
20 name is Janell Anema. I am a resident in  
21 West Philadelphia working in Kensington  
22 with The Simple Way. I'm here to express  
23 my strong opposition and my deep sadness  
24 concerning the Mayor's regulation banning  
25 public feeding in Philly.

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2                   I'll start by thanking

3   Councilwoman Jannie Blackwell for her  
4   leadership and her willingness to bring  
5   this issue back into public dialogue.

6   Along with the unanimous support of the  
7   City Council, Councilwoman Blackwell has  
8   ensured that these regulations intending  
9   to sweep our homeless brothers and  
10   sisters under the rug will not also be  
11   swept under the rug.

12                It is unnerving to know that  
13   the government actions are threatening to  
14   impinge on the civil liberties of the  
15   most vulnerable populations in our city,  
16   and as evidenced by my shaking voice,  
17   it's unnerving to stand here today on  
18   their behalf.

19                Whereas, there are all kinds of  
20   linguistic hoops that I clearly don't  
21   know how to jump through.

22                Whereas, I lack any political  
23   capital in the City, as I've only  
24   recently relocated and haven't worked or  
25   interned in any of your offices.

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2                   Whereas, I didn't wake up this  
3 morning intending to speak into a  
4 microphone to this distinguished  
5 audience, and I don't wish to steward my  
6 time poorly.

7                   I'm asking you to eliminate  
8 these proposed regulations on my behalf,  
9 you who navigate these legislative  
10 systems with ease, you who are working  
11 with my political capital as my elected  
12 officials, you who are much more  
13 comfortable with microphones such as  
14 these and must also steward your time  
15 wisely. Be bold. Stand in the gap.  
16 Stand with us in the gap and be for the  
17 least of these.

18                   I'm wearing black today because  
19 I'm in mourning. I grieve these proposed  
20 regulations and those of the board of the  
21 Health Department. How long? How long  
22 will I grieve? And how soon is the vote?

23                   (Applause.)

24                   CHIEF CLERK: Christine  
25 Murrison.

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2 (No response.)

3 CHIEF CLERK: Christine

4 Murrison.

5 (No response.)

6 CHIEF CLERK: Brian Jenkins.

7 (Witness approached podium.)

8 REVEREND JENKINS: Council

9 President Clarke, I definitely want to  
10 give honor to Councilwoman Jannie L.  
11 Blackwell, who I consider as the Queen of  
12 Philadelphia. We also want to give honor  
13 to my Councilperson, Mark Squilla, and  
14 congratulate him on his newly elected  
15 office here in City Council. I greet you  
16 in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus  
17 Christ, on behalf of our Chosen 300  
18 Ministries here and around the world in  
19 Guyana, Jamaica, India, Nigeria, South  
20 Africa, Liberia, Ghana and the United  
21 States.

22 We come here in a grieve  
23 moment. I was listening to the children,  
24 and I think that's what motivated me  
25 most. If you couldn't hear it through

2    them, then you won't hear it through  
3    anybody and my words really won't mean  
4    anything.

5                   But we stand here in solidarity  
6    with a group of churches, organizations,  
7    grandmothers and families that get  
8    together to serve the homeless and the  
9    less fortunate of our city. We hereby deem  
10   these regulations unconstitutional, a  
11   violation of civil rights, a denial of  
12   religious freedom and a discriminatory  
13   practice against the protected classes of  
14   our city.

15                   These regulations that both the  
16   Mayor and the Health Department have set  
17   forth indicate that we can only serve  
18   less than three people. So, therefore,  
19   if you're going to say that one group of  
20   people can only serve three people, then  
21   you have to do it for every barbecue, you  
22   have to do it for every family gathering,  
23   you have to do it for every picnic.  
24   Because any time that you target one  
25   group of people and discriminate and say

2       that only they cannot receive food, then  
3       it is against the law.

4           The regulations are designed  
5       for the purpose simply of economic gain  
6       and not for public health. They have  
7       simply decided that they want to move the  
8       homeless and put them indoors. They are  
9       not people that can be just put aside  
10      into a separate place.

11           The Mayor has indicated he has  
12      provided a place around the atrium of  
13      City Hall where the homeless now can go  
14      in a separate but equal place. The Mayor  
15      needs to be sent a news flash that  
16      separate but equal was abolished in 1954.

17           (Applause.)

18           REVEREND JENKINS: The  
19      regulations violate civil rights of the  
20      protected classes, including the  
21      disabled, the elderly and the children.

22           Very recently the Governor has  
23      indicated there's going to be a 20  
24      percent reduction in social services,  
25      which will equivocate to about \$41

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2   million in the City of Philadelphia if  
3   that budget is approved. Schwarz has  
4   indicated -- Deputy Mayor Schwarz has  
5   indicated that two-thirds of that money  
6   will come from mental health services,  
7   which is most of the people that we  
8   serve.

9           If we take the food away from  
10   these people, it will stimulate crime, it  
11   will assimilate aggressive panhandling  
12   and it will stimulate hunger and health  
13   hazards for people who desperately need  
14   this food.

15           My yellow light is on, so I'm  
16   going to leave you with the words that  
17   are in the Book of Acts, the Book of  
18   Acts. It's important that we talk about  
19   this because we are on the heels of a  
20   liturgical point of our text, and Acts,  
21   the 4th Chapter, where after the Holy  
22   Spirit had come and descended upon them,  
23   the Bible says that all things were in  
24   common, and they came together and no one  
25   lacked.

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2           If we only provide protection  
3 for the rich and not the poor, then we  
4 are an unjust society and not a city of  
5 brotherly love.

6           Thank you so much.

7           (Applause.)

8           CHIEF CLERK: Reggie Marrow.

9           (Witness approached podium.)

10          MR. MARROW: Good morning,  
11 President Clarke and the entire City  
12 Council. I find it an honor to be here,  
13 and I want to put a special emphasis on  
14 honoring Jannie Blackwell for bringing  
15 this bill forth.

16          This bill is simply talking  
17 about what we should be doing for the  
18 downtrodden, the homeless and those that  
19 are not as fortunate.

20          (Music playing; witness  
21 singing.)

22          Thank you very much. My time  
23 is up.

24          (Applause.)

25          CHIEF CLERK: Greg Volz.

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2 (Witness approached podium.)

3 MR. VOLZ: I appreciate the  
4 opportunity to be here this morning. I'm  
5 going to speak to the youth court  
6 resolution. My name is Greg Volz and I'm  
7 paid by the Stoneleigh Foundation. I've  
8 been running youth courts in the City of  
9 Chester for five years, trained about 15  
10 different groups of students during that  
11 time. And in light of the moving  
12 testimony by the children this morning,  
13 my prepared remarks are going to be  
14 altered a little bit.

15 I mean, youth courts really are  
16 about listening to our children. It's an  
17 alternative disciplinary system, where  
18 instead of having adults decide what  
19 should happen to kids that break the  
20 rules, we have youth who are trained by  
21 lawyers and teachers and other  
22 professionals to operate youth courts.  
23 They use peer pressure. Those of us that  
24 are parents know that for many of our  
25 children, there are times in their lives

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2       where what their friends think is a lot  
3       more important than what we believe.

4                   Peer pressure works on the same  
5       principle. As a matter of fact, our  
6       youth courts, we have juries of students,  
7       and when they give their disposition, we  
8       don't call it a sentence, because we're  
9       restorative. We're not about punishing  
10      kids; we're about helping them. When  
11      they give their disposition, they all  
12      stand up and they face the respondent and  
13      they read the verdict, and that's pretty  
14      powerful stuff when seven or eight or  
15      nine of the kids that you see every day  
16      that maybe live in your neighborhood and  
17      go to your classes tell you what you just  
18      did is not acceptable and it's going to  
19      have to stop.

20                  Youth courts are the most  
21      replicable juvenile justice program in  
22      the United States. There's about 1,150  
23      of them. There's only about 20 in the  
24      State of Pennsylvania. Recently, the  
25      Pennsylvania Bar Association adopted a

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2   resolution unanimously calling for youth  
3   courts to be created in all counties in  
4   the State of Pennsylvania.

5                   Two of the students that I was  
6   the most fond of who have now  
7   graduated -- in Chester, graduation  
8   itself is an accomplishment -- one is in  
9   the Marines now protecting us; the other  
10   one is attending a post-secondary  
11   educational institution in Philadelphia.  
12   One of them told me once that if it  
13   wasn't for youth court, they would be in  
14   a gang.

15                   So to the degree that you're  
16   looking for new ideas and new strategies  
17   on how to deal with violence, I think all  
18   I can tell you is that my experience is  
19   that kids in many ways can handle this  
20   issue better than we can as adults.

21                   I'm not talking about severe  
22   crime. I'm not talking about individuals  
23   that have severe behavioral issues.  
24   We're talking about the kids that are  
25   getting off track and youth court has put

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2 them back on.

3 Thank you for your time.

4 (Applause.)

5 CHIEF CLERK: Shawn Laney,

6 commenting on 120254.

7 (Witness approached podium.)

8 MR. LANEY: Good morning,

9 Council President.

10 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good

11 morning.

12 MR. LANEY: Fellow

13 Councilpersons.

14 Why am I here? I'm here to  
15 share my experience being a homeless  
16 person and serving the homeless. I am  
17 also here to speak against the  
18 legislation on behalf of the homeless.

19 A little about myself. I'm a  
20 college graduate with two Bachelor of  
21 Science degrees. I'm a mechanical  
22 engineer by profession. I have almost 20  
23 years of professional experience working  
24 with engineering design firms and utility  
25 companies, and yet I find myself

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2   homeless. Not because of any decision I  
3   made, but because of outside influences  
4   and persons who made this decision for  
5   me.

6           Due to these outside  
7   influences, my family began to experience  
8   difficulties beyond my control. My  
9   experiences have also caught the  
10   attention of city, state and federal  
11   governments.

12           Being called into the ministry,  
13   God was able to use evil for good, in  
14   that I have firsthand knowledge of what a  
15   homeless person goes through. Most  
16   people are not homeless because they want  
17   to be. Many find themselves homeless  
18   because of life circumstances; i.e., loss  
19   of job, unsafe housing, mental illness  
20   and, yes, substance abuse. I myself do  
21   not smoke, drink or do drugs.

22           Please note that most people  
23   who feed the homeless do so out of a  
24   calling from God, as he has burned their  
25   hearts to give of themselves through

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2   serving the disadvantaged. Their service  
3   to the homeless is more than just about  
4   food, as they also share the gospel of  
5   Christ.

6           They also provide personal  
7   items, and in listening here, and wanted  
8   to share their burdens.

9           Quite a few of the homeless do  
10   not feel comfortable in a church setting  
11   or a shelter. To stop serving food on  
12   the Parkway would put them at a great  
13   disadvantage. My experience with the  
14   homeless has taught me that most feel a  
15   lack of respect -- that most feel lack of  
16   respect in society and that most people  
17   really don't care about the homeless.  
18   Please be informed that I was one of  
19   those persons who really didn't care  
20   until God opened my eyes to the  
21   sufferings of the homeless and  
22   disadvantaged.

23           How will this bill affect me?  
24   God has given me a mandate to help the  
25   homeless and disadvantaged in our city,

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2   to minister the gospel, to help develop  
3   our community economically and  
4   spiritually. God has helped me develop  
5   relationships with persons that has  
6   given -- that he has given vision and  
7   purpose; namely, my pastor, Dr. Horace  
8   Sheppard, Jr., the Senior Pastor of West  
9   Oak Lane Church of God; Mr. Brian  
10   Jenkins, the Executive Director of Chosen  
11   300; and Reverend Mathews, the Executive  
12   Director of Helping Hand Rescue Mission,  
13   just to name a few. And needless to say,  
14   this bill will hinder that purpose.

15           The bill will have an adverse  
16   effect on a number of men, women and  
17   children serving food on the Parkway,  
18   helps countless of people supplement not  
19   only meals but with other needs, such as  
20   clothes, toiletries, Bibles, books and  
21   other necessities that most of us take  
22   for granted each day.

23           God, through his service,  
24   fulfills needs the government can't  
25   fulfill.

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2 (Microphone cut off.)

3 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Sir,  
4 can you wrap up. Your three minutes are  
5 up. Can you wrap it up, please.

6 MR. LANEY: I'm in support of  
7 the City in finding a solution to the  
8 problems that will be a win-win for all  
9 interested parties, but to deny the  
10 citizens the right to feed the poor is  
11 not the answer. I would like to believe  
12 that City Council wants to encourage  
13 people of faith to take every opportunity  
14 to help some of his poor citizens.  
15 Please start by voting against this bill.

16 Thank you.

17 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:  
18 Thank you.

19 (Applause.)

20 CHIEF CLERK: Daniel Colbert,  
21 commenting on 120254.

22 (Witness approached podium.)

23 MR. COLBERT: Good morning,  
24 President of City Council and  
25 Councilmember Blackwell and the rest of

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2   City Council and everyone else who's  
3   spoken here today on this resolution.

4   I'd like to thank you all for coming out  
5   and spending your time on this today.

6           I am an attorney for the  
7   Commonwealth of -- in the Commonwealth of  
8   Pennsylvania and in the City of  
9   Philadelphia, and I'm here representing  
10   the Ministry of Emmanuel, which is  
11   actually a place where we serve homeless  
12   persons indoors, and also the  
13   Philadelphia Christian Legal Clinics,  
14   which is a network of several hundred  
15   Christian attorneys in the greater  
16   Philadelphia area. They've authorized me  
17   to speak on their behalf.

18           We are concerned about three  
19   major things here. The first is that  
20   this is a serious civil rights issue.  
21   The second is that this threatens our  
22   faith and worship. And the third, that  
23   this hurts the people who it's claiming  
24   to help.

25           First of all, on the civil

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2 rights issue. I want to remind everyone  
3 that when this country was founded, the  
4 only people who could vote were white  
5 male landowners. We don't want to go  
6 back to a time when only landowners or  
7 any other specified class of people have  
8 special rights and the rest of society is  
9 left out or vice versa, a time when  
10 there's one particular part of society  
11 that's left out. Just because someone  
12 doesn't have a home does not take away  
13 from their worth or value, and we want to  
14 make sure that they know that and that  
15 the City knows that.

16 (Applause.)

17 MR. COLBERT: During the civil  
18 rights struggle, one of the major issues  
19 that is lesser known but very important  
20 within caselaw of the Supreme Court was  
21 the issue of public parks. Public parks  
22 are for the enjoyment of all people, not  
23 just certain people, and integral to  
24 enjoying public parks is the ability to  
25 go there to eat, to play, to rest, to

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2   have fun, to associate with your  
3   neighbors. Taking away a fundamental  
4   part of this, the ability to eat,  
5   threatens the entire system.

6           Furthermore, there have been  
7   reports that I cannot confirm, but I've  
8   heard from several of my homeless friends  
9   that during this last weekend, they were  
10   kicked off of the Parkway by people  
11   claiming to be from Parks and Rec and  
12   from the Police Department. These  
13   practices are incredibly alarming to us,  
14   and we're worried about what this means  
15   for the civil rights of our friends and  
16   neighbors.

17           Additionally, the Mayor has  
18   said in news interviews that he is going  
19   to make sure that this doesn't affect  
20   families on picnics and other similar  
21   activities, church outings. However, as  
22   the regulation is currently written,  
23   there is no exemption for this, and I  
24   can't see a principled way for such an  
25   exemption to be written without targeting

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2   the homeless directly.

3           Furthermore, this threatens a  
4   practice in the Christian family that  
5   goes back over 2,000 years and it hurts  
6   those that it claims to help with  
7   integrity.

8           We have an indoor feeding  
9   facility. However, not everyone has that  
10   option, and ours is actually difficult to  
11   navigate because of stairs and other  
12   obstacles. We can't have people with  
13   wheelchairs come in because of the  
14   difficulty with the stairs. It's an old  
15   building. It's the First Baptist Church  
16   at 17th and Sansom.

17           And I would claim that, just in  
18   wrapping up here, that the only way to  
19   serve justice here is in defeating this  
20   regulation and other regulations like it.  
21   And I would like to read quickly from  
22   Amos 5:24, that we should let justice run  
23   down like waters and righteousness as a  
24   mighty and ever-flowing stream.

25           Thank you for your time.

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2 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

3 Thank you.

4 (Applause.)

5 CHIEF CLERK: Jeremy Samsoe,

6 commenting on 120254.

7 (Witness approached podium.)

8 MR. SAMSOE: Thank you, City  
9 Council, for giving us the opportunity to  
10 be here. My name is Jeremy. I'm a  
11 resident of Brewerytown area of  
12 Philadelphia. I'm also a member of the  
13 Liberty Fairmount Church. Rachel spoke  
14 on the congregation's behalf. I can't do  
15 that, but I can speak unofficially on  
16 some of the concerns that other members  
17 of our church, other neighbors that I've  
18 talked to, people that I know have other  
19 concerns that we generally have about  
20 this particular regulation. I can't say  
21 much more than really has already been  
22 said, but I will try to restate them as  
23 best I can.

24 Three things mainly that we  
25 have concerns. One is, as Daniel said

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2   before, this method of enforcement, how  
3   will this be enforced. As was just  
4   mentioned, Mayor Nutter said that this  
5   regulation will not affect picnics,  
6   church gatherings and other such things.  
7   Where is the legal basis for this? We  
8   have yet -- and I've worked with Brian  
9   from Chosen 300 and a lot of us, and  
10   we've looked, we have not seen any basis  
11   for this. If it's not legally enforced  
12   across the City, it's going to be  
13   discrimination, discrimination against  
14   people who are physically disabled, who  
15   are mentally handicapped, military  
16   veterans, families, other groups of  
17   protected classes of people. This can be  
18   severe, severe discrimination and severe  
19   backlash as well.

20           The practicality, the second,  
21   of the available resources. Mayor Nutter  
22   said that this is about the dignity,  
23   improving the dignity of the homeless,  
24   and I and everyone applaud him for that,  
25   but if it truly is, before government

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2    action is in place to take away  
3    resources, other resources should be in  
4    place prior to that action, and we don't  
5    see anything that -- any steps in place  
6    to truly help and improve the dignity of  
7    people who are looking for a meal. And  
8    none of us, I think, think that a  
9    one-year feeding station at City Hall is  
10   an adequate substitute for a 20 percent  
11   budget cut to social services, closing  
12   shelters around the City and, as we're  
13   here to discuss, elimination of the free  
14   resources that meet people's needs in  
15   their time of struggle and in their time  
16   of need.

17               Lastly, as I said, I'm part of  
18   the Liberty Fairmount congregation, and a  
19   lot of us, we do feel like this really  
20   impedes our religious freedom, our  
21   ability to, as we're commanded to, to  
22   love God and to love our neighbor, to use  
23   the Biblical imagery of those with two  
24   coats, to give one to those who have  
25   none. And this action, this legislation,

2    would, in effect, not only impede our  
3    religious calling, but what we see as our  
4    religious right.

5           So in closing, just to  
6    reiterate to say that we are, I think, as  
7    a whole willing and want to work with the  
8    City in this issue, that this is not us  
9    against them, it's not us against the  
10   City, that this is us against poverty,  
11   against suffering, against need and  
12   against want, and that's why we're here.  
13   And we ask you would hear these sincere  
14   concerns and join with us in truly  
15   improving the health and care of the  
16   City's citizens.

17           So thank you very much.

18           (Applause.)

19           CHIEF CLERK: Monica Wildes,  
20   commenting on 120254.

21           (Witness approached podium.)

22           MS. WILDES: Good afternoon.

23   My name is Monica Wildes. I'm  
24   representing We Feed the Homeless  
25   Philadelphia. This is Mr. Craig Stroman.

2       He is the CEO and Founder. I am a Board  
3       member.

4                   I'm reading a letter that was  
5       written by Mr. Stroman in response to  
6       Resolution 120254. Councilwoman, we  
7       thank you.

8                   We Feed the Homeless Philly is  
9       staunchly against Mayor Nutter's ban on  
10      feeding on the streets through the Parks  
11      Department. When we began feeding at  
12      Love Park in July 2010, it was in the  
13      midst of a heat wave, in the midst of  
14      over 95-degree weather, and we actually  
15      had the opportunity not only to serve  
16      over 200 persons that day, but our food  
17      and the liquids that we were able to give  
18      that day prevented individuals from  
19      having heat stroke, prevented heat  
20      exhaustion, prevented hunger. Despite  
21      the good that we were doing and the lives  
22      we were attempting to serve, the Parks  
23      Commission shut us down that day.

24                   It was that day that it was  
25      determined to feed the homeless on a

2   larger scale. So as a result, we decided  
3   to move our feedings to 18th and Vine,  
4   where we started feeding over 300 people  
5   every day. As of this date since July  
6   2010, we have fed over 15,000 meals. I'm  
7   going to say that again. Over 15,000  
8   meals served to individuals that are  
9   currently suffering from homelessness.

10               We feed the homeless because it  
11   is the right thing to do. There are  
12   thousands of mentally disabled homeless  
13   persons roaming around our streets from  
14   budgets being cut for mental health  
15   clinics and homeless shelters being shut  
16   down. We feed our fallen comrades and  
17   heroes who came home from wars fought  
18   abroad, only to be met with foreclosure  
19   signs on their doors. These are the  
20   stories we hear from those forgotten and  
21   disrespected Americans.

22               Mayor Nutter always talks about  
23   Philadelphia as the City of Brotherly  
24   Love and Sisterly Affection but, however,  
25   seems to forget that the part about love,

2       which is what we are spreading, and  
3       showing the homeless community that we  
4       care about our fellow Philadelphians.

5                   The Mayor discusses the  
6       homeless being fed in a dignified manner  
7       by feeding them inside. The homeless  
8       people that we speak to do not want to  
9       come to a section of City Hall for a meal  
10      because of it being in an arena type  
11      setting where people will be taking  
12      photographs and news television stations  
13      making the situation a spectacle.

14                  So in closing, here's some  
15      questions that we have for Mayor Nutter  
16      and some things that we would like for  
17      you to consider. What do we tell the  
18      young boys and girls that have  
19      volunteered with us and other  
20      organizations during our feeding about  
21      your ban?

22                  What do we tell the homeless  
23      who do not want to come to City Hall for  
24      a meal?

25                  What shall we tell our churches

2 whose religious freedoms that are being  
3 violated by an attempt to discourage them  
4 from feeding in public parks and spaces?

5 What are the City's plans to  
6 help these people?

7 Thank you.

8 (Applause.)

9 CHIEF CLERK: Robert Taylor,  
10 commenting on 120261.

11 (Witness approached podium.)

12 MR. TAYLOR: Good morning,  
13 Mr. President, members of Council, ladies  
14 and gentlemen.

15 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Good  
16 morning.

17 MR. TAYLOR: I'm Robert Taylor,  
18 a citizen of Philadelphia, commenting on  
19 Resolution 120261, Trayvon Martin.

20 Quote, a police surveillance  
21 video taken the night that Trayvon Martin  
22 was shot dead shows no blood or bruises  
23 on George Zimmerman, end quote, ABC news  
24 reporter Matt Gutman wrote, noting that  
25 Zimmerman told police that, quote, he

2     shot Martin after he was punched in the  
3     nose, knocked down and had his head  
4     slammed into the ground, end quote.

5           ABC news reported that  
6     Zimmerman appeared to be uninjured in the  
7     video, but according to the Daily Caller,  
8     a still image from the video indicates  
9     that what appears to be a vertical  
10    laceration or scar several inches long.

11           Much of the mainstream media is  
12    suppressing information in order to  
13    inflame racial division. This whole  
14    media circus is out of control. They use  
15    a photograph of Trayvon when he was 12  
16    years old and they altered a transcript  
17    of Mr. Zimmerman's 9-1-1 call. They call  
18    Mr. Zimmerman white, all the while  
19    knowing that he is actually Hispanic.  
20    President Obama has mixed white  
21    background, yet we don't refer to him as  
22    a white black man.

23           In short, it is clear from the  
24    beginning that there was more to the  
25    issue than the fact that Trayvon was

2   dressed in a hoodie, purchased Skittles  
3   and iced tea. Whatever the calls may  
4   have been, Trayvon was beating Zimmerman,  
5   smashing his head into the concrete, and  
6   there's little reason to suggest that the  
7   conflict was racially motivated.

8   Zimmerman has protested in support of  
9   another African American shooting victim.

10           In short, the media wants to  
11   stir up racial division. Since the time  
12   of this incident, there have been calls  
13   to arrest and even kill Zimmerman. This  
14   is not right.

15           While I generally support this  
16   resolution, nevertheless Florida African  
17   American Representative Allen West  
18   stated, quote, I don't think that anyone  
19   should be using this tragedy to push an  
20   ideological agenda to include anti-gun  
21   lobbying. And he went on to say, I am  
22   not an investigator and I do not see --  
23   we all need to see what comes out of the  
24   investigation and let it materialize, end  
25   quote.

2           I agree with Representative  
3 West's views. We should seek justice.

4           Thank you for your attention,  
5 and God bless America.

6           (Applause.)

7           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

8       Okay. We want to make a statement.  
9       Resolution 120254, which references the  
10      homeless that calls for a public hearing,  
11      will not be running today. There will  
12      not be a vote on the resolution.

13           Under the rules of Council, I  
14      am authorized as Council President to  
15      stop the public comment as it relates to  
16      repetitious comments on a particular  
17      resolution. If this bill or resolution  
18      was running today, I probably wouldn't do  
19      what I'm prepared to do, but because  
20      there will be an opportunity to speak on  
21      this again if it runs next week based on  
22      Councilperson Blackwell's willingness to  
23      bring it up for a vote, there will be  
24      another opportunity.

25           So under the rules, I'm going

2   to stop the public comment on this  
3   particular resolution. You will have  
4   another opportunity, but we must conduct  
5   business, and under the rules of Council  
6   as it relates to the requirement by the  
7   Supreme Court, we are authorized to cut  
8   off public comment on this matter.

9           If there's anyone else to  
10   testify on any other resolution or bill  
11   relating to another matter on the Final  
12   Passage, they can do so now, but as it  
13   relates to this, we get your point. You  
14   will have another opportunity. So thank  
15   you very much. Thank you for coming down  
16   today.

17           Members, thank you for your  
18   patience. Right now we'll be considering  
19   the resolutions and bills on the Second  
20   Reading and Final Passage Calendar.

21           The Clerk will please read the  
22   title of Resolution No. 120118 -- I'm  
23   sorry. That's being held by  
24   Councilmember Johnson.

25           Mr. Decker, please read the

2   title of Resolution 120219.

3           CHIEF CLERK: A resolution  
4   authorizing the Commissioner of Public  
5   Property to execute and deliver to the  
6   Redevelopment Authority of the City of  
7   Philadelphia, without consideration,  
8   deeds conveying conditional fee simple  
9   title to certain City-owned lots or  
10  pieces of ground with the buildings and  
11  improvements thereon, situate in the  
12  Fifty-Second Ward of the City of  
13  Philadelphia, introduced by Councilwoman  
14  Blackwell.

15           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

16  Thank you.

17           Councilwoman, I believe you  
18  wanted to make a motion on this  
19  particular resolution.

20           COUNCILWOMAN BLACKWELL: Thank  
21  you. Thank you, Mr. President. I move  
22  that Resolution No. 120219 be withdrawn.

23           (Duly seconded.)

24           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: It's  
25  been moved and seconded.

2 Those in favor?

3 (Aye.)

4 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE:

5 Those opposed?

6 (No response.)

7 COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: The  
8 ayes have it. Resolution 120219 is  
9 withdrawn.

10 The Chair recognizes  
11 Councilmember Green.

12 COUNCILMAN GREEN: Thank you,  
13 Mr. President. I would like to ask to be  
14 excused for the remainder of Council on  
15 Council business and be recorded as  
16 voting aye on all motions to suspend the  
17 rules, all resolutions and all bills.

11   slow pace and reaction of the local  
12   police department and prosecutors. Two  
13   weeks ago when we introduced this  
14   resolution, we did not know whether the  
15   family would ever see this day that moves  
16   towards justice. We now know that this  
17   family will indeed be given their day in  
18   court. Now they will be given their  
19   constitutional right to seek justice in  
20   the death of their son. Now we will all  
21   be given the opportunity to find out just  
22   what happened on February 26th that led  
23   to this unarmed young man with no  
24   criminal record being taken from his  
25   parents at the age of 17.

2           We do not know what we will  
3 hear in court, but we know now that we  
4 will hear all the facts. And knowing the  
5 facts has been the ask all along.

6           Now the arrest action 45 days  
7 later has taken place, and so we must now

10           I offer kudos to those who  
11 protested, attended rallies, spoke up and  
12 spoke out about this case, all done under  
13 the flag of peace. I was struck by  
14 LeBron James and other members of the  
15 Miami Heat basketball team who posed in  
16 hoodies in a photograph they posted on  
17 Twitter, and Congressman Bobby O. Rush,  
18 democrat Illinois, even wore a hoodie on  
19 the floor of the House saying, and I  
20 quote, Just because someone wears a  
21 hoodie does not make them a hoodlum.

22           Yesterday Florida State  
23 Attorney Angela Corey spoke. She gave us  
24 non-lawyers -- and I speak for myself --  
25 a master class 101 in criminal law. I

2    watched her with exceeding admiration.  
3    She was precise, she was poised and she  
4    was thorough. She made it exceedingly  
5    clear that these proceedings are now in

10   We only know one category as prosecutors,  
11   and that's a V. It's not a B, it's not a  
12   W, it's not an H. It's a V for victim.  
13   That's who we work for tirelessly, and  
14   that's all we know, is justice for our  
15   victims.

16               It is not lost on me that we  
17    have focused worldwide attention on  
18    Florida when we have problems of youth  
19    violence in our own backyard right here  
20    in Philadelphia. As of January 1, there  
21    have been 97 murders in our city, 97  
22    families similarly situated who are  
23    hurting, searching for meaning and  
24    seeking justice for their young people.  
25    These families should know that their

15           COUNCIL PRESIDENT CLARKE: Are  
16   you requesting that the --

17           COUNCILMAN KENNEY: I would  
18   like to at least have some time to talk  
19   about it for a week. I may not vote for  
20   it next week either, but I just --  
21   between our folks in harm's way and our  
22   President under attack, I just don't want  
23   to give them anything to do any further  
24   damage.

25           Thank you.

3 Thank you, Councilman.

4 COUNCILWOMAN SANCHEZ: Just for  
5 clarity's sake, I completely understand  
6 my colleague's perception on this. This  
7 by no means says that we should not do  
8 what we're doing and giving our troops  
9 the resources and everything that they  
10 need, but I completely understand his  
11 point. The activity is on April 17th,  
12 which is why I asked for the call, but I  
13 would like to call a vote on it, and if  
14 he wants to just abstain, I completely  
15 understand. The time sensitivity is  
16 that -- I can assure you that that's not  
17 the spirit of the resolution. One thing  
18 has nothing to do with another. It's  
19 about as we begin to break down some of

10   release of the Bully movie, which has  
11   been about two years in the making.  
12   Councilwoman Brown and myself have been
