3 COUNCILMAN DICICCO: Good morning, good
4 morning, good morning. This is the continued
5 public hearing on the Committee of Streets and
6 Services.

7 Is there anyone here who wishes to
8 continue to testify on any of the bills that were
9 discussed at the public hearing yesterday in City
10 Council on Streets and Services?

11 (No response.)

12 COUNCILMAN DICICCO: Hearing none, we
13 will now move into the public meeting for the
14 Committee of Streets and Services.

15 The Chair recognizes Councilmember
16 Clarke.

17 COUNCILMAN CLARKE: Thank you, Mr.
18 Chairman.

19 Mr. Chairman, I'd like to offer an
20 amendment to Bill No. 000166. It reads on Page 4,
21 No. 4, locations of newsstands. I would like to
22 add a new section, which would be d., within 50
23 feet of any property classified in any residential
24 district designated R1 residential or R1-A,
25 residential, as outlined in Section 14-200 of the

3 monastery, or other places of worship and adjunct
4 residential dwellings or any property used for the

8 COUNCILMAN DICICCO: Do I hear a motion
9 for the adoption of the amendment?

10 COUNCILMAN ORTIZ: So moved, Mr.
11 Chairman.

12 (Duly seconded.)

13 COUNCILMAN DICICCO: It's been properly
14 moved and seconded that an amendment to Bill No.
15 000166 be adopted.

16 All those in favor of the amendment,
17 signify by saying aye.

18 Those opposed?

19 The amendment is approved.

20 There is also an additional amendment
21 to Bill 000166 that was offered by the Streets
22 Department yesterday, and those amendments were
23 read into the record yesterday. Is there a motion
24 on those amendments?

25 COUNCILMAN COHEN: I so move.

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2 COUNCILMAN DICICCO: It's been properly
3 moved and seconded that the amendments to Bill No.
4 000166, as read into the record yesterday by the
5 Philadelphia Streets Department, be approved.

9 The amendment is approved.

10 Bill No. 000166 will be held for
11 further consideration at a date certain of May
12 16th, year 2000. We're not certain of the time
13 yet. That bill will be advertised, and the
14 hearing will be heard on that day.
